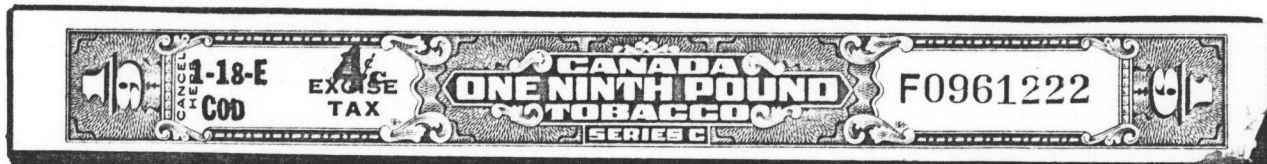

Surcharged with 3 mm blue "4¢" over 4 mm red pica capitals in 2 lines. Old 2¢ rate cancelled with a 4 X 4 mm blue slug.

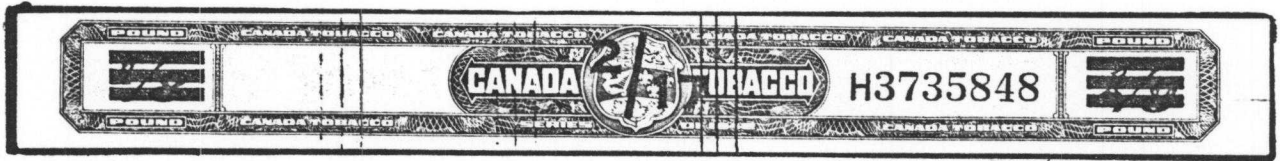

CUSTOMS STAMPS

242X 20 MM

1880 - 85

The stamp design is similar to 1880 Manufactured Tobacco Strip Stamps which have the City Code in the small panel at right center. There are 3 basic types, Division Open for general use, Montreal Division and Toronto Division. The stamps are coarse roulette and perforated 12 on block type watermarked or unwatermarked wove paper. All stamps are blue with 4 mm blue control numbers or otherwise noted. The word "ENTRY" appears in bottom of value panel at left or otherwise noted. Length varies from 240 to 244 mm.
