Third Issue Bill Stamps - Perforating Errors. Imperforate side margins on the 1/2 value. An imprint block of six showing the left margin without perforations and an Imprint block of nine showing the RIGHT MARGIN imperforate. This is the result of a sheet having been fed into the perforating machine in an inverted position.







A similar situation exists with the 30¢ value which is not cataloged. The single shows the same BLIND PERF that appears on the 4¢ and it is marked with a Red dot. A vertical pair has the left margin imperforate. An imprint strip of 4 of the 30¢ shows the first two stamps imperforate at the bottom but this is due to a fold in the sheet.
