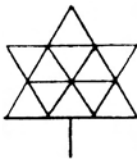

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This first newsletter of 1986 begins our fluorescent paper study. The success of this endeavour depends on the extent of your participation. It is assumed that most of our members have mint Centennials with some plate or blank corner blocks and an ultraviolet lamp. We will initially consider the high value Centennials and use the fluorescence tables from the second edition of "Canada, The 1967-73 Definitive Issue" as the starting point. The twelve levels of fluorescence are too extensive but I feel that these can still provide a base. The dextrine gummed stamps have either smooth or streaky gum and some items listed in the fluorescence tables are only in one type of gum - we should be able to find examples on the other type of gum. We should also be able to detect a significant difference in level of fluorescence; example - if all plate no. 1 blocks are listed as fluorescence "0", then a level of "1" would not be as significant as a "2" or a "3". A difference of 2 to 3 fluorescence units should be readily detectable. PLEASE USE MINT STAMPS IN THIS STUDY. I have listed what is hopefully an unambiguous guide to the levels of fluorescence established by Keane and Hughes, using stamps everybody probably has.

- 0 6¢ orange coil or \$1 booklet of twenty-five 4¢ stamps
- 1 \$1.50 perf 10 booklet of the 6¢ black
- 2 50¢ PVA gum, plate 2
- 3 20¢ PVA gum, Winnipeg tagged
- 4 20¢ PVA gum, plate 2
- 5 probably the best example is the 6¢ black, PVA gum, Ottawa general tagged, being careful not to use the "1" or "7" level also found on this stamp
- 6 15¢ PVA, plate 3
- 7 8¢ library plate 7
- 8 Bk 69cii, the most fluorescent grade with OP2 tagging and a clear sealing strip - these are probably the most common of the 69 booklets.
- 9 10¢ Ottawa general tagged, PVA gum, hibrite
- 10 Opal booklet or 25¢ booklet of the 6¢ orange, hibrite paper
- 11 6¢ black coil

Copies of the tables follow with a few additions and changes already recorded. Please give them some careful study and see if you can add some new items. If we get the participation needed, then we will slowly expand the study to the other values as well as coils and booklets.
