

STONY PLAIN - A NEW K TOWN! Jim Karr has sent a report of a new Klussendorf town, STONY PLAIN, ALBERTA. Jim has called it a hot flash, and I agree. A machine with serial number 02702 has been installed at STONY PLAIN, and its use appears to have started on December 3, 1990. The old machine - a hand-cranked IPS - was removed to the Foothills Division Office in Edmonton. A clerk at the STONY PLAIN office said that the arrival of the K machine was welcome, being just in time to speed processing the volume of Christmas mail. The clerk said that they are using a substitute ink, which Jim says probably accounts for the blotchy quality of the strikes. STONY PLAIN is a bedroom community of Edmonton, about 20 miles west of downtown. Present Status of Some K Towns

ACTON - Local use in late September 1990.

ANTIGONISH - Drop off in use September 1990.

AYLMER WEST - Last reported use 20 IX 1990-18. Favour cancel 29 XI 1990-18.

BOLTON - Local use only.

BOWMANVILLE - Discontinued. LKU 29 XII 1989-18.

- BRACEBRIDGE Dropp of in use in mid September 1990. Some use, balance to sorting plant.
- BRIDGEWATER Appears local use only from mid September 1990.
- COATICOOK Strikes much less frequently seen in 1990.

COBOURG - Local use only from mid September 1990.

DAUPHIN - Mid September 1990 most out-of-town mail to sorting plant.

DELHI - Discontinued. LKU is 07 IX 1990-18.

- DORION-VAUDREUIL Local use or discontinued. LKU 14 IX 1990-22 at present.
- DUNNVILLE Supposedly local use only but lots still coming through.
- ELMIRA Discontinued. LKU 20 IX 1990-18, but 3 X 1990-18 recorded on a favour cover dated 14 XI 1990-18.

FERGUS - Discontinued. LKU 20 IX 1990-18.

- GRAVENHURST From mid September 1990, decrease in strikes. Most of mail is now closed bag to sorting plant.
- HUNTSVILLE Mid September 1990, bag mail to sorting plant. Local use, and some still coming through.

- LACHUTE After September 1990, reduction in strikes. Appears most mail is going to sorting plant.
- LISTOWEL Discontinued, with LKU -2 X 1990-18.
- MAGOG Sharp drop in strikes from mid August 1990. A few strikes coming through. Appears most mail to sorting plant.
- MASCOUCHE Discontinued or local use. LKU seen is 08 IX 1990-17.
- MIDDLETON Mid September, most to sorting plant. A few still coming through.

MIDLAND - October 1990, decrease and much to sorting plant.

- NAPANEE Mid October 1990, decrease in strikes. Much to sorting plant.
- PARIS Discontinued LKU 07 IX 1990-18.
- PARRY SOUND Decrease in strikes from mid October 1990, much to sorting plant.

PORTAGE LA PRAIRIE - From mid September, local use only. Most to sorting plant, but a few still coming through.

- PORT ALBERNI Discontinued. LKU 08 IX 1990-09.
- PORT HOPE About 18 September 1990, local use only.

STE. AGATHE DES MONTS - October 1990, sharp decrease in strikes - possibly much to sorting plant.

- SELKIRK Local use only since mid September.
- SIMCOE Discontinued, with LKU 07 IX 1990-18.
- STRATHROY Discontinued LKU 20 IX 1990-19.
- TERREBONNE Discontinued or local use only. LKU 07 IX 1990-20.
- VILLE ST. GEORGES Sharp decrease in strikes in 1990. Appears most mail to sorting plant.
- VIRDEN Mid September 1990, local use only. Odd strike coming through. None in October or November, 1 in December.
- YARMOUTH Mid September 1990, local use. Most to sorting plant.

Dave Hanes has noted that Alliston, Borden, Collingwood, and Midland are still showing up in Barrie, as of January 7th, but there were no Bracebridge up to that time.

George Sangster was able to get K strikes from Collingwood only if he mailed letters on the rural route.

Murray Beckel says that Napanee is still using the K for all local mail, and was surprised to hear that out-of-town mail was getting the Scarborough machine cancel.

It was good to see some K collectors at Philex here in Toronto in January. There's always something new to talk about when we see each other! Hope some of the rest of you out there see each other once in a while, too. Some of us also get together at the St. Lawrence Hall bourse (usually every other Sunday). Maybe those that do come then could become an official study group of the new St. Lawrence Hall Postal History Society. As long as there's no newsletter to type....

