I will have Jim Karr's listing of Berri's in the next newsletter following presentation at Calgary by Jim.

Did you all notice our duplex article in the last Topics. I have submitted two further articles to get the ball rolling, please don't think I am hogging the limelight, all members are urged to submit articles for this regular column.

As mentioned in the last newsletter, I took my unofficial duplexes to Pipex in Vancouver (first time I have shown anything) and lo and behold a silver. Just shows anyone can do it.

My offer of providing my research on any Canadian town still stands, only had one request, Berlin, from Whit Bradley wondering why you don't seem to find a Berlin duplex on the Map stamp prior to about 1899. I show 3 diff. duplex hammers.

1. 22mm full circle dater with 11 medium horizontal bar killer. In use 1886-8 with AM/PM and 1888-97 blank.
2. 23mm full circle dater with 9 thick horizontal bar killer. In use Nov. 6/99 until Feb 15/1901.
3. 21.5mm full circle dater with 9 thick horizontal bar killer. In use May 30/02 until Jul 28/04.

I assume Whit that the June 1899 date you refer to is early date for my #2, easily distinguished by the wide flat letters (see photocopies). So #1 had ceased to be used and type #2 came into use well into your period, type #3 much later.

If anyone has additional early or late dates let me know and I will change my records and pass on to Whit as well.

I haven't had any feedback on the revised P.E.I. listing, additions anyone. Father Walker sends along for this issue Part 1 of N.S. updates, again any changes please let us know.

I offer the following additions to the N.S. listing.

AMHERST A9 23.5mm early use - AM/JUN 12/03.
ANNAPOLIS ROYAL A9 23mm proof date - AM/OC 29/07.
DARTMOUTH B11 22.5mm revised proof date - year 1913 believe should read 1915.
GLACE BAY A9 23.5mm late date - PM/SP 1/10.
LAWRENCETOWN (ANNAPOLIS) B11 24mm early date - MR 10/10.

What I liked about them was that they are very close to size, where the hard copies I have are much larger than the originals. There are some 2800 strikes. I think if enough interest were shown I might persuade Paul to produce additional copies (naturally there would be costs involved). 8 1/2 x 11 3-ring punched. Let me know.
