Issue #10 has no hot headlines such as new towns, as of May 13, the day when I started typing. Just a lot of news. In fact, I may have too much news for 18 pages! Can't ever complain about too many reports - but I'll try and get them all in. Also, I'll arrange them in groups by type - some highlights and questions, errors, TMs, etc. as I go along. And I'm still learning more on the Mac that'll eventually help give a better newsletter.

BOWMANVILLE, ON My latest strike is 29 XII 1989-18. I found no strike in January to March, 1990, which is unusual for this common town. The postmaster told me that as of January 1, 1990 all mail from BOWMANVILLE is being bagged and sent to the Oshawa sorting facility. As of March 31, the K machine was sitting idle and had not been used in 1990 and probably will not be used.

LA BAIE, PQ. As noted previously, the LKU at present is 23 V 1989. A report of the black box IPS without town name has been found dated 8 VIII 1989. This narrows the gap between the LKU for the K and the EKU of the IPS.



CHICOUTIMI, PQ. The new blank CHICOUTIMI machine already has a new timemark of . found on 14 II 1990..

SHERBROOKE, PQ. Denis Cottin reports that most mail at SHERBROOKE goes to Montreal by bag. The IPS machine is gone. The Klüssendorf machine is now used very infrequently. Some of the mail goes to Granby for sorting, instead of to Montreal. The K machine at SHERBROOKE is no longer a normal machine. The hub and canceller and the heart of the machine remain, but it has been modified by the addition of some peripheral attachments to allow it to carry more letters. The machine is used only for a medium-small mail day. There is also a Toshiba machine at SHERBROOKE.

SMITHS FALLS, ON. The annual March III for III at SMITHS FALLS has again appeared in 1990 on 01 III 1990, as shown above.



BLENHEIM, ON Invert. Greig Hutton reports that BLENHEIM had an invert on 02 II 1990.

This information was supplied by a friend of his who works at the post office. This information was written down two weeks after the machine (serial # 02249) started use.


THE PAS, MB. Add this town to those showing partly turned over dates. Theo Gordon reports the strike shown above, which he received on January 12, 1990.




CHATEAUGUAY, PQ. This cancel from this dead town reads 20 XII 1981-27. It occurred in the first month of use, and is an error for 20 XII 1983-27. This was also the only use of timemark -27. The cover was unpaid, so 64 cents postage due was charged - double the 32 cents unpaid.






A *Regina Klüssendorf?*



POSTAL MUSEUM. Shown here are the LKU of the previous flag (26 IX 1984) and the EKU of the K flag (27 IX 1984-09).








MORE ERRORS



UNDERLINKED Ks. Many K cancels are underlined. Some are so bad that the town name and or date is unreadable. For example, Jean Guy Dalpe has reported the HOPE, BC blank townmark. Below, this underlinked strike of MASCOCHE, PQ 19 I 1987-17 has the POCON cancel struck alongside applied by the post office so that the point of origin and date are readable with the poor K strike.



GATINEAU, PQ. Something unusual happened at GATINEAU early in 1990. The timemark = was used up to 31 XII 1989, which in itself is an unusual day to record - a Sunday before the holiday on New Years Day. On 02 I 1990, the first day after New Years Day, the new TM BL was used but only for three days (02, 03 and 04 I 1990). On 05 I 1990, a new timemark -00 was put into use until the LKU of 07 II 1990-00. On 08 II 1990, the TM was changed to BL again.


