left verticle perf. 12, right verticle perf. 11½, control

0197. My copy of the \$1 is 0197 it measures on the Kieszalas gauge

horizontal 66, left verticle 67, right verticle 68. Interrelating

to Stanley Gibbons Instanta gauge - 66 = 11.92, 67 = 11.75,

68 = 11.58. As the sheets were numbered horizontal, we would have

numbers 0182, 0187, 0192, 0197 with left verticle 67 and numbers

0181, 0186, 0191, 0196 with right verticle 67. Ed Richardson

had a copy with these three different perfs. but I don't know the control #.

Would you take a few minutes to check your copies of the \$1 and \$5 for the 11 3/4 perf on the verticle or 11.58 on both sides and send the information to me with the control # and denomination
