Time to learn how to do the newsletter on the Macintosh. Bear with me, as I try to get the easiest-to-read results. Lots of news for this issue, and lots of reports.

BOLTON, ON, MILTON, ON, and SELKIRK, MB. On checking through controlled mail sources, I noted a severe dropoff of reports from these three Klüssendorfs.

BOLTON. This was one of the commonest K cancels. We have noted in a controlled mail sample the following numbers of reports in 1989:

Jan. 13	May 10	Sept. 4
Feb. 14	June 20	Oct. 3
Mar. 18	July 11	Nov. 2
April 10	Aug. 14	Dec. 0

In a conversation with the postmaster, I found out that local mail is still being cancelled with the Klüssendorf machine, but that out of town mail is going into the Gateway sorting plant in Mississauga. This is due to a shift of work by employees to sorting, counter, etc. due to growth of the area.

SELKIRK. The Klüssendorf cancels from this town were very common until about September 10, 1989. The postmaster reports that out of town mail is now picked up by a contractor and taken to the Winnipeg sorting plant and local mail only is cancelled at SELKIRK. Our controlled mail shows no cancels after Sept. 10/89 in September, one in October, and none in November or December.

MILTON. Reports from MILTON show a sharp decrease in the number of Klüssendorf reports. After being very common, this cancel showed up only three times in November and December in our controlled mail source. The reasons are the same as for BOLTON. Out of town mail is going to a sorting plant.

TRAIL, BC. I recently had an interesting run in with the postmaster at TRAIL, BC. On Nov. 22, 1989, I sent 3 covers to the postmaster there to receive the 1989 Christmas slogan cancels and requested information on the first day of use of the slogan cancel, for our records.

The 3 covers were returned by a Mr. Karakasis, Director, Stamps and Philatelic Products, Canada Post, Ottawa noting "I regret to inform you that there is no Klüssendorf machine in Trail, B.C." This letter was dated Dec. 20, 1989.

I wrote Mr. Karakasis on December 27, 1989 advising him that TRAIL did so have a Klüssendorf Christmas cancel and sent him a normal Trail K on cover to prove it.

I received a letter dated January 10, 1990 from Mr. Karakasis, apologizing for his misstatement that there was no Klüssendorf machine at Trail. He noted "After further investigation I learned that there is indeed a Klüssendorf in Trail, but no Christmas message was provided to it during the holiday period."

Needless to say, I responded on January 18, 1990, thanking him for his letter, pointing out that there was a TRAIL slogan at Christmas 1989, and sending him one to prove it.

I'll keep you informed with his next response. Ha! Ha!

(I sent for samples of the Trail slogan, too, but got back POSTAL CODE cancels instead, dated 13 XII 1989. ; kgs.)

CHRISTMAS SLOGANS - DIFFERENT TOWNS IN 1989.

The last day of use of the slogan cancel at PORTAGE LA PRAIRIE, MB this year was 1 I 1990, which was also the first day of use of the POSTAL CODE cancel.

And now for something completely different.....

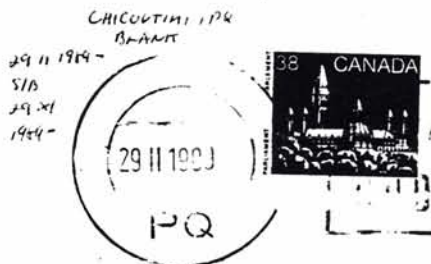
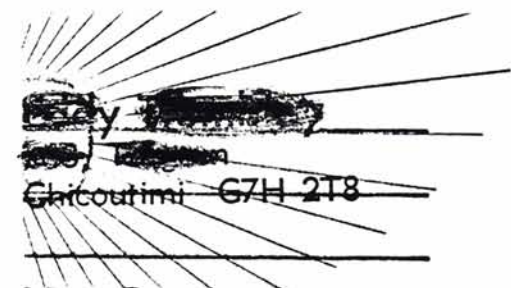
LA TUQUE, PQ. The missing town name at LA TUQUE is still reported in December 1989. Note that the top parts of some of the letters are visible. There is also an error reported with this odd type of strike, with 28-30 VIII 1988 BL for 1989.



