AYLMER, PQ and GATINEAU, PQ. In a telephone conversation with the postmaster at AYLMEER, Allan was told that the K machine is still there and it is the same machine. Only the hub has been changed. Farewell to AYLMEER, PQ and hello JOX KOA! This hub reads "CANADA" across the top, "JOX" at the left, and "KOA" at the right bottom, separated by an arc line about 12 mm long. The LKU so far of AYLMEER, PQ is 24 VII 1990-18 and the EKU so far of JOX-KOA-arc is 27 VII 1990-18. AYLMEER also produced an error in its last month of use, with 07-09 VII 199 -19 for 07-09 VII 1990-19, with a timemark change also. It was corrected 10 VII 1990-19 to 19 VII 1990-19. On 20 VII 1990-18, the -18 timemark was returned to use.

From this, it can be assumed that the same situation exists at GATINEAU, PQ with only the hub being changed to the "CANADA/JOX KOA" hub but with no arc. I think it can also be assumed that the reason for the arc is for Canada Post to be able to distinguish between mail from AYLMEER and from GATINEAU with the generic idiot cancels. The LKU for GATINEAU, PQ is 23 VII 1990 BL and the EKU for JOX KOA-no arc is 24 VII 1990 BL. GATINEAU also had an error in its last month. 07-09 VI 1999 BL is reported with an invert as an error for 07-09 VII 1990 BL. It was corrected to 10 VII 1990 BL normal POSTAL CODE.

I wonder where the next idiot cancel Klüssendorf will surface? Who said K collecting is dull? Pictures of the AYLMEER and GATINEAU strikes appear on page 217, inside.

CAMPBELLVILLE, ON. A new Klüssendorf town has appeared!! CAMPBELLVILLE, ON post office is now using a K machine, but you wouldn't know it from their postmarks. They do not yet have a CAMPBELLVILLE hub, so are using the old GEORGETOWN, ON hub. Apparently their old machine malfunctioned and according to the postmistress is being sent to the National Postal Museum. The machine now being used at CAMPBELLVILLE is K Serial #2290, the machine formerly at MILTON. MILTON now has machine Serial # 2252, the old GEORGETOWN machine. The K machine started use at CAMPBELLVILLE in late June or early July. The postmistress does not remember the exact date. Two timemarks and an error are already noted:

09 VII 1990-05

11 VIII 1990 5 (error for 11 VII 1990 5)

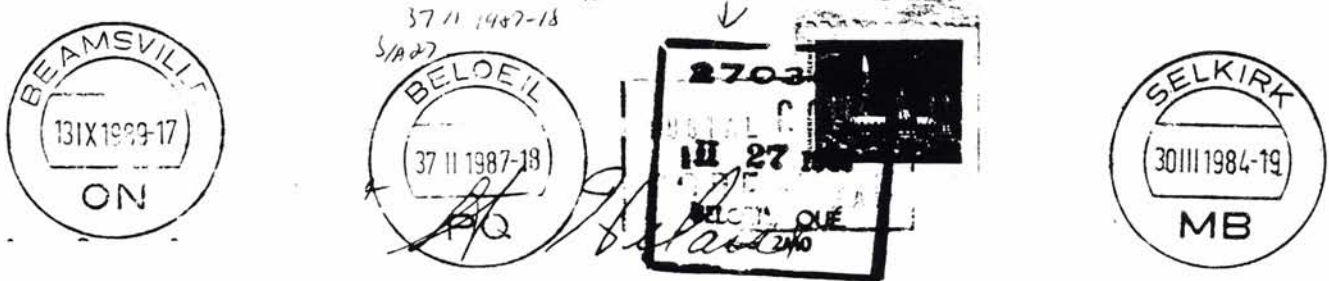

CAMPBELLVILLE post office is awaiting its own hub and as soon as it is received, it will replace the GEORGETOWN hub. To recap, we have at CAMPBELLVILLE, ON the old MILTON K machine with the GEORGETOWN hub.



Summertime let me get caught up with some of the past reports that have been in the file for a while, and some pictures. They are presented in this end-of-summer, beginning-of-fall issue (mostly prepared in early August).

BEAMSVILLE, ON. Through convoluted means, Eugene Labink was able to obtain a BEAMSVILLE cancel late in 1989. This is a very scarce one from 1988 on. The postmaster has been very uncooperative. The timemark -17 is new.



BELOEIL, PQ. Claude Gignac showed us a nice error at the BNAPS Convention in Hamilton. The K (above) has an impossible error of 37 II 1987-18 and also a POCON of 27 II 1987, which shows the error is 37 for 27. A confirming correct datestamp sure proves to be a help!

