FIRST ISSUE BILL STAMPS - TWO PLATES FOR THE 3¢ DENOMINATION?. An examination of copies of this value revealed that there were 'large' as well as 'small' stamps. Going to multiples it became clear that the gutters between the stamps, both vertically and horizontally, had been widened substantially on some of them. There is no question but that two different plates were in use to produce this value. Clearly dated copies of the 'large' stamps appear to have been used in, or after, 1866 suggesting that the early printings had the narrow gutters and they were widened to facilitate perforating. Further evidence is needed.
