## 50th Anniversary of the Vincent Graves Greene Philatelic Research Foundation

As the Greene Foundation celebrates its 50th anniversary in 2025 we wish to outline the services available to philatelists and postal historians. This month's topic is the Harry Sutherland Philatelic Library (HPSL) at the Greene Foundation.

The HPSL has the best BNA reference collection in the world. Our reference collection includes a wide selection of Canada Official Guides and annual Postmaster General's reports. HPSL has a comprehensive collection of Canadian auction catalogues, including historical runs of selected auction catalogues. We have research collections and fonds from important Canadian philatelists.



HSPL has a significant collection of early Canadian philatelic journals and Postal Guide Monthly Supplements, many of which have been digitized in OCR searchable format. Check the Digital Resources Hub under the Resources Tab at <a href="https://www.greenefoundation.ca/library">https://www.greenefoundation.ca/library</a>. We have a 6-week borrowing period for items in our circulating collection. Our reference collection is for in-library use only. Anyone living in Canada can request books from us. Requesters are responsible for paying both the incoming and outgoing shipping.