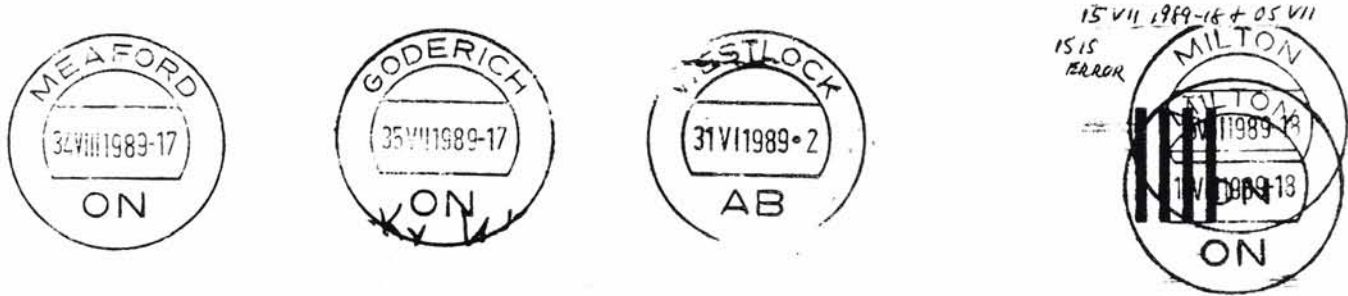
SELKIRK, MB. Bev Clark of Winnipeg showed us and reports a new EKU for SELKIRK, 30 III 1984-19 (below).

ST. ANDREWS, NB. It looks like ST. ANDREWS is using a 30-mm single ring datestamp frequently instead of the K machine. When there is not sufficient mail to warrant using the K, it is being handstamped. So this is why Ks from here are scarce.



BURNS LAKE, BC. During the entire month of July 1989, the K cancels from BURNS LAKE were in error, with VI for VII. Reports from a controlled mail source cover 4 VII to 26 VII. No VII cancels were reported so far. One cover had the 38-cent photography stamp (above) dated 04 VI 1989. - but the stamp was issued 23 VI 1989, so this shows on the cover that the date is an error.

IMPOSSIBLE DATES. Here are three more: MEAFORD, ON 34 VIII 1989 for 24 VIII 1989; GODERICH, ON 35 VII 1989-17; and WESTLOCK, AB 31 VI 1989.2 (which is a month error for July, or 31 VII 1989).



MILTON, ON. A day error occurred here on July 5, 1989. Some covers were cancelled 15 VII 1989-18, and were recancelled with the correct date of 05 VII 1989-18 (as above).

OLIVER, BC. In 1988, timemark . was used in OLIVER and is recorded up to 9 I 1989. . On 11 I 1989, a new TM .0 is found but it didn't last long as on 13 I 1989 another new TM is found, .9, which is recorded up to 15 VI 1989 as this was written. On 29 VI 1989 8, another shortlived new TM was found, timemark 8 with no dash, and again another new timemark is found on 6 VII 1989, timemark -0 which is also reported on 28 VII 1989. We note that all three uses of "0" timemarks are different with .0, -0, and 0 being used.



SYDNEY MINES, NS. On 27 I 1989, an impossible date cancel is recorded on a cover, reading 37 I 1989-16. A second cover (above) had both this error and the corrected date of 27 I 1989-16.

PORT DOVER, ON. An interesting cover has been found with strikes of three types of machine cancels. It originated at Lethbridge, AB with an IPS cancel of 26 V 1989, and was addressed to Paris, ON. It was misssent to PORT DOVER, ON where a K cancel was applied 30 V 1989-18, and in transit to Paris a Waterford, ON 1 VI 1989 Pitney Bowes machinee cancel was applied.

SOME YEAR ERRORS. AYLMER WEST, ON is reported with 27 VI 1980-18 for 27 VI 1989-18. ANTIGONISH, NS had a dramatic year error, 13 VI 2018-17 for 13 VI 1989-17. STE. ADELE, PQ shows a year and month error of 27 VII 1980-18 for 27 VI 1989-18. VAL D'OR, PQ shows 12 VIII 1990.1 for 12 VII 1989.1 (a scarce TM for this town). STE. JULIE DE VERCHERES, PQ shows 13 VIII 1980=1 for 13 VII 1989=1, which is also a new TM.

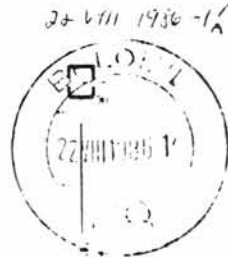
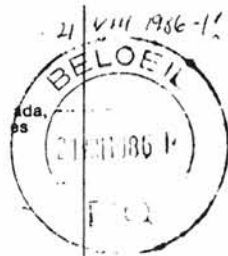