CHICOUTIMI, PQ -A New Klüssendorf Usage

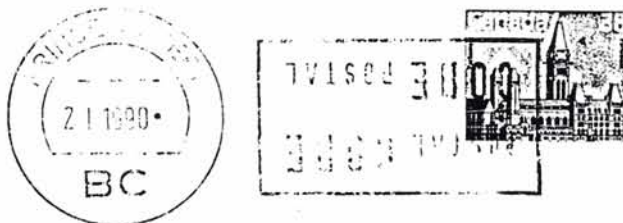
This town has an IPS machine. It appears that there were problems with the IPS, and many strikes are known with a black bar where the town name should have appeared. Then the IPS cancel is known with the black box with the date in centre.

It appears that this IPS machine was replaced temporarily by a Klüssendorf machine with no town name but with PQ at the base. It is similar to the LA TUQUE K but with the LA TUQUE K part of the top right of the town name is visible (see above). With the Klüssendorf used at CHICOUTIMI, it is completely blank. A couple have been found with Chicoutimi corner cards and return addresses. Two dates are known so far: 22 XI 1989 BL and 29 XI 1989 BL, an error for 29 XI 1989 BL. Perhaps one of our Quebec members could make some enquiries and let us know what is happening in CHICOUTIMI. In the meantime, watch for this one. It could become as scarce as one of our rarities.



PRINCE RUPERT, BC INVERT

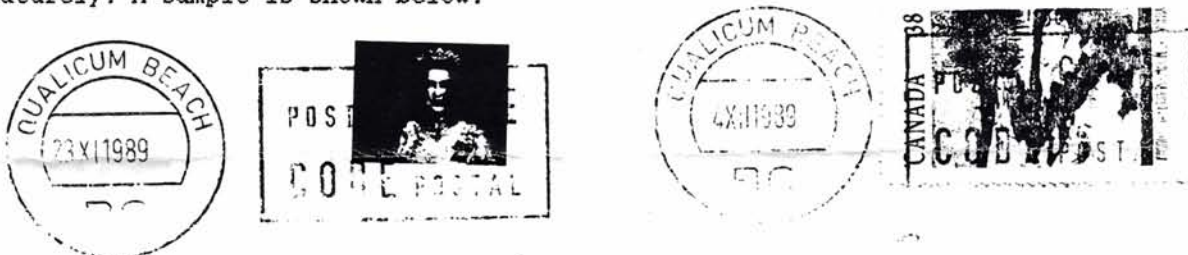
PRINCE RUPERT started the year with an invert, as noted in a recent report from Bill Robinson. 2 I 1990. had the inverted POSTAL CODE SLUG. This is also the earliest reported date we have at present for the POSTAL CODE after the slogan.



SLOGANS AGAIN. The PRINCE RUPERT postmaster has reported the first day of the slogan cancel as November 1, 1989. As we know, this is incorrect as we have at present reports of 20 and 24 October 1989. I assume that Nov. 1 was supposed to have been the start date but in error the slogan was put into use earlier.

The PORT ALBERNI postmaster reported that the EKD of the slogan was November 1, 1989.

QUALICUM BEACH, BC. Lots of reports and news about this town. In a letter to Greig Hutton, the P.M. noted that the first day of use was November 23, 1989. The covers that Greig received were sent out to QUALICUM BEACH on February 18, 1988 and sat from then to November 23, 1989 until they were serviced. Luckily, they were not lost or returned prematurely. A sample is shown below.



Jim Karr found a nice commercial usage of the first day of QUALICUM BEACH. Gord McDonald sent in an example from 4 XII 1989. ERROR. There is already an error to report from QUALICUM BEACH. A strike (below) shows the impossible date of 38 XI 1990 BL for 28 XI 1989. This is really a double error with 38 for 28 and 1990 for 1989.

CHANDLER, PQ Some strikes have shown up in late 1989 with what appears to be timemark 1 no dash. This is NOT a TM. There are no serifs on the 1 and it is the end of the date TM roller where it is overinked.

