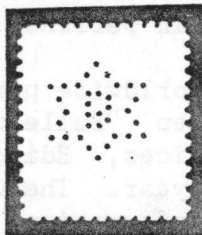
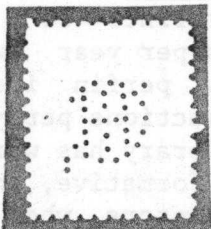


NEW PERFINS APPEARING SINCE 1973

This is a brief review of new perfins and new dies located since the 1973 Supplement to the Handbook and not mentioned in the February Perforator. Although the notes are brief, it will take more than one copy to complete the list. Much of the original work on the dies was done by Jack Brandt. Any comments and additions can be directed to the Chairman or the Editor. A preliminary note, not all the different dies can be spotted visually without practice. As the die differences are constant it will be easy to superimpose the perfins on the photos initially to properly review your perfins.



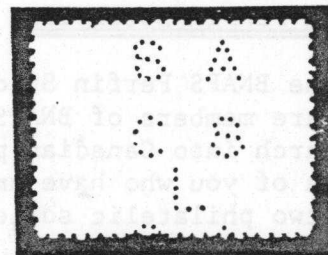
B1a. The 'B' is $\frac{1}{2}$ mm. wider than B1 with many other minor differences. The U.S. Catalogue lists two types, B15 and B15.5. Preliminary work indicated that the dates, B1 1903-1917 and B1a 1935-1939 applied to both countries.



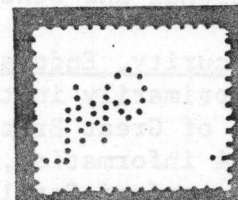
C12u. This is U.S. Catalogue No. C152H-7, International Harvester, Tulsa, Okla. (The photo is U.S. due to poor centering of the Cdn. copy.) The reported copy is on #350, owner J. Brandt.

C41. This perfin is now the first British perfin in Canada. 'CS/L/SA' is the Civil Service Supply Association Limited. It was found in a 1912 Customs stamp, owner J. Johnson. (The photo has had extra holes deleted as the stamp had three split perfins in it.)

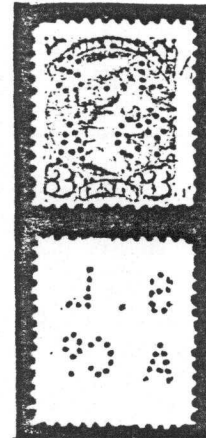


G13u. This perfin is similar but has many minor differences from G13. It is listed in the U.S. Catalogue as G201, unidentified. Stamps known; #231, 232, 254 & 326; only cancel, Halifax.

A NEW SMALL QUEEN

Up to a few weeks ago there was only three companies recognized as using Queen Victoria 'Small Queen's'. They are I1 (Intercolonial Railway, Moncton, N.B.), J5 (unidentified, Montreal, P.Q.), and W8 (W. J. Gage Co., Toronto, Ont.). The Editor has just seen stamp No. 41 perforated with S8 (Sun Life Assurance Co., Montreal, P.Q.) dated May 31/97. It should also be noted that S8 is the only perfin type to date, that has been found in the 20¢ and 50¢ Widow's Weeds. Do you have other information of Queen Victoria stamps that you can tell the group about?



OTHER PERFIN SOCIETIES

As the BNAPS Perfin Study Group is still growing I expect that most of you are members of BNAPS, partly due to BNAPS taking a lead in the research into Canadian perfins with the original Study Groups. For those of you who have an interest in perfins of other countries there are two philatelic societies who's primary interest is in perfins.

The Perfins Club is a society founded in 1943 and has worldwide perfin information and interests. The Perfins Club publishes ten "Bulletin's per year with articles, research, want & selling notices, Editor's notes, perfin Handbooks available and two auctions per year. The Club has a very comprehensive Library of world-wide perfin information and a separate Editor of Foreign Catalogues who has research work - sheets of perfin types for all countries that do not have Catalogues written on their perfins. The Perfins Club has maintained a membership of over 700 for the past two years and is still climbing so there are quite a few collectors to correspond with. Even for those collectors only interested in Canadian perfins this Society most likely would be very educational and beneficial to your collecting.

The Security, Endorsement & Perfin Society of Great Britain is interested primarily in the perfins, overprints and underprints of the stamps of Great Britain. SEPS publishes six Bulletins per year with general information, company perfin histories, new perfin identities, revised Catalogue pages in each issue and two auctions per year. Although the accent is on Great Britain perfins the Library has world-wide perfin information. Although SEPS can be very informative, membership in it is most beneficial for those perfin collectors who are considering taking a serious interest in Great Britain perfins.

COVERS CORNER by Michael Dicketts

I don't think I'll get much of an argument from anyone that there's nothing quite like a perfin on cover to add that extra something to one's collection. Even a mundane CNR (sorry Jon) when seen with an attractive corner address and, perhaps, the user's trade mark or logo stands out on an album page. The challenge is tremendous once you get past the BT's & railway covers, and while I've been collecting for some time now, I've a long way to go. I've often speculated on the maximum number of covers it's possible to own, and who has the largest collection. I know a few collectors with quite extensive holdings containing really scarce items, but all of us must own a few prized and distinctive covers. I invite those owners to share their treasures with the rest of us by submitting details and, preferably, a photograph to our editor for inclusion in a future issue of this publication.

