

Over a period of many years, with help from fellow collectors, dealers in Canadian Postal History and members of the Canadian Military Mail Study Group of the British North America Philatelic Society (BNAPS), Doug Sayles, a first-class researcher, gathered as many different examples of World War II Canadian Military markings as he could find and produced a 304-page book.

Since Doug's passing the growth of the Internet, and especially the growth of eBay, have brought to light several hundred previously unknown World War II era Canadian Military markings. This UPDATE is intended to help students of Canadian Military markings identify markings that cannot be found in Sayles Volume II.