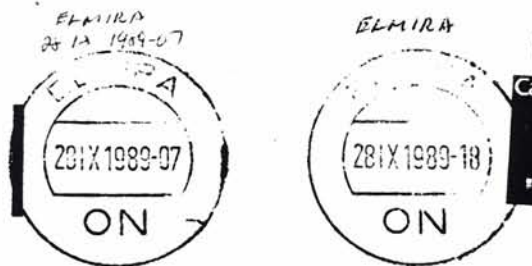

ELMIRA, ON. A new timemark is shown below for ELMIRA, with 28 IX 1989-07. This could be an error for TM-06 or it could be deliberate. Here is a matched pair, with this TM.



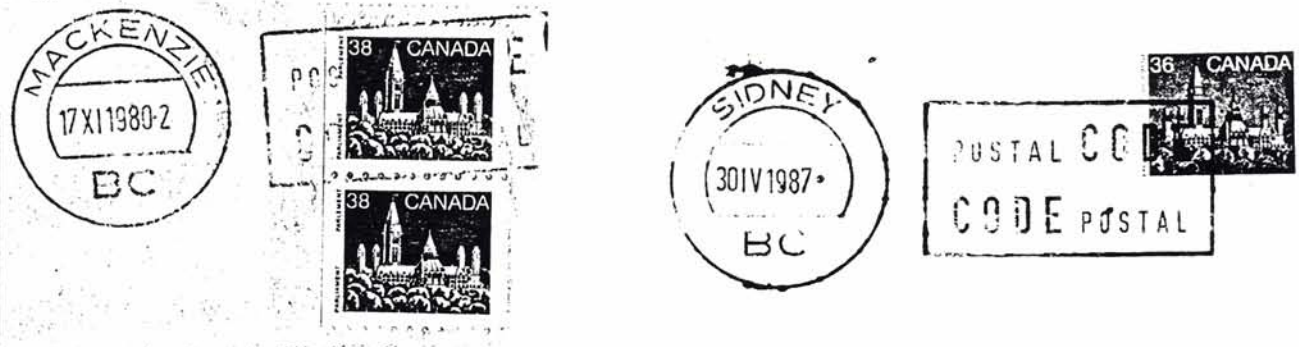
CORUNNA, ON.

Show below is a first strike from the red Christmas K of CORUNNA, ON which was in use during December. Unfortunately, we cannot show the red colour here. The period of use was December 1st to December 29th. After the 29th, CORUNNA returned to the usual black ink. Gordon McDonald sent in a report of a commercial CORUNNA dated 04 XII 1989-17. Gord also sent a generous \$10.00 donation to help defray the deficit in the expenses last year. Thank you very much, Gordon.



MACKENZIE, BC error.

Member Tracy Cooper reports a date error for MACKENZIE of 17 XI 1980-2 for 17 XI 1989-2. The error ran from 16 XI to 25 XI.



SIDNEY, BC. There's been a positive response to our SIDNEY covers, sent out with the Christmas Klüssendorfer. In future, if we get a chance and our budget allows it, we will try for more little things like this for our members.

Gray Scrimgeour reports another of the rare SIDNEY strikes. This is a local usage dated 30 IV 1987. A photocopy of it is shown above.

And now, GREEN.....

LISTOWEL, ON SURE AND BEGORRA, IT'S GREEN

The LISTOWEL, ON Paddyfest slogan is in use again this year. The LKU of the POSTAL CODE killer is 29 XII 1989-18. The EKU of the slogan is 02 I 1990-18. The postmaster planned to use GREEN ink with this cancel as it is a special Irish festival, but he reports "The green ink did not arrive but I put the slogan in as planned. Should the green ink arrive I will use it." The green ink did arrive, and the EKU for green is 08 I 1990-18 so far. It looks like the black cancel will be the scarce one, being used for only the few days until the green ink arrived. It is projected to use the green ink until the end of the slogan at March 17th. Despite the difficulty in getting suitable green ink (and an apparent oiliness to the ink), these cancels will be popular for years! Thanks to those who arranged this and carried it out.
