OUR NEW "AUCTION-ONLY" FORMAT!!



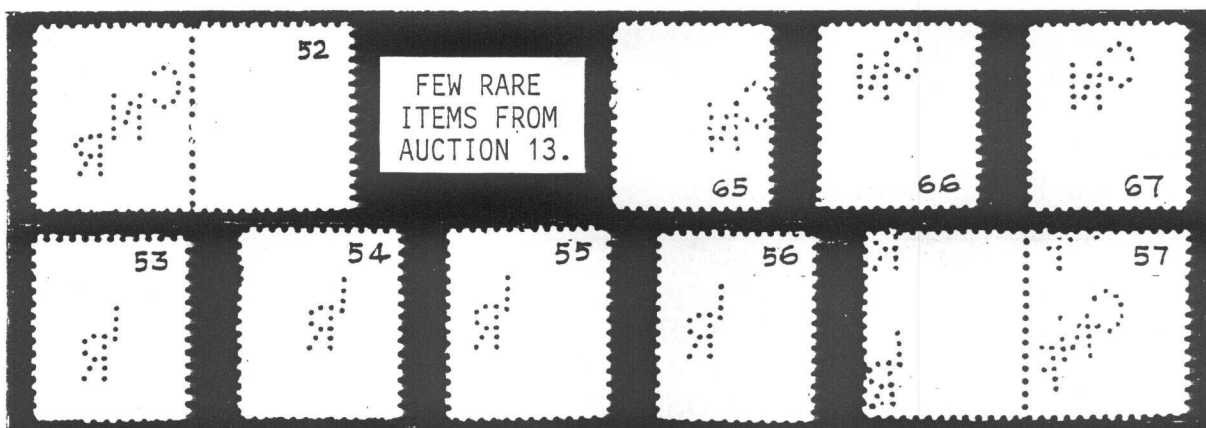

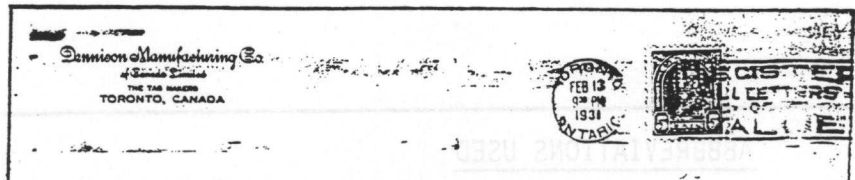
This, understandably, can be quite frustrating for Conrad as although retired, he plans the auctions around other activities and commitments.

We receive the printed listing and think nothing about the background of its making.

Our auctions present an excellent opportunity to obtain individual items at reasonable prices without having to bid on bulk lots for which there is no need for most of the material in our collections. If you haven't previously bid, I would suggest you seriously consider so doing and thus support Conrad in his efforts and, if a successful bidder, enhance your own collection.

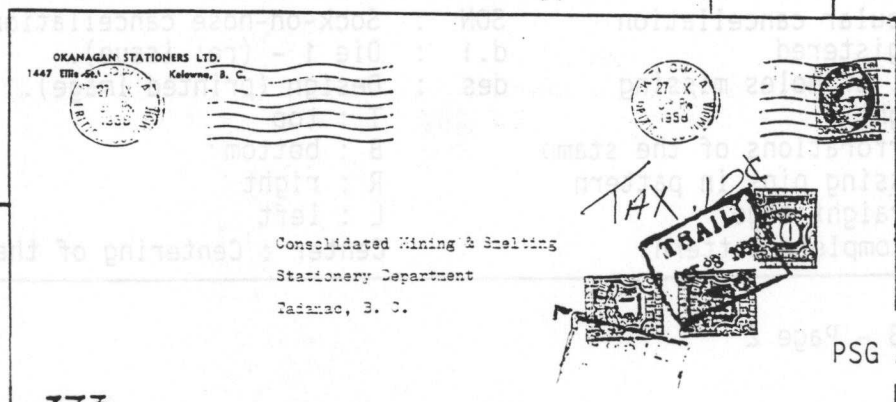

PERFIN STUDY GROUP AUCTION No. 13

Welcome to the 13th PSG Auction.

You will find 381 lots in this auction, including 10 large lots and 10 covers. Again I am offering for sale another portion of the collection from one of our club member - starting from the pattern P14 to R8 - described in the lots 153 to 275 plus the large lots No. 369 to 371. As usual, many rare items are offered in this auction.

All the lots photographed have an estimate value of 10\$ or over, and they are reduced to 50% to save space. Bids lower than 75% of the estimate value will be declined.

Lots must be paid for or returned within THREE (3) days of receipt.

Successful bidders will be notified by mail. All lots with a 100\$ value or more will be sent by registered mail. Mailing cost will be paid by the buyer. Bid by lot number
