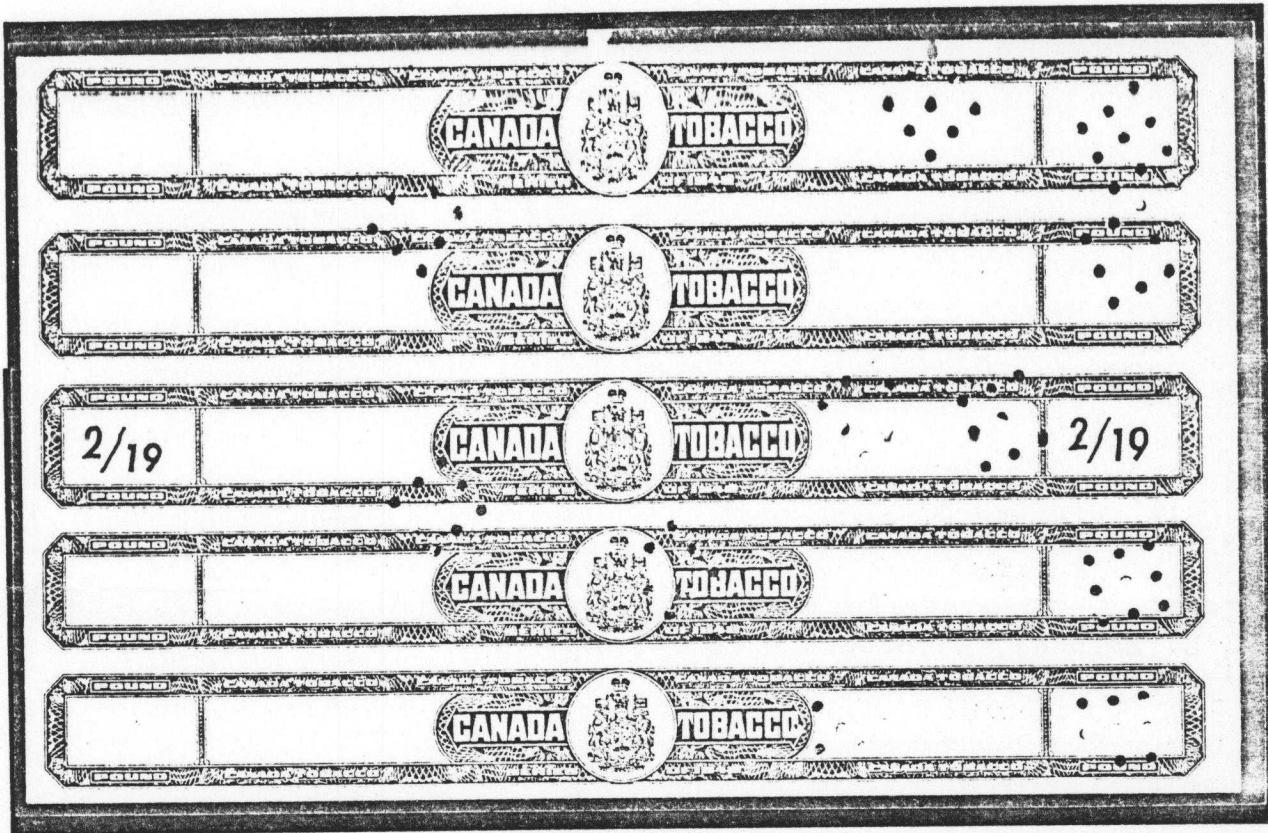

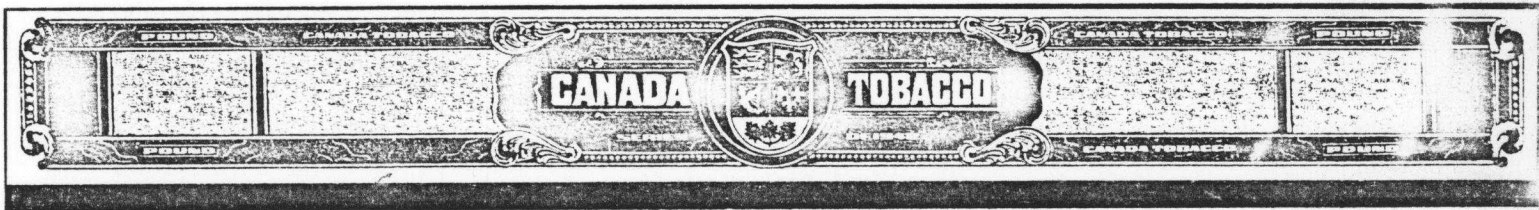

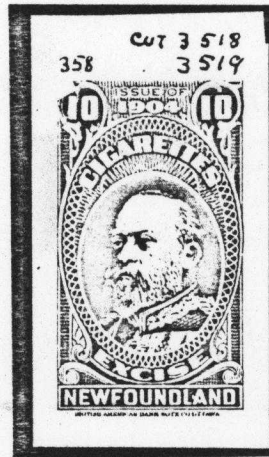

No prices are shown for the Die Proofs as none are available for purchase. In most cases we have the die number and the roller