1868 THIRD ISSUE BILL STAMPS - OVERPRINTED N. S.

All values of this Issue were overprinted N.S. for exclusive use in Nova Scotia, due to a slight differential between the Canadian dollar and the Nova Scotia dollar. All values from the 1¢ through the 50¢, with the exception of the 5¢, are shown on the "PELURE" paper. Every item has been checked and has the 'original', not the counterfeit, N.S. overprint. The strip of five of the 3¢ value is definitely a February 8, 1868 item and it may be compared with the most unusual document on another page dated 7 Februry 1868. The reverse of a stamp illustrates the appearance of the "PELURE" paper. The rare Rough Perf 13½ 20¢ is seldom seen dated.

1868 THIRD ISSUE BILL STAMPS - OVERPRINTED N. S.

This draft, drawn by Stephen Tobin, Mayor of Halifax and Chairman of the Fisherman's Relief Fund, on the County Treas. at Guelph Ontario for a \$500.00 donation is an outstanding Rarity in the Bill Stamp field. It has historical significance and is the EARLIEST KNOWN USAGE OF THE THIRD ISSUE BILL STAMPS.

A cover from Halifax dated August 27, 1869 to London, England via R.M.S. Etna franked with a 10¢ Bill Stamp overprinted N.S. and backstamped London Sept. 3, 1869. This slipped by the Postal Authorities because the Bill stamp was the same size, and color, as the 12½¢ Large Cents which should have been affixed. Not a bad item for a Large Cents collection.
