Here we go again with the March Newsletter. I have been kept quite busy in February, what with filling 7 orders for the Revenue Group publications and taking out four days to go to the Bissons sale in Toronto. At the sale there were fourteen Revenue Group in attendance.

The total of the sales in the Revenue section amounted to \$48,000, quite a nice tidy sum.

There was quite spirited bidding on some of the items. The six \$2 inverts of the third bill issue were sold as one lot and brought \$4000, to a non revenue member "Bob Cunliffer" of Pittsburg. Bob is a collector of inverted stamps.

The 1765 embossed Revenues were all purchased by one buyer, "Sam Nickel" one of our members. The price \$5300. Poor me I really wanted the 6d. Well you can't win them all.

I also missed out on the British Columbia 25¢ imperforate between R25a, price \$185. Well, Adolph Koepell, if you don't want this I will happy to take this off your hands. I did get the vertical strip of three (R25b) \$185.

A few highlights; R36a - \$210. (I liked this, but didn't get it). 1876 - 15¢ - 4 1/2 mm control number - R89a brought \$100. Gas inspection 60¢ rouletted, \$165. Custom Duty R218, \$120. 1915 5 on 2¢ (2 leaf), \$200. 25¢ War Savings stamp in French #33, \$650. Consular Fees 25¢ to 25, \$160. Alberta R26a, \$165 (I needed this one also). British Columbia R47a, \$330. Newfoundland Transportation Tax R46, \$525. Ontario R51a - 55a, \$110 (I got lucky) The 5¢ Saskatchewan Inverted, \$250. Also there was good action on the Supreme Court and IN PRIZE items.

The collection of Canadian Tobacco stamps sold for \$1300 to our member Bill Walton. The collection of cigarettes went to our member Ed Morris (the owner of the only known copy of the 3 cig series C) for \$60.

There were some very beautiful and elusive proofs and essays in the sale. I had hoped for a few of these lots, but our members nickel and Bileski took care of all of these.

So, I didn't get too much, altho I did stop at our member George Wegg's shop and was fortunate enough to get the \$1 Newfoundland watermarked, a 2¢ R230 overprinted squares, plus a few Ontario Law stamps mint (thank you George).

All told it was a very pleasant trip. I enjoyed meeting some of our members at the sale, especially those who I had never had the pleasure of meeting before.
