This can be proved based on the steady increase in the prices realized for A and B rated patterns as well as scarce stamp issues. The Lee sale saw Patterns D10 - DXN and J10 - JR/C each sell for \$280, A6 - ATF/Co for \$160, J4 - JEP/SON for \$150 and F3 - (FD) Square for \$140. As for individual items, the 15c Large Queen with the W10 - WJG sold for \$500 and the companion 10c Small Queen sold for \$160. Please note that to each of these prices a 10% buyer's fee and 7% GST must be added.

Both Lorne James and I (the only Perfin Study group members in attendance) were often out bid by "The Book" but occasionally picked up items that had no or low opening bids.

Anyhow, I did manage to add some nice new items to my collection so the experience was worth it. Now on to other issues. I continued to have a busy May by attending the Royal '95 show in Quebec City with my wife (our last trip as a couple). I found the show and the city both rewarding. In addition to winning a Vermeil for my Canadian Official Perfins, I had the pleasure of meeting some of the other members of our Study Group including Jean Guy Dalpe, Don Wilson and Wally Gutzman.

My begging has finally paid off and I now have enough information to put together the next two or three Perforators. However, please do not stop sending me articles and information, the more I have the better the quality of these newsletters.

As for the issue at hand, it contains the "A" and "B" portion of the "ABC" Perfin Survey that was compiled by Lorne James (part "C" will appear in a future issue.) Chairman's Chatter

I was going to change my format a bit for this issue and have less chatter and instead a couple of articles, but as the saying goes "the road to hell is paved with good intentions" and that is where I must be headed as I've been too busy to carry through.

It was gratifying to have received responses to the requests for a one frame display on behalf of the Study Group for BNAPEX95 and to update the Perforator index.

The first letter was received from our farthest away member, Barry Clarke of Whangarei, New Zealand. I must quote his first paragraph as it gives our Perforator a pat on the back. "May 12 newsletter arrived half an hour ago and as usual I stopped for a coffee break to read it." Barry by the way will be attending BNAPEX95. He enclosed photocopies of his 16 page display which was on the theme of Harvesting tied into the International Harvester Company and their perfins.

I laid out the sheets to get an idea of how the display would look and after careful study had to make a judgement call based on BNAPEX95 Exhibition rules which state that "the Exhibition is restricted to British North American material." I took this to imply that it was also applicable to the Study Group exhibits and thus I regretfully had to decline Barry's offer as only 25% of the perfins were BNA.

It would have been a good display on behalf of the Perfins Club of the USA. However as I explained to Barry, all was not lost as the Edmonton Stamp Club was having an exhibition at the same time and had an Adult Single Frame Exhibit, unclassified category and I encouraged him to enter his display in that. He wrote to say that he was not going to enter it, which I feel is unfortunate, but we must all make our own decisions.

The next letter was from Barry Senior of Terrace Bay, ON. He offered to prepare a Perforator index for the period Jan. 1/89 to Dec. 31/94. What is particularly pleasing about Barry's offer is that he previously volunteered to update the Newfoundland survey, which we had to decline, as Russ Deveau was carrying on with that. Yet that didn't turn Barry off from volunteering a second time and we are pleased to accept his offer. There will be a bit of a delay however as Barry is a relatively new member and only has 4 issues of the Perforator, so I will have to photocopy what he needs and send them to him, but I'm a bit strapped for time, however it will get done.

Our sincere thanks to these two members for their willingness to help.

I hope to see as many Study Group members at BNAPEX95 as possible in Edmonton - September 1 to 3. We will be holding a Perfin Seminar on Saturday, September 2nd at 2:30 pm. At this time, we will elect our Study Group officers for the 1995-96 year. We will also conduct as much other business as time allows.

Post Discovery

What to Do After Discovering a new Pattern by Steve Koning

Part of the fun of collecting Canadian perfin is the discovery of new material, which still exists "out there".

One of our Study Group's objectives, according to our Constitution is "to add information to that now in the Perfin Handbook which is of interest to perfin collectors and other speciality collectors."

