

All of the Newfoundland Tobacco Tax Paid Stamps were found to be on white wove. unwatermarked paper. Dimensions given are for the frame lines of the stamp only. Does not include the imprint.

## CIGARETTE STAMPS

## FIRST ISSUE - 1904 KING EDWARD VII IMPRINT: "BRITISH AMERICAN BANK NOTE CO. OTTAWA" 24-1/2 X 42 MM

This first issue has what we believe to be a retouched die. There are several differences, but one easy to detect has to do with the 1 mm wide side panels just inside the frame line. With the original die, the panels have seven vertical lines with strong horizontal lines. The retouched die has ten vertical lines and very weak horizontal lines. For easy identification, they will be distinguished by the notation O-D and R-D.

NT-102 15 on 10 cig., double lines "15", pica "CANCELLED" at top, no "s" after "15", O-D NT-102a - double lined "15" with apostrophe and "s" after "15", O-D NT-103 15 on 10 cig., single lined surcharge with pica "CANCELLED" across top, O-D NT-104 14 on 10 cig., single lined surcharge with pica "CANCELLED" across top, O-D NT-104 - same without "CANCELLED" across top, O-D NT-104 - same without "CANCELLED" across top, O-D NEWFOUNDLAND CIGARETTE STAMPS - 1904 PROVISIONALS - CONTINUED

Surcharged with 21 X 9 mm red-violet "100" across upper half of stamp on NT-101d

NT-105 100 on 10 cigarettes, lilac, perf 12, R-D


Surcharged with 3mm purple or lilac Gothic "100" and 6 X 22 mm slugs to delete old values on NT-101d.

NT-106 100 on 10 Cigarettes, lilac, perf. 12, R-D

SECOND ISSUE - 1907 KING EDWARD VII 25 X 42 MM

This design is very similar to the 1904 issue. The small side panels all have light cross lines. The green color varies from yellow-green to blue-green. Imprint - same as 1904 issue

NT-108 100 Cigarettes, green (shades), perf. 10-3/4 NT-108a - perf. 12



Surcharged with black manuscript "20" or "50" and pica "CANCELLED" across top.

NT-110 20 on 100 cigarettes, green, perf. 10-3/4 NT-111 50 on 100 cigarettes, green, perf. 10-3/4 NT-111a - manuscript "CANCELLED" at top

Surcharged "FIFTY - CIGARETTES" with 3 mm black Roman letters

NT-113 50 on 100 cigarettes, green, perf. 10-3/4, reading down NT-113a - reading up

Surcharged "14" with black single line 16 mm Gothic figures and pica "CANCELLED" across top. No apostrophe "s" after "14".

NT-115 14 on 100 cigarettes, blue green, perf. 10-3/4

Surcharged "15" with single lined black figures between two horizontal bars. Size of overprint and distance between bars varies 1 or 2 mm. Pica "CANCELLED" across top.

NT-116 15 on 100 cigarettes, green, perf. 10-3/4
