Bill & Chris pointed out that several of the B.C. towns we had listed as B11 were in fact B10, please note illustration to the right. I think there has been a general assumption that the thumbprint types had 11 bars. I have been busy rechecking all mine.



Al Steinhart submitted an early date for AVONDALE/NEWFOUNDLAND listed in our last newsletter. EARLY FEB/18/1901.

Lloyd Macpherson recently wrote asking several questions I was unable to answer, can anyone help?

1. Did the 19th century duplex hammers have vertical handles (stamper form) or horizontal handles (hammer form). Lloyd adds, I know mid 20th century ones were hammers.
2. What do you know of the wartime 'Blind' duplex used in N.S.? I know only one, type 0, early 1943, may be Liverpool.

NEW ITEMS OR UPDATES.

Illustr. #1 shows HOUSE OF COMMONS/CANADA duplex with twisted 8 bar killer enclosing HOUSE OF COMMONS/OTTAWA in 3 lines dated MAY 7/08, this item was submitted by Barry Shapiro who asks for further reports, hoping to pin down the period of usage. Lovely item, wish I had one Barry.

Illustr. #2 shows MONTREAL/CANADA nude with 12 bar circular killer on small queen cover, George Olson has a similar but unaddressed, anyone know the reason behind this?

Page showing PORT BURWELL/ONT B10 submitted by Bob Smith, he believes the 1940 hammer has had the killer bars filed down. Comments anyone?

Illustr. #4, WINDSOR/ONT A7 dated 1949 which I recently acquired from Graham Noble, also note a partial strike on 10¢ stamp, similar time period. Did Windsor ever have a 7 bar duplex? Postmaster's unofficial? Help.

Illustr. #5, some time ago I illustr. a PORT HOPE/ONT A9 on piece OC 31/01, a very sharp member was quick to observe that killer was twisted compared to my 1911 example. Is the first not a duplex? or ???

Page showing two strikes of the TORONTO WEST BRANCH OFFICE note two different hammers, I would very much like to narrow the usage dates on these, please check any strikes you may have, it is very easy to tell from the lettering in the KILLER.


Last spring I bought a TORONTO/CANADA 2-ring target unofficial duplex, so what you say, nice but not rare, since I had a number and in fact was showing them at Pipex I was stunned to find that the dater and killer were 9mm apart not 3.5mm., the seller, Steinhart when I pointed it out, was lost for words (that in itself is worthy of a story). I had a discussion with Jim Hennok in Calgary re the OSHAWA M.O.O.N. unofficial which was subject of an article in Topics July-August 1985 p.38, it too had a varying distance from dater to killer. Jim & I concluded that the Oshawa was attatched by means of track device which allowed the two parts to slide.

Also a page showing same (or similar) dater with a larger target, again I would like to narrow down the period of use.


If anyone is interested in the 1901 TORONTO freak duplex, the one in which the dater was later inserted in the Toronto 2-ring orb let me know. I have just completed a study of these and I would be glad to exchange information.

Father Larry Walker sends along several reports including, part II of the N.S. updates, Halifax updates, listing of Canadian Armed Forces duplexes. Father Walker points out that where dater measurements are in brackets it was from Dalpe/Walker collections not the proof books.





PORT BURWELL - duplex








CANADIAN DUPLEX CANCELLATIONS

TORONTO WEST BRANCH OFFICE


The Toronto West Branch Office used two different duplex devices. The differences are best seen in the height of the lettering in the killer portion. The first one was in used until late 1885 or early 1886 with lettering 3.25mm high. The second one was used exclusively for almost all of 1886 with lettering 2.5mm high.

UNOFFICIAL DUPLEX CANCELLATIONS OF CANADA

TORONTO / CANADA 2-RING TARGET TYPE OF 1880.

A revolving type, a combination of full circle dater with 2-ring target killer.

DATER - FULL CIRCLE 22mm, 3 LINE INDICA, CANADA. AT BOTTOM.

KILLER - 2-RING 19mm TARGET, 3.5mm SPACING FROM DATER +-.


TIMEMARKS - AM, PM, NT.

PERIOD OF USE - AUGUST 24, 1880 until MARCH 28, 1881.

Many theories have been advanced regarding the target duplexes.

1. There is no doubt that either the dater or the killer revolves.
2. Except for the examples in March and April 1981 the size of the killer are standard, slight variances are likely a result of the quality of the strike and quantity of inking.
3. The dater and killer most likely are attached by means of a device which allows the dater or killer to slide closer or farther apart as well as revolve, normal spacing is + 3.5mm, however, note the 5mm and 9mm spacing examples.



TORONTO / CANADA 2-RING TARGET TYPE OF 1880.

To support the theory that the killer and dater were attached by means of a sliding device, allowing the dater and killer to be placed at a set distance from one another, note the following 9mm and 5mm settings, both dated inside the known usage of 3.5mm spacing on previous pages.

KILLER - 2-RING 21mm TARGET, 3mm SPACING FROM DATER +.


TIMEMARKS - PM.

PERIOD OF USE - MARCH 30, 1881 until APRIL 4, 1881.

Between March 28 and March 30, 1881 it appears the 19mm target was removed and replaced by the following 21mm target, likely the result of breakage, note it still revolved.
