
These meetings will be available only to those who register for the convention. But remember – registration is FREE.

The 3rd and 4th editions of CAPEX 22 News were issued in July with several items of interest to BNAPS members including news of Fred Fawn's Canadian and International award-winning Large Queen collection to be sold by auction at CAPEX 22 by R. Several issues ago we wrote about a Canadian postal permit that was printed on the inside of Cheerios boxes. It was part of a Cheerios campaign to send "Cheer" to 2010 Canadian Olympians. 2010 was the first year this campaign was run. Phil and Charlie are trying to get more information on which Olympics this campaign was offered. Here are the Olympic dates possible. Date in blue are believed to have had the permits

It may be that the campaign wasn't run for 2012 and 2014. Charlie has been searching on eBay for boxes from any of the campaigns. So far, NOT A ONE. All kinds of other boxes but none for the "Cheer" campaign.

2010 - Vancouver - Winter2016 - Rio de Janeiro - Summer2012 - London - Summer2018 - PyeongChang - Winter2014 - Sochi - Winter2020 - Tokyo - Summer - Postponed

Larry Cherns sent a photocopy of the 2010 box (inside and out) and Mike Street has been kind enough to spend more time in grocery stores than normal BUT – his efforts were successful. Mike has sent me the three different varieties of Cheerios participating in the 2021 campaign. The reverse of these boxes contains the French version of the card. 
The insides of all the boxes are identical (illustration on next page).














Map Stamp Study Group

Although *The Pilot's Log* has not been published for several years, the Air Mail Study Group (AMSG) has held several meetings during BNAPEXs in partnership with the Canadian Aerophilatelic Society (CAS).

In November last year, when the CAS was unable to hold its regular Day of Aerophilately in Toronto due to Covid restrictions, the AMSG partnered with the CAS to hold a Zoom Day of Aerophilately.

This meeting was very successful: it attracted 35 participants from across Canada, (British Columbia to Newfoundland), the USA, Scotland and France. 
Following these meetings the AMSG has been officially revived, and will hold another AMSG/CAS meeting during BNAPEX 2021:

<u>JUST FOUR WEEKS TO GO!!!!!</u> BNAPEX 2021 Virtual preparations are well in hand. Here's how things stand as of 1 August 2021.

<u>Convention Registration:</u> BNAPEX 2021 Virtual registration is <u>NOW OPEN</u> to everyone, not just BNAPS members. Access to the exhibits, study group seminars, virtual meeting recordings, and dealer bourse on the BNAPS website is free, but registration is required.

<u>Non-members</u> of BNAPS must register and log in to view the BNAPEX web pages. You can do so by clicking on the "Registration" tab in the left navigation bar on any BNAPEX 2021 web page.

BNAPS members have two options:

- 1. You can register and log in like non-members, or
- 2. You can skip the BNAPEX registration and login by logging on the BNAPS website (https://bnaps.org) using the standard member login page (click "Member Login" in the top menu bar on the home page). We are waiting for exhibitor confirmation that they have completed their uploads. Uploaded exhibits will be posted on the BNAPEX 2021 "Exhibits" page soon. The Judges' Feedback session is scheduled for Sunday, 5 September, between 14:00 and 16:00 EDT.

Souvenirs - a special show cancel has been requested from Canada Post for use on show

covers. Souvenirs can be viewed now on the BNAPEX 2021 "Souvenirs" page. An image of the BNAPEX 2021 Virtual Personal Postage stamp is shown at right. (Images of the BNAPEX 2021 Virtual Booklet covers were show in the July BNAPS eLetter.)

BNAPS members who Register for the Virtual event will receive a special show cover similar to what is



normally given out at the convention banquet. In addition, each Exhibit will receive a Virtual Ribbon award, which will be a nice collectible item.

Philatelic Presentations: Sixty (60!) previously recorded philatelic presentations on a broad range of subjects will be available online 24/7 during the convention. Included subject areas are: Aerophilately; CAPEX 22; Military Mail; New Brunswick Stamps & Postal History; Newfoundland: Aerophilately, Postal History, Railway Post Offices, Stamps and Postal History, Postal Stationery; Postmarks; Canada Maritimes Railway Post Offices; Stamps and Technical Philately.
