I am enclosing my copy of HI or IH whichever you wish to call it. My first thought was that it looked like the HI of CHI, International Harvester. But on further study found some discrepancies. There are only 3 holes in the I, whereas there are 5 holes in the I of CHI.

There are 6 holes in the vertical sides of the H, whereas there are only 5 in the H of CHI. BUT, the 2 extra holes line up with holes 2 and 5 of the C of CHI (or holes 11 and 14, depending on which way the stamp is superimposed on CHI.

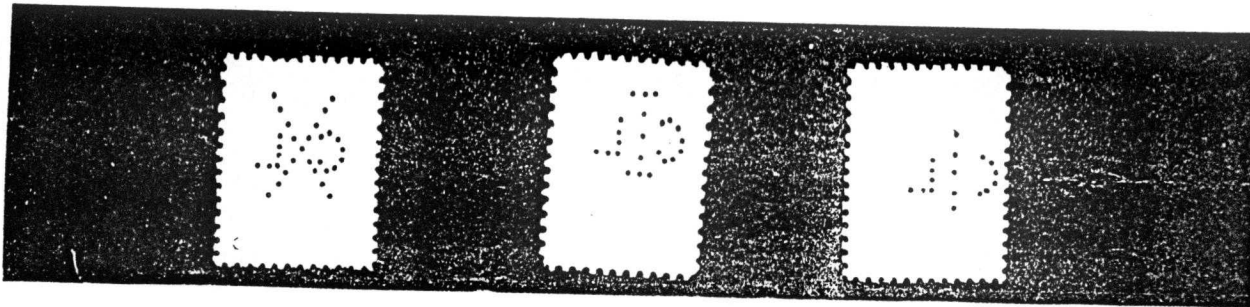
I know of 3 other Admirals with the same perfin. Floyd McNey has two, Jon Johnson has 1.
