Revenue Group Meeting at BNAPEX 2005

Village of MCADAM (2001 pop: 1513) in York County




Description: Black on red-orange, black serial number, 153 by approx. 49 mm, width varies due to tags being individually cut from a larger sheet. Cost: \$2.00 each. Comments: Residents allowed 2 untagged bags per week, excess to be tagged. Tags introduced 1997.

Yukon Municipal User-pay Garbage Tag

City of WHITEHORSE (2001 pop: 19,058)



Description: Black on dark pink, black serial number, 76 by 74½ mm, with two diagonal cuts in the self-adhesive tag forming an X. Cost: \$1.00 each. Comments: Residents allowed 4 untagged bags per bi-weekly collection, excess to be tagged.

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Newfoundland's Missing Tobacco Stamps

On August 1st, 1899, the Colony of Newfoundland introduced an excise duty on domestic tobacco products. Regulations issued under the authority of the enacting Statute provided the following with regards to tobacco revenue stamps:

"Upon all descriptions of boxes and caddies of tobacco of all kinds, a stamp shall be affixed over one corner or angle of the box or caddy, at equal distances from each end, attaching about equally to each side; And on all such packages when made of wood, a groove not less than one thirty-second of an inch deep shall be made to admit the stamp and prevent it being torn or rubbed off by transportation.

Each stamp shall be numbered and shall give the designation of the factory, the descriptive quality of the tobacco, the weight, date of issue and bear the signature of the Excise Officer.

The stamp will be affixed by the Excise Officer upon the manufactured article being bonded and shall upon payment of the Excise duty be duly cancelled before the tobacco shall go into consumption.

The owner of any factory manufacturing tobacco in this colony shall place upon each package of tobacco a caution label as follows:

Newfoundland Tobacco Works (or as the case may be), Excise Duty. Notice. The manufacturer of the tobacco herein contained has complied with the requirements of the law. Every person is cautioned not to use this package for packing tobacco again, nor to use the stamp under the penalties provided by law in such cases."

For imported tobacco products the regulations specified as follows:

"Packages containing tobacco shall be marked with a label, on which shall be placed the name of the port where, and the number of the entry under which such package was imported. The label shall be so placed on the package as to be broken when it is opened. [1]

The function of Newfoundland's tobacco excise stamps resembled that of Canada's warehouse and customs tobacco stamps of 1864-1883 where payment of the duty was separate from the stamping. In July of 1883, Canada had discontinued this system in favour of one where the duty was paid by the purchase of the stamps by tobacco manufacturers and importers.[2]

Newfoundland's 1899 regulations were supplemented on November 10th, 1903, to require stamps on small, individual packages of cut and similar tobacco, weighing up to one pound each. Unlike the earlier stamps for larger packages, these new stamps were to be affixed and cancelled by the excise officer upon the removal of the tobacco from excise bond. However, payment of the duty remained separate. The stamps were to be cancelled with the date of stamping.[3]

On February 7th, 1905, the regulations were further amended to provide for the manufacture and excise-stamping of cigarettes. This amendment appears to have been simply a confirmation of pre-existing practices as its preamble states that the manufacture of cigarettes had already been established in the Colony.[4]

When taken all together, the information outlined above indicates that Newfoundland's tobacco stamps were in use from August 1st, 1899, with the first issue being for relatively large boxes and caddies. However, the earliest Newfoundland tobacco stamps that are known today were prepared by the British American Bank Note Company (BABN) in 1904 for cut-tobacco and cigarettes.[5]

Unknown to present-day philatelists are the stamps that were used, both pre- and post-1904, on large packages of tobacco products. These packages typically contained pressed-tobaccos, which, along with cigars, were the dominant forms of tobacco being consumed in Canada prior to the late-1920s.[6] Cigar-stamps are only known to this writer as proofs.

Where are these unknown Newfoundland tobacco stamps? Importations certainly occurred, and at least one tobacco domestic manufacturer, Newfoundland Tobacco Works, operated in the 1899-1907 period.[7] Furthermore, Imperial Tobacco was producing 7-pound packages of pressed tobacco at its Newfoundland plant at the time of the Colony's 1949 union with Canada.[8] Several explanations for the absence of the stamps have come to the attention of this writer, but these scenarios are complete speculations.

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Licence Codes for Canadian Cigar Manufacturers: 1883-1962

The following compilation of codes for Canadian cigar manufacturers was extracted from annual Official Lists of licences as published by the Revenue Department. Starting in July of 1883, these licence codes were used by manufacturers to cancel their excise duty stamps and to mark their packages. The applicable dates for each licensee are given in brackets following their name. The Official Lists were found by the Author in several institutional collections: National Library of Canada, National Archives of Canada (Records of the Revenue Department), Customs and Excise Library of the Canada Revenue Agency, and Robarts Library at the University of Toronto.

For the 1883-1920 period of the Inland Revenue Divisions, the Author's collection of Lists is complete except for 1886 and 1891 where pages are missing. This results in some uncertainties that are indicated in the compilation by asterisks on applicable dates.

In April of 1921, the Inland Revenue Divisions were replaced by Customs & Excise Ports. However, it was not until September of that year that the new licence codes were introduced over time on packages. The first available Official List for the 1921-1962 period is from 1924. As a result, uncertainties again occur with licensees that appear or disappear in the List for that year. Individual changes could have

occurred at any time during 1921-1924. Where possible, extrapolations from the pre-1921 period have been made and recorded '1921' in the present work. The Author's collection of Official Lists for years after 1962 is very incomplete and therefore data from that period was not incorporated into this work.

The reader is also cautioned that in an unknown number of instances a licence was issued in the name of an officer or proprietor of a company rather than in the name of the company itself. For example, circa 1900, Licence 15-32 for the Canadian Cigar Company of London, Ontario was issued in the name of F. Haselgrove. Another consequence of personal licences is situations where what would appear to be a change in the licensee is actually just a succession of officers for the same manufacturing firm. This appears to have occurred with family-owned businesses and other unincorporated partnerships.

The most common colour for the duty stamps was black. During the period of 1897-1908, green and red stamps were used for preferential rates of duty on products of Canadian leaf. These colours are indicated below by name ('green') or initial ('G') where such information was given in the Official Lists for the period of 1899 to 1908. The Lists do not give the licence type, and therefore the stamp colour, until 1899.
