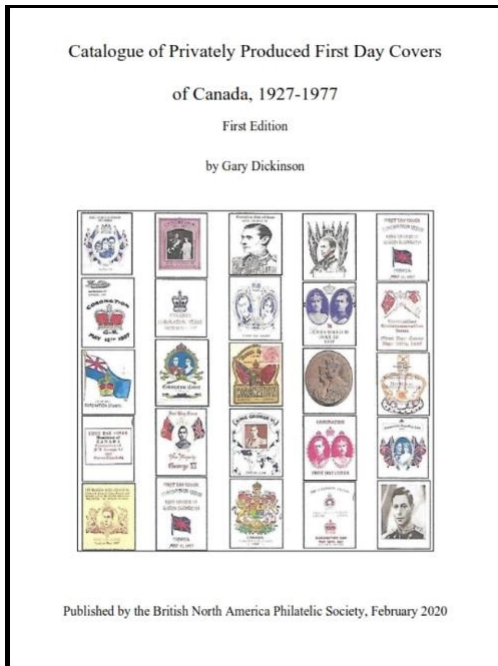
## APS Becomes a CAPEX 22 Partner Level Sponsor

## First Day Cover Catalog Available



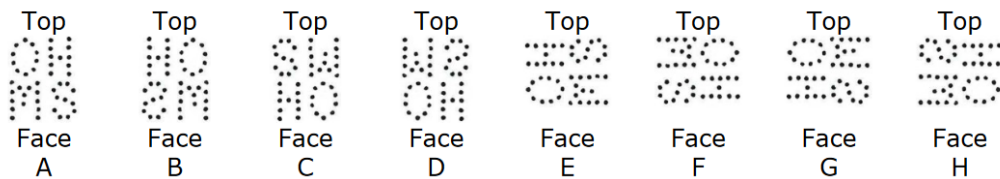
BNAPS is pleased to advise that the Second Edition of Gary Dickinson's "Catalogue of Privately Produced First Day Covers of Canada, 1927-1977" will be released in June 2022 at CAPEX 22, the International Single Frame Exhibition taking place in Toronto next June.

The Second Edition will have about 12,500 entries, compared with 8,800 in the First Edition, and will be almost two-thirds larger, 360 pages compared to 222. Coverage has been extended by 12 years, to 1989, with airmail, special delivery, semi-postal, and Newfoundland FDCs now included.

New and previous buyers of the First Edition will receive a 25% credit toward purchase of the Second Edition

## 2022 Unitrade Perforated Official Stamps

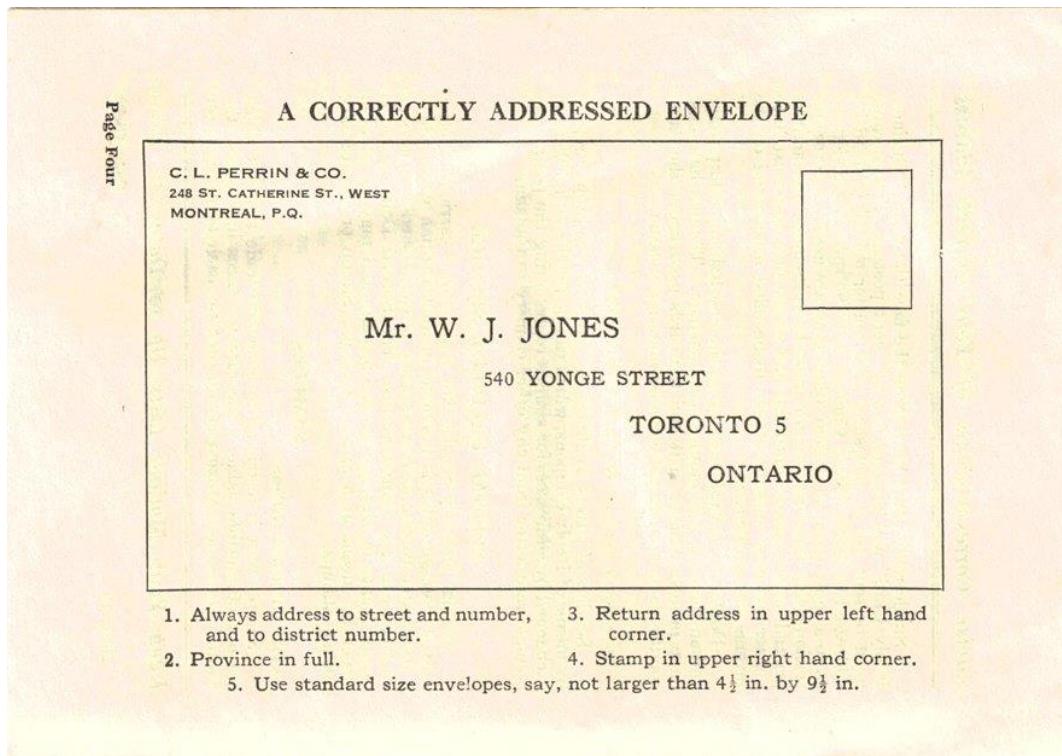
The Perforated Official “OHMS” Stamps listed in the *2022 Unitrade Specialized Catalogue of Canadian Stamps* has been changed with Unitrade adopting the British North America Philatelic Society (BNAPS) Perfin Study Group’s perforated OHMS numbering system and list of perforated OHMS stamps. The 5-hole OHMS perfin Type “OA” has changed to “O8”. The 4-hole perfin Type “O” now is “O9” (1st 4 hole) and “O10” (2nd 4 hole). The perfin Issues are the regular Unitrade stamp numbers. This list of perforated officials come from the *BNAPS Perfin Study Group handbook – Canadian Stamps with Perforated Initials, Positions, Sixth Edition*.
