NEWFOUNDLAND TOBACCO TAX PAID STAMPS

The Newfoundland Tobacco Tax Paid Stamps have proved to be quite scarce and have been difficult to locate, as no one collection contained near all the varieties. In fact, it seemed that if a collector owned only fifteen or twenty stamps, he would have some particular major or minor variety that no one else had, or he would provide bits of information that were previously unknown to this collector.

Mr. Edward A. Richardson made an extensive study of these stamps some years ago and he was kind enough to make all his notes and information available for this project.
