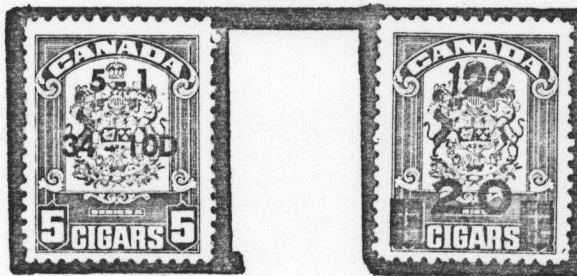

It appears that "Series C" stamps have some very small letters hidden in the design which may or may not be engravers initials. There are 2 or more letters which usually appear in the right or left hand scrolls. The letters enclosed in parenthesis following the listed stamp indicates those letters found on that denomination.
