With reference to page 4 of Newsletter No. 19 December 1990 :-
DUN-149 TORONTO.ONTARIO / CANADA we have a letter from Robert C. Smith,
part of which we quote:-

I note that Mike Sagar's report of a cover with the TORONTO.ONTARIO / CANADA Pitney-Bowes experimental duplex [note: should be a period between TORONTO and CANADA] is shown as a new listing. This hammer in fact already appears in Bob Lee's catalogue as DON-1774. I reported on this postmark, along with the similar hammers DON-1216A (OTTAWA.ONTARIO / CANADA) and DPQ-593A (MONTREAL.QUEBEC / CANADA) in an article which appeared in PHSC Journal #52, page 18, using material I found in the National Archives here in Ottawa. I don't know of any report of DPQ-593A, but DON-1216 has been seen on June 23 and July 1, 1948.

Would it be possible to include the above information in the next issue of the Duplex Cancellations newsletter?

Thank you Bob for having a sharp eye and recognizing an unusual duplex postmark. Bob Lee is cancelling DUN-149 listing, and Mike Sagar's report will be the first report for DON-1774.

Your Editor has reread Bob's article in the PHSC Journal No.52 and can recommend it to all Duplex Study Group members. These Pitney-Bowes experimental duplex postmarks are very worthwhile items to watch for in dealers' stocks, being used for only a three to four week period in late June and early July 1948. Bob Lee has no report of use of DPQ-593A, the MONTREAL.QUEBEC / CANADA hammer.

We have a very interesting letter and computer print out from Bill Barry of Regina, who is a keen collector of all Saskatchewan postmarks. His report is so full of great information on the Saskatchewan Duplex postmarks that we are taking the liberty to include it in its entirety. We hope it provides many of you with up to date information. Does any other member have similar information on other provinces? We would gladly include it in future Newsletters.

Bill's letter follows:-

Well, I guess it's about time I updated my earlier report on Saskatchewan duplexes, it has been more than two years!

Attached is a complete list of the updates I have to Bob Lee's catalogue. It is quite a lengthy list, since I have included my latest dates on all the hammers still in use.

By my count, 65 duplex hammers remain in use in Saskatchewan post offices, at least I have strikes of them from within the past 12 months. There are 10 more that I'm not sure of -- they may still be used occasionally. Also by my count, there have been 19 duplexes retired in the past 5 years. I have included separate printouts of all three of these lists with my latest dates. (Please feel free to use any or all of this in the newsletter.)

Many of these hammers have been awesomely durable, to say the least. It's amazing how many of them have seen relatively constant duty for 30, 40 and 50 years. Then there are the three granddaddies, all type B11, which have been in use for over 70 years: DSA-626 PLATO/SASK. which is definitely still in use, DSA-780 SILTON/SASK. which may be still in use, and the now retired DSA-425 LANG/SASK. which tops the list (so far!) at 75 years, 3 months.

The publication by Bob Lee of the proof strikes as assembled by J. Paul Hughes has been an enormous assist to we collectors. I blush with embarrassment at some of the bad information I gave Bob earlier! Hopefully, the listings which follow will set right the damage.

In the list, I have only included data which is different from the latest update to Lee (January, 1989). Note that hammers which have an asterisk after LRD are those which are still in use. The 18 hammers with a date in the proof column are those which Lee listed as NIPB, but for which proof strikes appear in Hughes.

It is also worthy of note that 8 hammers for which Lee gives a proof date did not show up in Hughes:

NOTES:

- (1) this is the only Assiniboia duplex to appear in Hughes (J. Paul Hughes, Proof Strikes of Canada, v.5: Duplex Proof Strikes of Western Canada). Interestingly, Kell (Ronald Kell, the Postal History of the District of Assiniboia 1882-1905), mentions a type A9 SWIFT CURRENT/ASSA duplex, but gives no dates for it and it does not appear in Lee (Robert A. Lee, Catalogue of Canadian Duplex Cancellations).
- (2) in Hughes, not in Lee. Most strikes previously reported as DSA-101 are probably this hammer.
- (3) this hammer should be de-listed, there is no equivalent strike in Hughes.
- (4) this hammer should be de-listed, the proof date given in Lee is a typographical error and DSA-208 and 209 are the same hammer.
- (5) in Hughes, not in Lee.
- (6) this hammer is still at the Hazlet post office with the date 19560630 in it. I have two philatelic strikes of the hammer, one obtained in 1977 and the other in 1986, and both show this date. I am quite confident that the LRD given in Lee is in error.
- (7) Lee shows an LRD of 19881231 for this revival of an old hammer, but I am confident it was retired prior to Christmas, 1987.
- (8) collections should be checked on this one, I am almost certain that reports after 1961 are, in fact, DSA-377. On DSA-376, the middle killer bar intersects the second A of CANADA. On DSA-377, the point of the middle killer bar is between the N and the second A of CANADA.

- (9) note the misspelling on this hammer, which wasn't noticed by Lee; it is unlikely it was ever issued. Also, the proof date in Hughes is 19130903.
- (10) this hammer is in Hughes but the proof date is almost illegible (apparently 19650219).
- (11) in Hughes, not in Lee.
- (12) I believe this listing should be NIPB. It is extremely unlikely that a SASK hammer would have been proofed some 15 months before the creation of the province. Also, see AS14, which has the same proof date.
- (13) matching with the proof strikes in Hughes reveals that Lee got DSA-693 and 694 reversed: the earlier proofed hammer has the dot, the later one the dash. Collections will need to be checked on these.
- (14) I previously reported the LRD shown in Lee's catalogue for this hammer. Comparison with the proof strikes revealed that I was in error and the strike is actually DSA-702.
- (15) Lee erroneously gives the proof date of this hammer as 19331120. Collectors' strikes of DSA-721 should be checked against the proof strike of this hammer.
- (16) the listed LRD for this hammer must be in error, the Saint Front post office closed in 1970!
- (17) in Hughes, not in Lee.
- (18) the two Saskatoon type S7 hammers are distinguishable as follows:

- (19) this hammer was revived for a very short time after Turtleford's type C hammer broke (LRD 19881026), and before delivery of their new type F (30mm) hammer (ERD 19881128). I am highly skeptical of the end of December date shown in Lee.
- (20) late revival.
- (21) DSA-959 and 960 should be re-checked by collectors. DSA-959, proofed in 1950, maintained a good circle throughout its use. S to . measures 14mm, and an extension of the left leg of the second A in Canada meets the bottom of the N of Yorkton. From late (Aug) in 1952, DSA-960 (proofed in 1951) has a dent at 7 o'clock. S to . is 14.5mm, and an extension of the left leg of the second A in Canada meets the top of the N in Yorkton.
