Reflections- - - - WHY ?

It seems in the last year there have been many top flight Canadian Revenue items and collections come on to the market.

It seems everytime I see an auction catalog there are revenue items I have not seen before.

Of course, back in 1972 Jim Sissons said there are many items which are grossly underpriced and when the prices reach the right level then these stamps will be offered for sale. Maybe this is the time? Perhaps there are more of these rarities than we know of.

Take the \$100 Caribou of Newfoundland. Back in 1952 Marks price was \$18. However you couldn't purchase this for none came on the market. 1964 Sissons catalog listed this at \$250, still none of these showed. 1969 Sissons catalog price \$1000 now they appeared. 1978 Sissons catalog price \$500.

In the Richardson sale by Maresch a block of 6 sold for \$1050 or \$175 per copy if divided by 6.

So, what does this all mean? Myself I collect Canadian Revenues as a Hobby. I buy items I can use for my collection. If I need a stamp and it is within my budget, I buy it with no thought of making an investment. Many times I am asked by a collector if a certain item is worth X number of dollars. My answer, do you want this for your collection? If you can afford it, buy it. After all, this is a Hobby.
