FROM CANADA POST

Canada Post has again provided a listing of the changes of status of Post Offices in British Columbia up to December 30, 1993 and their co-operation is greatly appreciated. A new format is used and there is some overlap with the previous listing. A few new "A" Franchises are missing as this information comes from Ottawa.

Present Post Office policy assigns the RC number to the operator of the office rather than the Post Office itself and thus each time a Post Office changes hands a new number is issued. In some cases the dater has the name of the parent office rather than the name of the Post Office. These will be reported where possible and your assistance is required.

OPTICAL CHARACTER READER 081 - Vancouver

The A.B. Dick Jet Spray Printer was introduced in Vancouver September 28, 1993 and was discussed in detail in December News Letter (Issue 8 page 62). Since the December issue went to press OCR 081 has undergone some short lived changes which are well worth looking for.

Normal --->

081 V6B 3A0 931208 09:15

The "normal" jet spray marking is 42mm long and about 5mm high but the length of the marking may change if the machine speeds up or slows down. The machine has four jet spray heads each consisting of seven jet holes and the sprays are activated by a computer which produce a series of seven vertical dots each under one millimetre in diameter. Letters move past the jet spray head at the rate of about six letters per second so it is not surprising that the spray marking are sometimes indistinct or jumbled.

From December 7 to 29, 1993 the height of the spray markings were changed on an almost daily basis. Not all heads were changed at the same time nor by the same amount. Note; Head 1 (top) and 2 are used only for oversize envelopes and are far less common than Head 3 which is used on Number 10 envelopes. The items below are a few of the more notable items from December 1993. The editor has a day by day tabulation available.

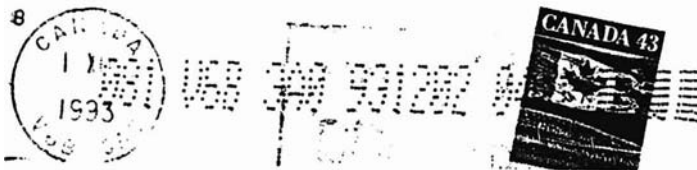

From about noon on January 4, 1994 until about noon on January 8 head number 3 was printing spray markings in reverse or as a mirror image. The reports for the three other heads indicate normal printing during this period. A similar mirror markings are reported for November 25, 1993. The length of use and the reason for this error is not known at this time. Further details would be appreciated.

As a "Working Draft" this is an excellent 24 page spiral backed booklet. The MOONs are listed in numerical order followed by the name of the Post Office as shown on the cancellation. Proof dates (if available) as well as early and late dates are included. The marking type and notes on usage or colour are also provided. A brief introduction provides some background information on the history of the MOON cancellations. A single page showing the "MOON TYPES" identifies the "13 point date arrangements" as used on the MOON hammers. Unfortunately there is no explanation of the differences between each of the 13 types and as a novice I could not distinguish between hammers such as numbers 1, 9, and 10 which all look the same to me. I hope the next edition will include this much needed information..

More than 20 years have passed since the last MOON was manufactured and it is high time a work of this kind was available to collectors. Mike Sagar has collected much valuable information and is to be complimented on his efforts. The work, in its present form, compares favourably with such pioneer works as A.L. McCready's "Canadian Flag Cancellations", first published in 1945, and it is hoped this work will go through as many revised editions as has the flag handbook.

The book is a necessary publication for any true collector of British Columbia postal history. As might be expected in any pioneer work there is much new information that will be found and the success of this publication depends on the feed back received from other collectors. Good work Mike.