number. Some of the items shown were apparently never printed or used, at least this collector did not find any at the time the first edition of the catalogue was compiled.

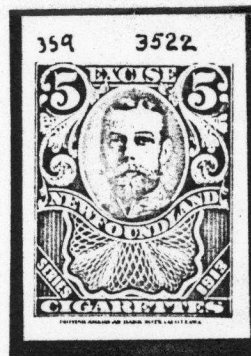

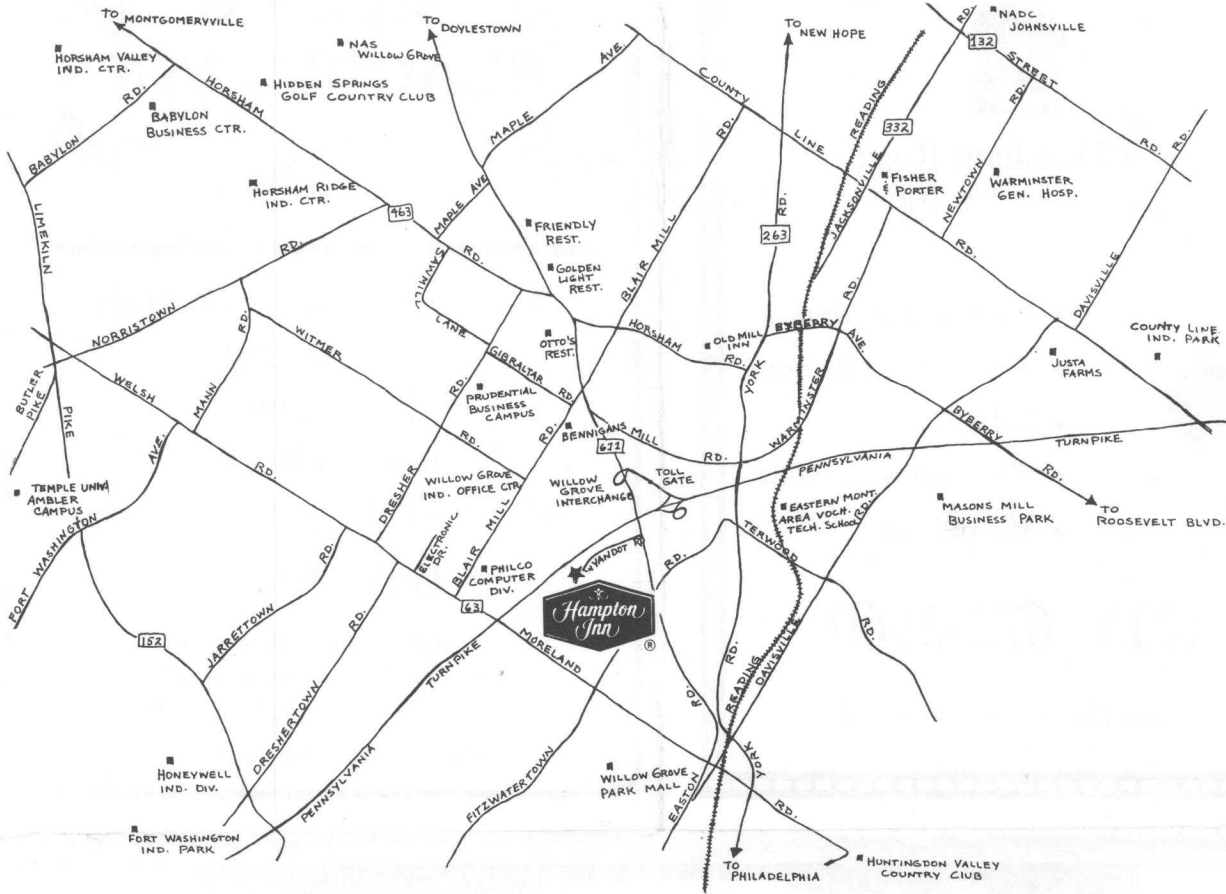