CHRISTMAS SLOGAN - singular.


Contrary to the past two years, the only K town known to use the FIGHT LUNG DISEASE Christmas slogan in 1990 was PORTAGE LA PRAIRIE, MB. None of the other towns that had this slogan over the past few years has had strikes of the slogan reported so far. The LKU of the POSTAL CODE at this time is 28 XI 1990 BL. The reported period of use of the slogan so far is 04 XII 1990 to 28 XII 1990. Strikes of the slogan for 1990 will be much scarcer than in past years because most mail from Portage La Prairie is going to a sorting plant. Only a small portion of out-of-town mail is receiving the K cancel..

ST. ANDREWS, NB. A few strikes of this town have appeared in November and December 1990. The dates seen are 26 XI, and 03, 05, and 10 XII 1990-17. It appears that the K machine is getting a bit of service during the Chritmas rush, after no normal strikes were seen from February to October 1990.



199 ERRORS. One of the commonest errors in 1990 was the "199" year error, where the 0 was not put on the dial. A fair number of towns had this error - as reported in the Newsletter. Shown below are a few of these from ARNPRIOR, AYLMER, DRYDEN, PEACE RIVER, and RENFREW. This type of error was probably the most frequent for a number of towns. Eric Manchee reported two strikes of the RENFREW error on 11 XII 199 -09, and Allan has sent a copy of 27 XII 199 -09.

200 ERRORS. A similar sort of error found at a number of towns in the past 12 months was the year "200" error. Here are examples from HAWKESBURY and STE-MARIE BEAUCE.



A BRITISH KLUSSENDORF MACHINE!

A note in Linns of January 28, 1991 observed that the British Post Office has installed a Klussendorf machine at the official testing station at Swindon. The markings are experimental, and read KLUSSENDORF AG / K / 18-7-90-15 / BERLIN.

Gordon MacDonald not only sent in his dues, but also a little extra to help the kitty. Thanks, Gord. He also noted that he phoned a few offices around London with the following results:

GODERICH - Machine in use - all mail cancelled by K.

CLINTON - Machine in use - all mail cancelled.

INGERSOLL - Machine there, but use discontinued. All mail sent to London for servicing.

TILLSONBURG - Machine in use for local letters - since September 1990.

DAUPHIN, MB. The postmaster reported on December 12, 1990 that the K machine was still in use. Street collection is done six days a week, once a day. All local mail for area codes R0H, R0J, R0K, R0L, and R0M plus R1N, R7A, R7B, and R7N is cancelled locally and all other mail is sent to Winnipeg for treatment.

Jim says that the only seasonal slogan he saw for 1990 were PORTAGE LA PRAIRIE and CRESTON. His dates for the Blossom Festival span 2 V 1990 1 to 18 V 1990 1. Anyone else see any other slogans last year - besides Alexandria? Any other Christmas slogans? Jim sends the following items of recent Alberta Ks:





Jim also has sent this interesting material on <u>errors</u> at DRAYTON VALLEY in 1991. Saturday 26 I 1991 BL was fine. There were cancels of 27 I 1991, but this must have been in error as there is no Sunday mail service. Jim has a double strike: 27 I 1991 BL for the K, and 28 I 1990 (year error) for a meter. The P-B meter gives reasonable confirmation that the K is one day out. Jim has strikes of 28 (I 1991, presumably an error for Tuesday 29 I 1991. There are NO strikes for 29 I 1991, despite the fact that he has received 15-20 for every other day from his bulk mail source. Wednesday, 30 I 1991 is fine. The error of days of 27 to 28 would not show up without lots of mail!






Errors with odd timemarks





I've got lots of material on hand, which is a good thing because I'll be starting on Issue #15 very soon. Time flies by in the busy time of the winter. The first robin appeared on our street today (March 14th), so the rest of the spring birds should follow soon. That means end of term for me, with lots of exams to mark. It also means the start of summer school pretty soon. Holiday time planned is from the end of July - to go by car to Vancouver for BNAPEX in late August. Hope there'll be a K group meeting there. There's a Klussendorf meeting coming at Orapex, I believe.

Have just finished my monthly column for the UCRS (Upper Canada Railway Society) Newsletter. The PHSC Journal is on the way to the press, and the first articles have arrived for the next issue. See what happens when you buy a Mac? I get to read lots of postal history, etc.each month. Now, when will I have time to mount the rest of my covers for an exhibit at Vancouver?

