BNAPS Member Dean Mario wins 2023 Pratt Award

The Collectors Club of Chicago is pleased to announce the winner of the 2023 Pratt Award, which recognizes articles or other publications related to the philately of Newfoundland as judged by the Pratt Award Committee as being significant and of academic merit. It is awarded in the year following its publication.

The 2023 recipient is Dean W. Mario of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, Canada, for "Newfoundland's Postal Censorship During the Great War" in *BNA Topics* Vol. 80, No. 3.

The committee noted the article gave an exceptional explanation of why and how Newfoundland formalized plans to censor civil mail. Further, it included pictorial descriptions of three types of censorship hand stamps of

Newfoundland and described foreign censorship on mail to and from Newfoundland. The committee appreciated how the article gave substantial coverage to a small niche in Newfoundland's postal history.

The CCC Pratt Award is named for Robert H. Pratt [also a BNAPS member], the eminent Newfoundland stamp and postal history collector, researcher, and author. Since 1997, the award has been bestowed upon the author(s) of the best-judged article(s) or book(s) published on Newfoundland philately.

The annual award is US\$1,000, which is given to one or more winners. If there are multiple winners in a year, they share the prize.

BNAPS President David McLaughlin wins 4th Large Gold for his Maple Leaf exhibit

McLaughlin shared on Facebook: "Concluding the Traditional Class exhibit of my Maple Leaf of Canada 1897-1898 collection with a Large Gold Medal, scoring 96 points, and receiving a Special Prize at EFIRO 2024 in Bucharest, Romania last night. This marks the fourth FIP Large Gold attained by this exhibit. Additionally, the exhibit now fulfills the criteria of earning three Large Golds in three different years — a 2022 (2), 2023 (1) and 2024(1), — qualifying it to be showcased in the FIP Championship Class for the next 10 years. Gratitude to all the friends who supported me throughout this journey, and special thanks to commissioners Jim Taylor, Charles Verge, Ed Kroft, Ingo Nessel, and Jane Sodero for representing my exhibit at FIP exhibitions from 2015 to 2024. Appreciation also goes to all the judges who provided valuable feedback over the years."
