While on the subject of items for our newsletters, any member who is collecting a specialized area or town, I would be very happy to publish your work, I am sure it would be refreshing to hear from members other than yours truly. Member Jeff Switt advises he is publishing 'acid-free' 3-ring quadrille pages, cost U.S \$15/100. Jeff will donate \$1 from each order to our study group, when ordering please mention the duplex study group. Jeff's address will be found on the enclosed membership list.

New member Bill Barry, recently sent me his inventory, along with a great deal of new information on Saskatchewan.

First please note DSA-10 Alvena/Sask is type Q7 rather than 07. Bill advises that for the following towns, their duplex hammer is still in use and is their sole hammer - Archerwill, Beechy, Big River (B11), Blaine Lake (07), Borden, Bredenburg (S7), Bruno (S7), Caron (07), Chamberlain (Q7), Clavet, Crooked River (Q7), Delisle (07), Denzil, Drake, Golden Prairie, Govan (S7), Kelvington (Q7), Loverna (Q7), Mayfair, Maymont (Q7). Mendham, Milden (S7), Odessa, Ogema (07), Plato, Porcupine Plain (R7), Rabbit Lake (R7), Redvers (Q7), Riceton, Rouleau (N7), Ruthilda, St. Victor, Speers, Stalwart, Tessier (Q7), Verigin (Q7), Verwood (07), Vonda (07) White Bear, Windthorst (07).

The following towns are still using their duplex hammers, although they also use at least one other device - Beechy, Broadview (R7), Buchanan (Q7), Cardnuff (S7), Coderre (07), Codette (Q7), Cupar (B10), Dundurn (Q7), Duval (B10), Glenavon (07), Gronlid, Invermay, Kenaston, Killaly (seldom used), Kinistino (R7), Lafleche (R7), Lang, Langbank, Lemberg (07), Lintlaw (Q7), Marquis (S7), Montmartre (07), Morse (R7), Mossbank (07), Neudorf (N7), Paynton (07), Ponteix (07), Preeceville (R7), Punnichy, Quill Lake (Q7), Saltcoats (07), Silton, Tisdale (R7), Whitewood (R7) & Wolseley (R7).

This is a total of 75 hammers still in use, quite remarkable, how about reports on other provinces?

A letter from Doug Murray of Charlottetown, Doug sent me a list of his P.E.I. duplexes, providing a number of earlier, later dates and new TM's. As a result of all the changes a new print out of the PEI section is included. Thanks Doug.

John Levy sends along a photocopy of the first recorded strike for DSA-481 MAIDSTONE/SASK -/1926/10/25.

Tom Southey sends along a photocopy of the first recorded strike for DMB-53 CARBERRY/MAN -/1915/04/19.

I failed to note the reporter, however, I received a photocopy of the first recorded strike for DPQ-632 MONTREAL/CANADA 'S' (type T7) 27/1955 SP 23, you will recall that earlier we listed this as a U7, Father Walker was kind enough to advise that in fact it was a T7.

For some time I have been concerned that the listing for CALGARY/ALTA A9 (DAB-78-80) may not be accurate. I asked Jim Karr to look at what strikes I had and incorporate with his strikes. The result is enclosed. Jim and I are anxious to have input from other members who may agree or not agree with the findings. Only one A9 hammer is in the proof book, this is illustrated below.



Those of you who ordered the January 1989 duplex update may have noticed an expanded VANCOUVER/B.C. A9 section, this for the main part thanks to member Chris McGregor. Since that time Chris, Bill Robinson & Bill Topping have done further work on DBC-391-398. The results are enclosed, this should now make it very easy to distinguish the different hammers.

Thank you to all those who have sent along your inventories. It is very important, for the sake of accuracy to have everyone help before we publish rarity factors. If you need an inventory sheet please let me know.




