Canadian Northern Railway

The two postal cards illustrated privately on the front with different scenes for Canadian Northern Railway are the only known views for Canadian Northern Railway on the King Edward cards.

Meeting recently with Chris Ellis and comparing our two cards, we were surprised in the colour difference of our two cards. The colours of these two cards are listed as green and black (NTH 3 & NTH 4) in the 7th edition of Webb's postal stationery catalogue. But we think the difference in colour in each design of our two cards warrants a separate listing in the catalogue.

The first card in blue green has "Form 505 Cashier's Office Winnipeg Oct. 29 1914" on the back and the card beside it "Form 905 Freight advice". (unused card)

The second card in blue green has "Form 1098 Freight Claim Department Winnipeg 2-3 1914" on the back and the card beside it "Form 905 Freight advice Wpg Station 3-7-1913".

Canadian Northern Railway was incorporated in 1899 and acquired by the Government in 1917, (CNR in 1923) but kept the corporate identity until 1956.

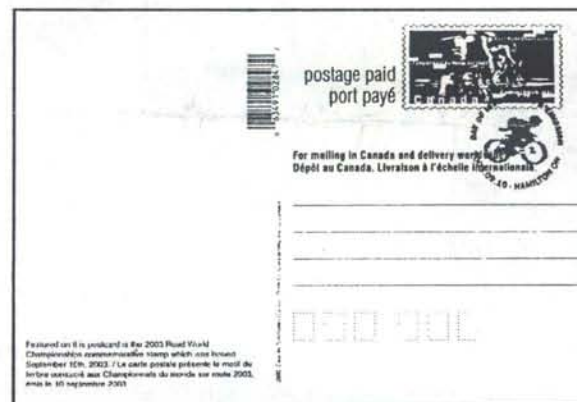

CARDS

A prepaid postcard "For mailing in Canada and delivery worldwide" was issued with the same stamp impression as the "Road World Championships" postage stamp issued September 10, 2003, but with no value showing. The same blurred racing competition design is also shown in a larger format on the reverse of the card.

The road race competition takes place in Hamilton, Ontario on October 6 - 12, 2003.

Andrew Chung was able to get some of these cards cancelled "first day of issue" on September 10, 2003.

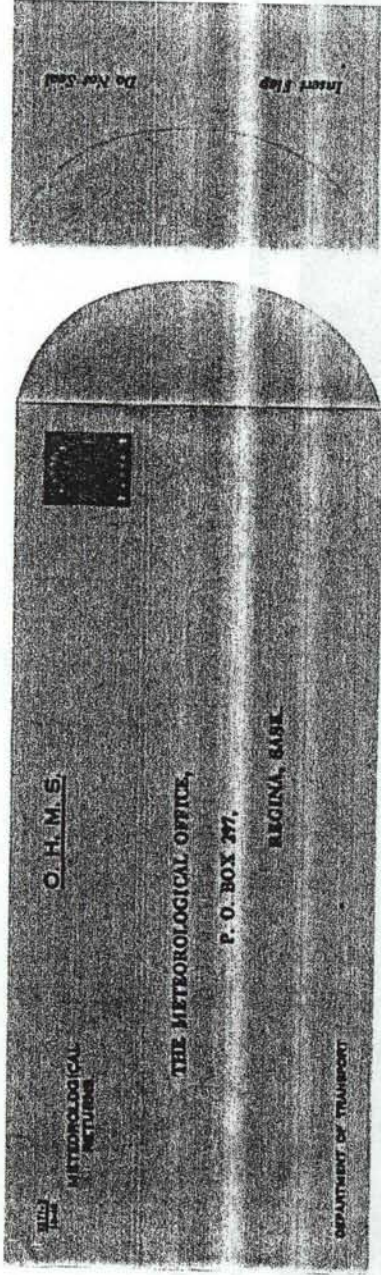

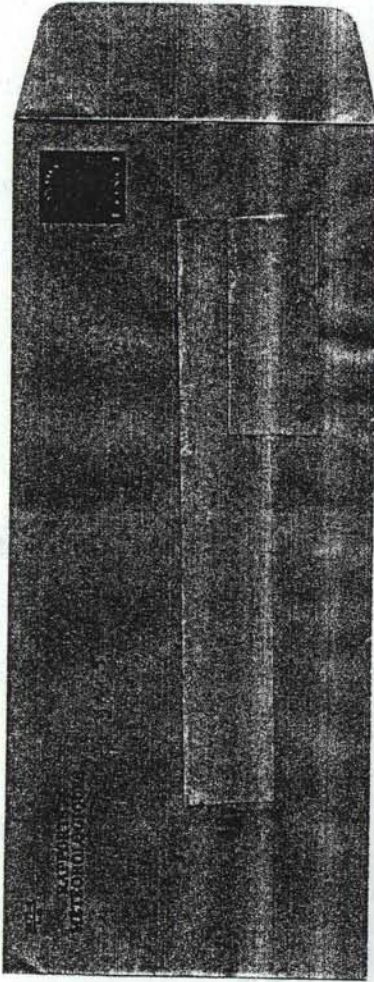
