Hot and humid weather, so it's perfect for staying home in the air conditioning, and typing the Klussendorfer. As usual, we've got new and interesting reports. It seems that there's always something up with K machines in Canada. We hope you enjoy this issue, and send us more info for the next. We lead off with a report of a tough K - LADYSMITH, BC. I had the chance to try a Klussendorf machine at the PIPEX show in Edmonton, as did others (below). And there's more happening with slogans. Here goes.

LADYSMITH, BC

Greig Hutton sent off a couple of covers to LADYSMITH to get Klussendorf cancels. After a long wait, they came back with the LADYSMITH K as shown below. Initial word was that it would be used on a regular basis. The EKU for this period supposedly was May 19, 1989. (This news suggested that the supply of this K would become plentiful. But no; read on!) After hearing from Greig, I wrote the same postal official and in a letter dated July 10/89 the official returned my covers uncanceled noting "that the Klussendorf cancelling machine which we once had is no longer in use at this location." It appears that this K is going to be a very tough one. Except for the few Greig got, the piece reported previously (p. 31), and a couple another member has, there are no others known. This looks like it will become a rare one. Good hunting!



ALDERGROVE, BC - error and local usage.

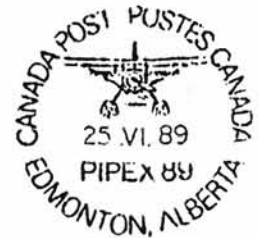
This one is being used for local mail only. I saw no strikes after April 1988. On speaking to postmaster H. Sangha at ALDERGROVE, I found out that all nonlocal mail is sent to the mail sorting facility at Langley, B.C. and only local mail is cancelled at ALDERGROVE. The Klussendorf machine is still in use, with the blank timemark. This will be another difficult cancel to obtain in future if its use is restricted to local mail. I have one copy, with the date (above) 01 VI 1988, an error for 1989.

SPRUCE GROVE, AB and PIPEX.

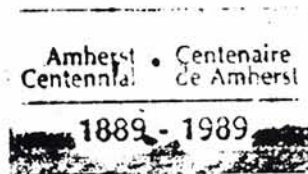
Keith Spencer of Edmonton, the head of the recent PIPEX show there, reports that the SPRUCE GROVE machine was at the PIPEX show 23, 24 & 25 VI 1989. The cancel used was 23 VI 1989-00 on all three days. Some but not too many covers were prepared. Keith reports the machine was out of adjustment (the strike was too far to the left on the envelope; kgs) and so few covers were processed at the show. After the show, the postal officials readjusted the machine and a few covers were prepared with all three dates.

Further, Joe Smith, a fellow BNAPSer and PHSC member, was kind enough to send along a SPRUCE GROVE 23 VI cover, and notes the machine was marked as a Division machine, serial number 02702 (F-11 order P0023 2 0129; kgs). This Greig Hutton advises is one of the new order of machines ordered by Canada Post as backup. From this, we can conclude the Spruce Grove hub was used with new machine 02702 at Pipex in Edmonton 23, 24 and 25 1989.



CRESTON, BC slogan

The Blossom Festival slogan is back in use again in 1989 with dates from 21 IV 1989 1 to 2 VI 1989 1 recorded so far. This is the fifth year in a row for this slogan. 19 IV 1989 is recorded with POSTAL CODE.



AMHERST, NS slogan, timemark, and error

A new slogan has appeared at AMHERST. Dan Hunka reported the turnover date to me but I can't find it. I record the POSTAL CODE on 29 III 1989 and the slogan 31 III 1989 with timemark -20. An error occurred here of 1980 for 1989 with TM -1 as previously used in Oct.-Nov. 1987. I record this so far on dates 10-23 V 1989 with it corrected in June but timemark -1 still in use.