To find a new pattern is a big thrill and probably a faster way to get an "A" Rarity Factor, than to try and buy one at an auction, where good ones may cost over \$200. Part of this thrill is sharing this discovery with other perfin collectors, but the catch here is that there is an official way to do this.

To have a new pattern type authenticated, a perfin number issued and listed in the next edition of the handbook, it is necessary to send the actual stamp by registered mail (it will be returned that way) to Jon Johnson. If it is found to be genuine, then it is listed. The circumstance of the find should also be given. Then the finder may report his find and brag as much as he/she likes to other members via our "Perforator".

The other type of new find is of a new item to be included in the handbook's checklists of revenues, airmails, postage dues, precancels, special delivery, and coils. These checklists are found at the back of our 4th Edition handbook. Before reporting such a find in the "Perforator". Please send a photocopy of the front and back of the stamp, with details of the find's circumstances to Jon Johnson. If found authentic, it will be listed in the next edition of our handbook.

I am indebted to Mark Fennell and Jon Johnson for this information, which I hope will lead many members to compare their collections with the checklists in the handbook, so our next edition will be as up to date as possible.

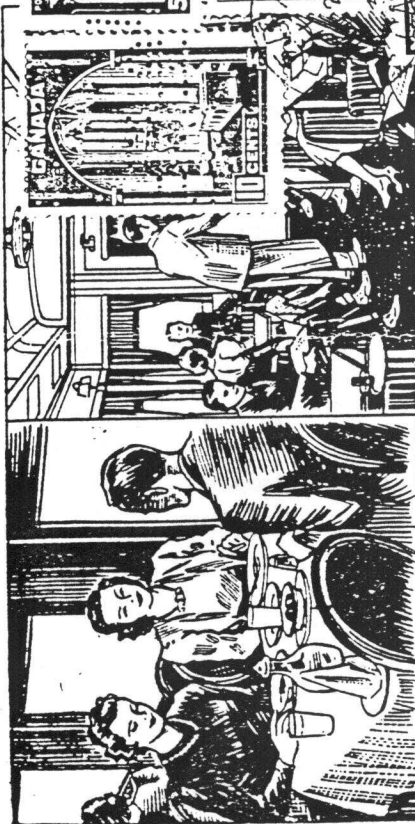
C46 Perfin on First Flight

ABC Rarity Factor Survey

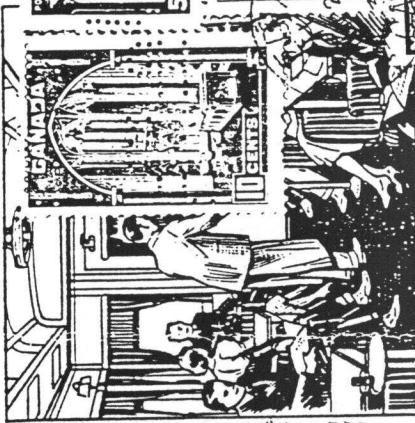

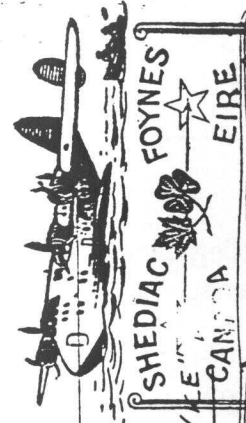

ABC Perfin Survey

PURPOSE: At the 1991 Study Group Meeting there was discussion concerning the number of perfins that had been showing up as a result of the handbook publication and the high auction prices these perfins were yielding. We knew of instances where only two stamps might have been known at the time of publication and their number had doubled, or conversely their scarcity cut in half. This survey is an attempt to update this information and to publish the results for all who participate. Anyone may use the results with the caveat that as there were not as many participants in this survey as the one which led to the handbook, therefore scarcity cannot be assumed where there are no reports and the handbook is still the reference.

FORMAT: The survey is divided into three parts, rarity factor A, B, and C. An asterisk (*) next to an entry indicates this information was culled from previous surveys and added by the editor who has access to the old information. The survey without the asterisk marks is a "footprint" of the study group holdings when the reports were filled out, late 1992 to mid 1993.
