My Favourite Elizabethan Varieties - Leopold Beaudet

A 2-row comb has 2 rows of pins and perforates 2 rows of stamps in the sheet.

4-colour litho, Ashton-Potter

Perforated using a 2-row comb travelling sideways, as shown by the missing vertical pin hole that repeats in every 2nd column of perfs.
