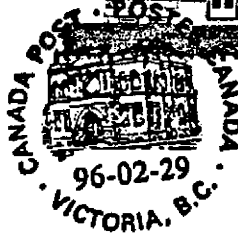




The \$4.00 Canadian Architectural Heritage Series stamp of the Carnegie Public Library Building, Victoria, B.C., issued February 29, 1996.

Constructed in 1904 and designated as a heritage site by the Province of British Columbia in 1979, the Carnegie Public Library building in Victoria stands as one of the gems of Canadian architecture. A remarkable example of the Richardsonian Romanesque style of architecture, the building features rough stonework, large, arched entrances and groups of deeply-cut windows. It was designed by Thomas Hopper and Charles Erwood Watkins.

The stamp was designed by Raymond Bellavance, from Montreal, and was assisted by Toronto architect Robert G. Hill. The designer used photographs and building plans to generate line drawings on his computer; then added colours and tones and returned the files to produce the finished product. The stamp was printed by Canadian Bank Note Co., perforation 15+, on Coated paper, printed by four colour lithography and one colour steel engraving, untagged, in a pane of 25 stamps.

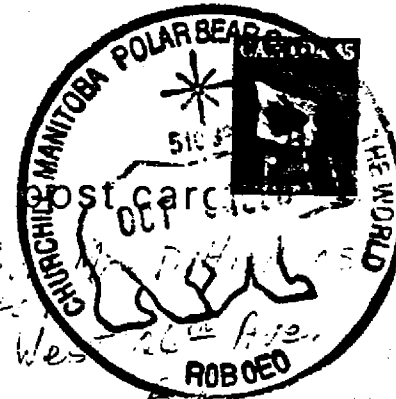

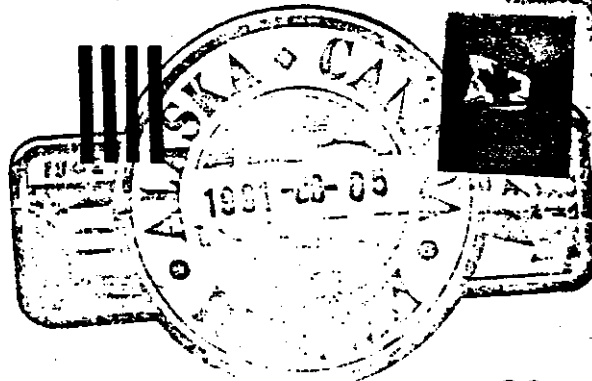
