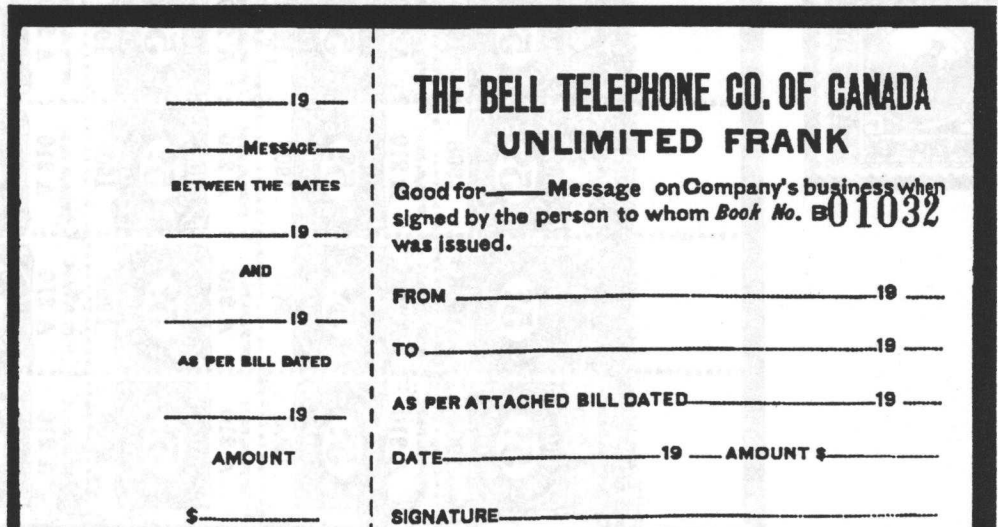
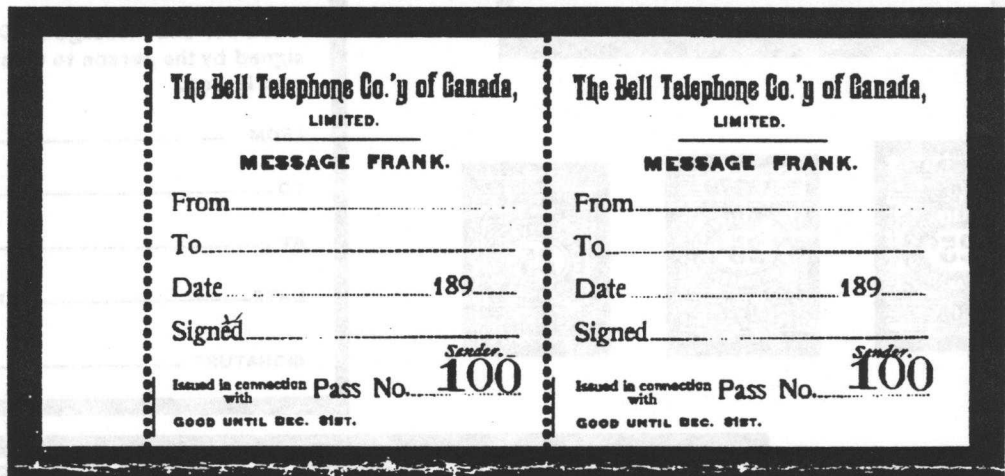
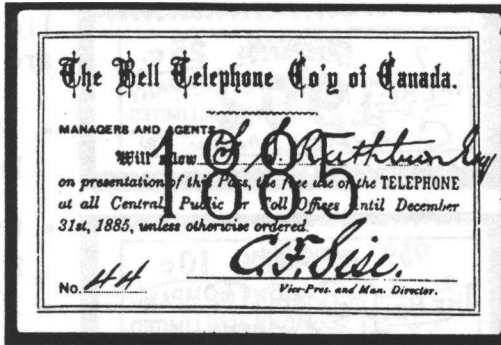
Pictured on this and the following page are a number of annual passes, franks, and frank booklet covers issued by Bell Telephone Company of Canada.