A very few companies which owned perforators were acquired by a competitor or another owner but continued to use the old device to punch stamps. C17 and G16 are examples of this form. I have in my collection a copy of M15 on a 3¢ red Admiral on a cover bearing the return address of the Steel Company of Canada Ltd., Montreal, dated March 22, 1924. Although the handbook lists the life of M15 running to 1942 it can be assumed that for many years Montreal Rolling Mills was owned by Steel Company of Canada, but continued to use M15 rather than S6. Some cost minded person must have felt it a waste to scrap the old perforator and replace it with a new machine. Does anyone have other examples, perhaps in the 1940's to confirm these comments?

NEWFOUNDLAND PERFINS by Dave Hanes

Four Newfoundland companies perforated various stamp issues during the era that this practice was in common use. These companies were:

A4	Anglo-Newfoundland Development Co., Grand Falls	1911-1931
A8	Ayre & Sons, St. John's (15 mm wide)	1923-1943
A9	Ayre & Sons, St. John's (20 mm wide)	1897-1946
G4	George Knowling Co., St. John's	1911-1919

Several other perfin designs are found on Newfoundland stamps as well but not to the extent as the above. The years quoted behind each listed design is very misleading as it does not fully establish that every stamp design was actually perforated by the respective Company.

I have under taken the task of attempting to put together a checklist of stamps actually perforated by each of the above companies. Therefore I'm requesting the assistance of all members of the Study Group to report each stamp issue and each perfin design. This way, I hope, a fairly accurate list can be compiled. (Editor's note - mail information directly to Dave.)

Chairman's Comment: As I write this note the Study Group should now be over fifty participating collectors. This number of collectors of Canadian perfins represents a huge source of information which you have easy access to. This edition of the Perforator has the first Questionnaires attached, I hope you will complete them promptly and forward them to Joe Purcell. The Editor has planned to print the Questionnaire summaries in the May edition so you can see the information as quickly as possible. I will repeat that most of us are missing a lot of perfin types and negative replies are still important. There will be usually eight, sometimes twelve, questionnaires per month so that it should not take more than 30 minutes to complete them (time yourself on the 'A's). Do you have a favourite perfin type or certain stamp perfinned? Use the Perforator to find out what other collectors have. As the Study Group is young, you have the chance to be the first into just about every aspect of Canadian perfins.

The example above is for P10a (Province of Saskatchewan). A further explanation of what is required appears below, but first some general information.

- if you have no stamps of the perfin in question, draw a line throughout the complete Questionnaire;
- if you have no comments or information for a question in the Questionnaire, please draw a dash (-);
- if you would like to place your name on each Questionnaire sheet, please do so. This way if we have further questions on the information you have supplied, we can contact you.
- if the R.F. is 55 or above please list out the stamp number and the number of the stamps for each number that you have.


In the Questionnaire, Items 1 and 2 will be completed by the editor.


Item 3 - PERFORATOR LOCATION - is used if you have any information that would indicate that the perforator is located in a different location than in Item 3.

- Item 4 - FIRST ISSUE - is used to show the date of issue of your earliest stamp. Please note that the Admiral issue has different issue dates (e.g. if you have a 1¢ yellow admiral issued 06July22 and a 3¢ deep brown admiral issued 08June18, you would show the earliest issue date 08June18.
- Item 5 - FIRST STAMP NO. - is used to show the Canada Specialized Postage Stamp Catalogue stamp number for the stamp mentioned in Item 4. If you do not have a "Canadian Specialized" please use a "Lynams" or a "Scotts" catalogue but note the fact in Item 18 - OTHER COMMENTS.
- Item 6 - LAST ISSUE - is used to show the date of issue of your last stamp.
- Item 7 - LAST STAMP NO. - is used to show the stamp number for the stamp mentioned in Item 6.
- Item 8 - FIRST CDS CANCEL - is used to show the earliest cancellation with date and location that you have.
- Item 9 - LAST CDS CANCEL - is used to show the last cancellation with date and location that you have.
- Item 10 - NO. OF DIFF. CAT. NO. - is used to show the number of different stamps you have disregarding the different positions and duplications of the same stamp.
- Item 11 - TOTAL PERFINs - is used to show the total number of stamps including duplications and different position of the stamps that you have. If you have a large amount of the stamps, please show amount in two significant figure (e.g. 2,200, 310, 16,000).
- Item 12 - POSTAGE STAMP - indicate by a cross (X) which country you have Perfin on. If it is on another country not mentioned, please make a note in Item 18 - OTHER COMMENTS.
- Item 13 - REVENUE STAMPS - indicate by a cross (X) which revenue stamps you have if possible, use Sissons catalogue for this. If you use others X please make further notes in Item 18 - OTHER COMMENTS.
- Item 14 - AIRMAIL & SPECIAL DELIVERY - is used to list the stamp number of each different airmail & special delivery you have based on "Canadian Specialized". If you use a different catalogue, please note it in Item 18 - OTHER COMMENTS.
- Item 15 - COILS - is used to list the stamp number of each different coil stamp.
- Item 16 - TAGGED - indicate by a cross (X) if you have any Winnipeg or general (Ottawa) taggings on stamps. Please list catalogue numbers.
- Item 17 - PRECANCEL - is used to list the precancel stamp numbers with their identifications that you have. If possible, use "Walburn's" Precancel Catalogue for this.
- Item 18 - OTHER COMMENTS - is used for information that cannot be included above. If you run out of space, please use additional paper but note the Perfin number that the information is for. If you have this Perfin on cover or covers, please list all information about the covers, or send in a xerox copy of the covers.