AYLMER WEST, ON. The K is finished. The PM says the last day of use was Sept. 21, 1990. Allan's charts report use on the 17th, 19th, and 20th. Does anyone have the last possible date, the 21st? Currently, Aylmer West mail goes to a sorting plant in London. Hand-cancelled mail gets a POCON 390151/STN-SUCC. DATE/ AYLMER WEST, ON/N5H 7J0. LKU now is 20 IX 1990-18. There is a favour strike on a piece of paper, dated 29 XI 1990-18, which suggests that the machine is still there.

<u>TILSONBURG. ON</u>. The K was still in use but only for local mail, as of 30 XI 1990. Now tough to get copies.

<u>PORT COLBORNE. ON</u>. As of 29 XI 1990, the K was still in use, for local mail only. Other mail goes to a sorting plant. A new TM was in use, with 29 XI 1990-07.

<u>BEAMSVILLE, ON</u>. As of 30 XI 1990, the PM notes "we still use it every day" in reference to the K machine. Only on local mail. Other mail goes to Stoney Creek.

SIMCOE. ON. The EKU at present is 22 III 1984-18, with a supporting strike of 23 III 1984 reported. The present LKU is 07 IX 1990-18. TM -18 was used for the entire span here. There is a report of a BL timemark on 11 X 1984. TM -19 was used from 01 XII 1989 to 29 XII 1989. Only 2 errors have been reported: one 13 VI 1989-18 which should be 18 V 1989-18, and the other an impossible date of 31 XI 1986-18.

STRATHROY. ON. Another discontinued town. EKU is 14 III 1984-18, and LKU 20 IX 1990-19. No errors in almost 7 years. Only 3 TMs are reported. TM -18 was used from the EKU to 27 IX 1985. Then came TM -19, at present from 11 X 1985, until 20 IX 1990. TM -00 was used on 18 IV 1988, which is possibly an error as TM -19 is also known on this date.

<u>DELHI.ON</u>. Also discontinued. EKU is 06 III 1984-18, and LKU is 07 IX 1990-18 at present. The machine was picked up in October or November, says the PM. All mail goes to Stoney Creek, TM -18 was the usual timemark. Four invert periods! While cleaning up some stuff, Allan found an old article on Linns, April 2, 1984, with the following information:

Canada Post was replacing cancelling devices in about 500 post offices. Being replaced were about 320 Pitney-Bowes Model D and 180 P-B Model DD machines in small and medium post offices processing 2000 to 5000 pieces daily. Pitney Bowes could no longer supply parts for these machines which Canada Post rented so they were discontinued. 320 Model D machines were purchased from Klussendorf of Berlin, Germany to replace the P-B "D" machines. The distribution was 40 machines per month starting in Oct. 1983. The old machines are being returned to Pitney-Bowes. At this time the replacements for the DD machines had not been approved (the IPS machine).

The Sechelt, BC oddball cancel often confued with Klussendorf is a prototype by IPS (International Peripheral Systems) Model 4D2, an old hand machine which the company had motorized. This machine was turned down. Sechelt was "desparately" in need of a canceller and so the rejected prototype was purchased and sent to there. It will probably remain unique.

BOWMANVILLE, ON is another discontinued K. The postmaster informed Allan that he had not used the machine in 1990 and mail was being cancelled and sorted at Oshawa. It is now being sent to a Toronto sorting plant. The EKU is 06 I 1984-18. The present LKU is 29 XII 1989, an error of 1988. No 1990 strikes have been reported. The timemarks erported are -06, -09, and -18 in normal use and -00 and -17 on errors. There is an unconfirmed report of the. TM. The sequence is:

BORDEN, ON - WE LOSE ANOTHER K Dave Hanes told me yesterday that the post office at BORDEN is supposed to close on March 22, 1991. And there's the possibility that COLLINGWOOD will be changing or closing in the summer.

And an error from BORDEN:

Dave said that he's just obtained (in late Feb.) a K cover from BORDEN with the following error:

25 III 2002 08. Should be 25 II 1991 16. TM, month, year error.

The Klussendorfer is late this issue. The reason is simple - cold/ flu that has lasted 8 weeks, so far. I'm back to about 75% efficiency; 100% by next issue! Then there's overtime at work...