SHERBROOKE, PQ

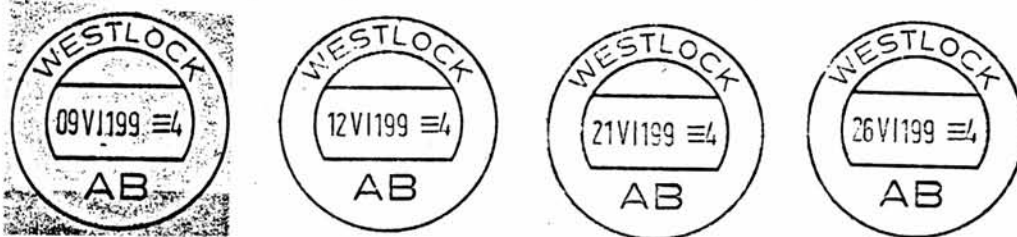
Current strikes of this Klussendorf are scarce as the machine is not in normal daily use. I record only two strikes this year so far. The interesting thing is that one of these is an error of 19 III 1988 BL for 1989. This is also a Sunday date which again is unusual. Watch for these.

The Klussendorfer

WESTLOCK, AB error (199).

Jim Karr reports some funny stuff at WESTLOCK. Jim reports the normal dates to 29 V 1989.2 and then the error 09 VI 199 \approx 4 to 26 VI 199 \approx 4 showing the day and month correct, but 199 for 1989 and the new timemark \approx 4. There are no strikes for either Saturdays or Sundays, so perhaps either no mail from WESTLOCK on weekends or another dater used. I have the dates 12 and 16 with this error. Jim wonders if the error started June 1 on the changeover from May.

While examining a large lot of May and June Klussendorfs (which included numerous June 1-16 Ks from other K towns), I found no early June WESTLOCK strikes, but I found a few covers with 05 and 06 IV 1989.2. I will make the supposition that when changing from May to June the postmaster changed to IV instead of VI for the first few days of June. On correcting this sometime between 06 and 09, the postmaster unintentionally introduced the error.



LISTOWEL, ON error (199 also).

This town has shown up with a similar oddball date error of 11 VI 199 -00 for 11 IV-1989-00. This gives a month error of VI for IV, a year error of 199 - with only 3 digits - for 1989, and a new timemark of -00. On the 7th and the 14th, the date was correct.



LIVERPOOL, NS error.

A date error occurred on 28 IV 1989 reading 28 VII 200^u.9 with the month VII for IV, the year 200^u with the last digit part turned, and the .9 timemark part turned (faint, but above). →

Half-turned indicia - DRYDEN.

With more reports being seen of partly-turned indicia, it makes me wonder if this is a sign of wear of the numbering device. For example, I recently obtained the above example from DRYDEN, ON dated 2 V 1989 with the timemark showing the upper part of the 7 and the lower part of the 8. Is it my imagination, or are these glitches becoming more frequent? (kgs)

GODERICH, ON has a new TM of -16 reported on 02 V 1989-16.

GRIMSBY, ON's Klussendorf is back in local use only after being used at the RPSC show in Hamilton (p. 50). The timemark . is back in use. The TMs .2 and .1 were in use only at Hamilton.

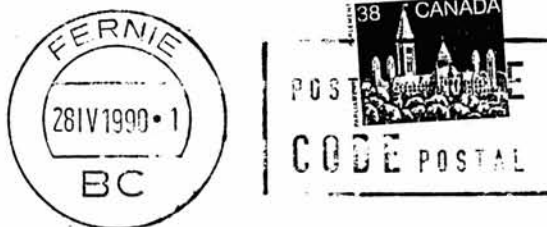

Wally Gutzman reports that an exhibit of Klussendorf cancellations at the Lakeshore Stamp Club Exhibition in April 1989 rated a silver ribbon. I assume this was Wally's. This is the first award won by a K exhibit at an organized exhibition.

Bill Robinson reports a FERNIE error of 28 IV 1990.1 for 1989. I record this error as early as 20 IV 1989.



Wally Gutzman reports a new EKD of 04 VII 1985-17 for the NORTH SYDNEY, NS slogan. Also he reports a date error for WHITEHORSE of 03 VII 1996. with a 34-cent stamp. In addition, Wally reports the following timemarks new to him:

A SURVEY

Greig Hutton has been working on Ks again. He has designed a chart on his computer which has spaces for each date each year for any Klussendorf, and he has entered his K strikes on these charts (actually entering the timemarks of his strikes). Beginning this issue, we will print some of these charts with records of what Greig has listed. I have already supplied many of my strikes which are incorporated in his list and have more to report. We are going to start with the discontinued towns.

