Just keep them coming - we'll have space for lots of news next time. Some highlights, of course, are included here.

The EKU-LKU TM List.

This list took many months to prepare. Allan has used all reference sources that he could find, to make the list as complete as possible. Please send in any additional material that you can. I have proofread the list a number of times, but with that much data, there's still a chance of mistakes. I will keep a copy of the list on hand for updating, which should be fairly easy with the Mac. In particular, please confirm any timemarks that you have from the column on the right (the list of unconfirmed timemarks).

Many references are included in the list. References to notes are shown in the first column, in parentheses after the town name; the notes are listed by letter below the listings. The references for the dates are shown by numbers after the dates, with the sources referred to being given on the last page, below the Notes. The underlining of timemarks indicates that this timemark is known only with an error date.

We hope that you will find this list useful. We recommend that you make a photocopy or two of the list, to mark up with your holdings. It should be suitable for timemark collectors, in particular. All of the material listed is in the public domain, so please feel free to quote the list - just give credit for the source: The Klüssendorfer - Newsletter of the BNAPS Klüssendorf Study Group.

The other list for this issue is the list of members of the study group. The continuous increase in the membership is encouraging.

The Klussendorfer

CHICOUTIMI, PQ. This K town is confirmed. They have a Klussendorf machine without a town name hub, used as a back up system (p. 139). It is being used in the interim while they wait to get their hub with the town name. Greig Hutton called the CHICOUTIMI post office and learned when the hub comes in, the post office name will be SAGUENAY, PQ.

LA TUQUE, PQ. The LA TUQUE hub being used still has no town name. The question arises - is this the original LA TUQUE hub? So little of the top part of the few letters remaining suggest this is not the original hub for LA TUQUE. I wonder what town hub it is that's been mutilated!

CHICOUTIMI & LA BAIE, PQ. The CHICOUTIMI machine is Serial #02272. This is the number of the LA BAIE machine. My charts show no recent strikes of LA BAIE, with my latest use May 23, 1989. Can you please report later dates.

ELMIRA, ON. A letter from the ELMIRA post office says that the use of TM -12 has been discontinued. Also, only TM -18, -06 or 6 are correct, and any timemarks not 6:00 AM or 6:00 PM are TM errors (like 09 I 1989-09 or 28 IX 1989-07). Therefore, we can state that timemarks 6, -06, -12, and -18 are normal, and -02, -07, -09, -13, and -19 are TM errors, as would be -05, an unconfirmed TM.

YELLOWKNIFE, NT. Kevin O'Reilly writes that the postmaster in Yellowknife wanted a K slogan for the 20th Arctic Winter Games, but was unable to get it. A rubber cancel was used instead.

LISTOWEL SLOGAN. The Irish Festival slogan (p. 142) EKU is 02 I 1990-18, in black. The LKU for black was 05 I 1990-18. The EKU in green was 08 I 1990-18. The green ink did not arrive on time, so for the first week of the slogan, black was used. Watch for this one - it could become scarce.

Classified Ads for Klussendorfs. I have a couple of ads ready, but there's no space this issue. Next time, members. Send in some more, for this new feature. Jeff Switt has suggested a great name for the column - K Mart.

An Expensive K Cover. Bob Lee's Sale #59 had a very desirable K cover, Lot 2528. The cover was franked with a \$2 Kluane stamp, a 3¢, and a 25¢ stamp. The Kluane was tied by a STE. ADELE, PQ K cancel (10 IV 1985-18). The interesting and expensive part is that the Kluane stamp is missing "CANADA and \$2."
