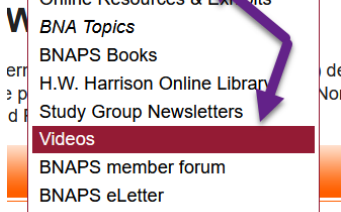

BNAPS Member Sam Chiu Awarded the Geldert Medal

The Geldert Medal was established in 1967 by Phyllis Geldert to honor her husband George who was president of the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada (RPSC) from 1958-1967. It is awarded annually to recognize the best article published in the *Canadian Philatelist*, the RPSC's bi-monthly journal. Sam's article ran in the November-December 2021 issues of the journal.

For the year 2021 the Geldert Medal was awarded to BNAPS member Sam Chiu of Toronto for his article *Adding New knowledge: Canada's C-Force in Hong Kong*.

SAM CHIU Ph.D.

Sam started collecting stamps in childhood. His interests are in China and Hong Kong postal history postal stationery plus various themes. An avid exhibitor, Sam has achieved multiple national-level gold medals in 8 different sub-classes. He is the only Canadian to win AAPE Sapphire Award and 1 of 2 Canadians to win AAPE Diamond Award. He is an accredited judge with The Royal Philatelic Society of Canada and a Jury Fellow at FIP. He served on Canada Post's Stamp Advisory Committee from 2006 to 2012. Sam has a PhD in International Management from the University of St. Gallen in Switzerland. He has been Vice President of RPSC since September 2017. He is also a Fellow of Royal Philatelic Society London. Currently he is the editor of Journal of Chinese Philately for the China Philatelic Society of London.

On-line Registration

The on-line registration system is available through the Register Now button on the website homepage or at the website link <https://capex22.org/event/capex-22-international-one-frame-stamp-championship-exhibition/> . Registration cost is \$50 Cdn for a 4-day pass or \$15 Cdn for a single day pass. Register early and avoid delays and registration line at the show. Present your registration confirm, pick up your badge and enter.

All One-Frame and individual Philatelic Literature Exhibitors will receive a complimentary 4-day pass for CAPEX 22.

Room Blocks

The CAPEX 22 room block at the InterContinental hotel adjoining the MTCC is now sold out. The next closest hotel is the Delta Toronto Downtown which is connected to the MTCC by a pedestrian skybridge. The most recent room block uptake report from the Delta indicates that 50% of the room block has been booked. The uptake at the Hyatt and the Sheraton which are further away from the MTCC is less but, in lieu of the customary attrition penalty for unbooked rooms, the hotels will return an increasing percentage of unbooked rooms to inventory over the coming months. Second CAPEX 22 Souvenir Sheet

Today, March 1, 2022 Canada Post releases the second CAPEX 22 Souvenir Sheet. This special souvenir sheet overprint featuring the two calla stamps of the 2022 flower issue is released in anticipation of CAPEX 22 International One Frame Stamp Championship Exhibition, to be held in Toronto, June 9 to 12, 2022. The souvenir sheet image is of one curled, white calla and one pink calla in full bloom. The CAPEX 22 logo is placed in the lower left corner. As with the CAPEX 22 overprint of the Bluenose 100 souvenir sheet issued in June 2021 the Calla souvenir sheet has a limited printing of 40,000 copies available.

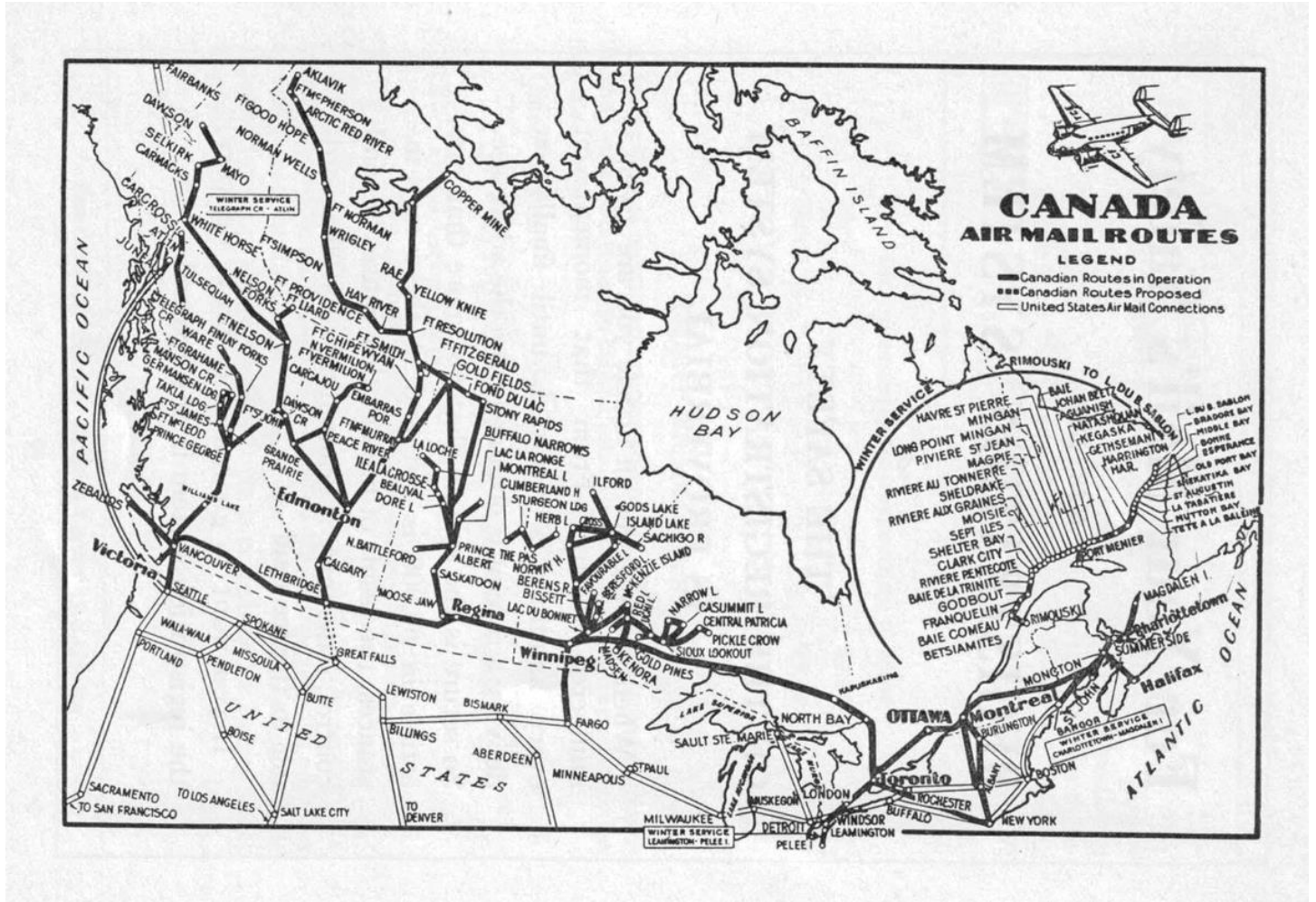