There are two basic ways to handle this. One is to write out your date reports and send them to Greig. A second is to fill in the charts or make a copy of the charts, fill in the copy where appropriate, and send this to Greig. These towns have been discontinued for a few years and we should be able to fill in a lot of gaps in our knowledge and assemble it in one place.

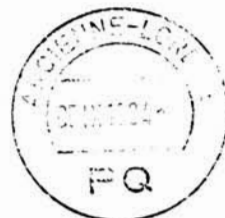

The handstamp of the M.V. Lady Rose (reported on p. 16, Klussendorfer #2) is still in use, except the years "1937-1987" have been removed. This is an interesting way to get Port Alberni. Bill Robinson: note for the RPO & TPO cancel group.

PARRY SOUND, ON timemark

PARRY SOUND has a new timemark of -16, the earliest report so far being 05 VI 1989-16.



LA TUQUE, PQ

Something strange is happening here. The LA TUQUE part of the cancel (above) does not show up in the cancel except for small parts of a few letters. This is found consistently from at least as early as 16 V 1989 to 16 VI 1989. The dater was okay on 8 V 1989. I wonder if the machine is poorly adjusted or has been damaged. Fortunately, corner cards help identification and no other Klussendorfs are consistently like this at present.

Member Robert Meek has sent us a long report dated March 28, 1989 which I unfortunately misplaced, but better late than never, here it is, starting at the top of p. 79.

From Robert Meek:

- confirmation of ALLISTON, ON EKD - 22 II 1984 BL (p. 14)
- SUSSEX, NB report of 2 II 1984-17 (cf. pp. 14-15); error for 1985
- PORT ALBERNI, BC. Bob reports having three covers like that on p. 16 with the Lady Rose handstamp with the 1937-1987 date removed (see later illustration on p. 78). All are from Bamfield, with PORT ALBERNI Klussendorfs of 24 II 1988=0, 29 VIII 1988=0, and 09 IX 1988=0 (with the salmon slogan). All are technically way letters. Two of the Lady Rose handstamps are black, and that of the 29 VIII 1988 cover is red.
- BLENHEIM, ON (p. 24) strikes are more purplish than blue; strikes seen from 07 XI to 29 XII 1988.
- WESTBANK, BC EKV 07 V 1988= (p. 25).
- BEDFORD, PQ. Two " 988" strikes, no "1" in the year. 30 VIII 988-18 and 28 XI 988-18 errors (cf. p. 28).
- MASCOUCHE, PQ - similar error 03 XI 988-17. Robert wonders if there is a blank on the wheel where the "1" should be (see also WESTLOCK and LISTOWEL on p. 67 of this issue for somewhat similar errors).
- CHAMBLY, PQ (p. 29) confirmation of EKV as 12 I 1984-19.
- AMQUI, PQ (p. 30) supporting early date of 22 II 1984 BL.
- FORT ST. JOHN, BC (p. 32) - extend error date of 24 VIII 2014-08 back to 21 VIII.
- MORE INVERTS (p. 32) - HOPE 05 XII 1988.1
 - REVELSTOKE 16 VIII 1988.
 - DELHI 10 III 1989-18
- WESTBANK, BC - error of 11 II 1990 should be timemark .2 not -2. Please correct.
- a dozen and a half Klussendorf slogan date changes that I'll put into the list (pp. 34 & 35), and reprint soon (kgs).
- PICTON invert. The date given previously as 12 III 1988-17 is a mistake and it should be 12 I 1988-17. The slogan was correct on 7 I and 14 I.

Some musings.

