



This work is an anthology reprint of a series of 106 columns which appeared under the logo "Revenue Unit" in The American Philatelist between February 1928 and January 1942. While many of the individual articles were written by the editors themselves, specialists such as Applegate, Beaumont, Bedford, Holcomb, Joyce, Konwiser and others are fully represented. A Preface, Subject Index and Author Index by Richard F. Riley have been added which greatly facilitate usage.

The Subject Index divides the material included into the following groups: FIRST ISSUE: 1862-71, SECOND ISSUE: 1871, THIRD ISSUE: 1871-2, ISSUE OF 1875-8, ISSUE OF 1898, 1914, 1940-41, CIGARETTE TUBES, CITY AND STATE REVENUES, PLAYING CARDS, PRIVATE DIE PROPRIETARIES, TAX PAID AND U.S. POSSESSIONS.

This hard bound anthology encompasses 237 pages. It is for the specialist who already has an excellent working Revenue Library and who seeks to include the difficult-to-obtain articles provided by this publication.
