When I checked and found that Wayne Curtis joined BNAPB just ten years ago, I could hardly believe it! Seems like I have been in correspondence with him for more years than that! The April issue of BNA TOPICS contained a sketch of Wayne, as No. 185 in the series. I can do no better than to copy copiously from that source.

"Born in Sutton Vermont, he received pracically all of his schooling in Montreal. The U.S. Army drafted him in 1951, and two years later he was back living in Montreal again. We'd like to have a "Clothes-line" Exhibit of items #2.








ORAPEX '75 FLAG CANCEL

As announced in the May-June Issue of the BULLETIN, ORAPEX '75 was the occasion for the appearance of a new Flag Cancel. Shown



here is an example dated May 3, 1975. We are still waiting to hear from Colin Bayley, to get the exact data on the dates of use.



### QUEPEX '75 FLAG CANCEL

May 1975 also saw still another Philatelic FLAG CANCEL make its' appearance - the very attractive QUEPEX '75 cancel, used in connection with the Annual meeting of the ROYAL PHILATELIC SOCIETY of CANADA, held in Quebec, May 29-31.

The Die was used on commercial mail for two days, May 1-2. The May 1st is known with the 8:30 PM time marking, and with a large dot above the "1" in place of the time marking. The May 2nd - a scarce date - seems to all have the Roman III above the "2" in place of the time marking.

The "Official Philatelic " use of the Die was May 29-30. On May 30th Canada observed the First Day of Use for FOUR NEW STAMPS - Bourgeoys, Chown, Cook and Desjardins. A fairly good number of these were prepared as First Days using the QUEPEX cachet covers, and cancelled with the May 30th date.

The May 29th date was used on cachet covers of QUEPEX, using the 8¢ UPU of 1974.

There was another variety of the May 30th Flag Cover - found on perhaps 250 examples of Cards, bearing the Bourgeoys stamp, so it too was a First Day. The cards were various types of the special Post Cards issued by the National Postal Museum, a Banquet Souvenir.

I did not see any May 31st Flag Covers for sale, - however at the Awards Banquet, - Guests were surprised to find that their MENU had been franked with the 2¢ Laurier and 7¢ St. Laurent (two French Canadian Prime Ministers), and cancelled with the QUEPEX FLAG dated May 31st!