1. The way the wheels must spin on the dater I'm (R. Meek) surprised more ridiculous year dates haven't turned up. Is it possible only years of 2000, etc., can appear rather than 3000, etc.? My most future year date is 2016 (HALIBURTON, MILTON, NEWCASTLE & NELSON) (2018 is known from ANTIGONISH, NELSON, SQUAMISH & TRACADIE; ALS).
2. Similarly error days over 31 are not uncommon but is it possible to have something in the 40s or 50s, etc.?
3. The QUEBEC machine with three POSTAL CODE slugs has me wondering if there are 2 different belts used alternately as one needs cleaning perhaps. Since the invert is still appearing from time to time and can be seen as often as three times on a single envelope, I feel that it must be a separate device.

Dear Bob - Thanks for a super bit of ~~reporting~~ ^{REPORTING}. Let's all get some input in the newsletter. (ALS).

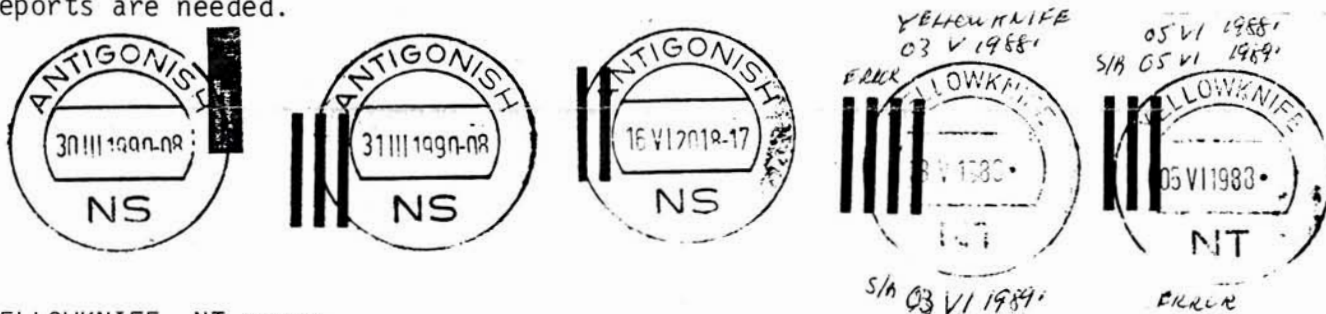

ANTIGONISH, NS - errors and timemarks

Timemark -17 was in general use all of 1988 and 1989 until 23 III 1989. On 27 III 1989, an error occurs of 27 IV 1990-08 with a month and year error of IV for III and 1990 for 1989 and a new TM of -08. By 30 III this was partly corrected, the month part only, as 30 III 1990-08 which is also found on the 31st. In April, the timemark was changed to -18 and is reported from 03 IV 1989. Another error occurs in June: 16 VI 2018-17 for 16 VI 1989. More reports are needed.



YELLOWKNIFE, NT error

An error occurs in June 1989. 03 V 1988. appears as a month and year error for 03 VI 1989. 04 was a Sunday. On Monday, the month was corrected but not the year and the 05 VI 1988. style appears until 13 VI 1988. (1989). 16 VI 1989. is corrected.

SUSSEX, NB timemark.

A timemark change occurred on 27 IV 1989 from -17 to -18. Shown below are LKU and EKU of these timemarks.



LA PRAIRIE, PQ timemark

A new timemark has surfaced back on 27 VI 1985, previously unreported, -15.



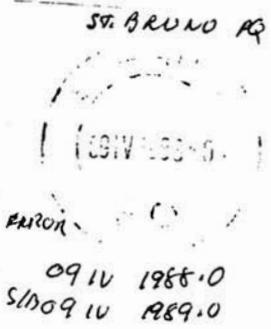

STEPHENVILLE, NF year error.

A year error occurs from 08 to 14 IV 1989 as 1980. What makes this error of more than passing interest is the possibility of getting matching timemarks on the same day in combination with the error, as shown above.

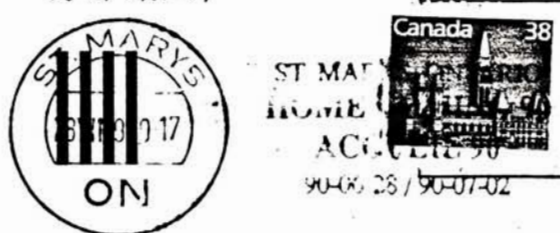
