

FLAG HAND-STAMPS AND FLAG-LIKE CANCELS

Richardson devotes Chapter 3 of the Handbook to 'The HAND-STAMPS'. He also mentions the flag-like cancels in the forward. In the past few months a couple of members have sent covers with this type of cancellation. Other examples have been sent by many members in the past. Also the editor has looked around for some of these.

The following is a listing of the items found. Other cancellations exist. Please send in a copy of any examples that are not in this listing and we will include in future listings.

Numbering is by the year in which they first appear and then sub-numbering along the format established by Richardson. Dates are those seen by the editor. Copies of dates expanding periods of use should be sent to the editor for inclusion in further listings.

I realise there are proof impression dates and late date of use based on the slogan text wording. These may well be accurate in most cases. However; in keeping with the Flag group tradition we report only impressions seen by the writer.


