Several study groups have requested a delay of two to five years between publication of their newsletter and posting it on the website. Kingston is an excellent location for our 75th annual BNAPEX within driving distance for many of our BNAPS members. Kingston figures prominently in Canada's history and there are many sites and attractions to visit. The most recent Kingston attraction is the SS Keewatin, the 107-metre-long Edwardian era CPR steam ship which carried passengers and freight between Port McNicoll on Georgian Bay and present-day Thunder Bay on Lake Superior for 60 years. The SS Keewatin now

has a permanent home in the Marine Museum of the Great Lakes in Kingston.
