The \$1.00 1967 – 73 Centennial Issue
BNAPEX 2023

Purpose of Exhibit:

To show the 2 different printings of this value plus a range of its usage.

Exhibit Plan:

The exhibit starts with the different printings over the 1967 – 73 period. This is followed by examples of usage broken down by Domestic, United States and Foreign.

Technically production of the \$1.00 Centennial issue ended on October 24, 1973 with issuance of the \$1.00 Landscape issue. However Canada Post had a policy that existing stocks of definitive stamps were to be continued to be issued at post offices and from regional stamp depots until fully depleted. This resulted in some post offices receiving the \$1.00 Centennial issue until 1977.

Examples of usage shown are limited to “in period usage” (the end printing date of October 24, 1973).

Items of interest:

Single usage examples are uncommon and difficult to acquire. The exhibit shows several examples of usage.