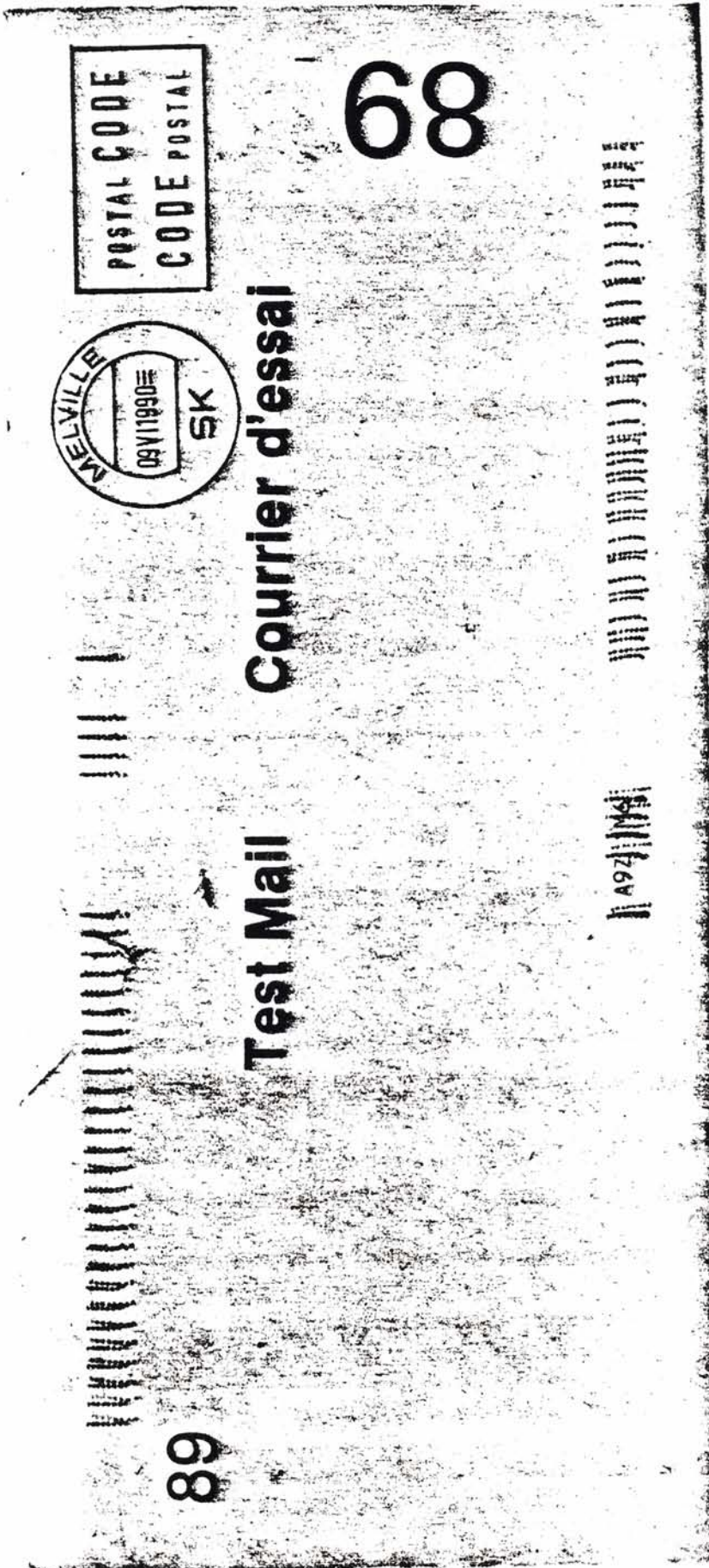

BELOEIL, PQ. An interesting error occurred in August 1986 in the K strikes of BELOEIL. The normal timemark used was -18. Something happened on 21 VIII 1986, such as a loose pin, and the last digit in the TM slot rolled. Strikes are known with TM -18, -1, and with -7. Similar strikes are known on the 22nd with the same three varieties of timemark. Strikes are also known on 26 VIII and 30 VIII with the partly-rolled 7 and a TM -18 is recorded on 28 VIII. By 03 IX 1986, the -18 TM is back but not quite in line. Shortly thereafter, all was correct again.

NAPANEE, ON is a good town for a study of timemarks. The EKU is 03 I 1984, as noted by Dan Hunka. The only error noted when this was written was 04 II 1989-07 for 04 I 1989-07, a month error, with 3 and 5 I 1989 being correct.

I have recorded the use of timemarks -06, -07, -13, -14, -15, -16, -17, -18, and -19 at NAPANEE. In addition, there are reports of -12 and .18 which I have not seen; if a member has these or any other timemarks, please let us have your report with the dates of use.

The commonest timemarks are -07, -16, and -18. TM -07 is seen from 11 II 1984 up to July 1989. TM -16 is seen from December 1984 to July 1989. TM -18 is recorded from 27 I 1984 to 14 XII 1988. Next in frequency is TM -13, which is reported from 17 I 1984 to 21 IX 1987. There are no 1988 or 1989 reports of TM -13.

TM -14 is less frequently reported, with six strikes: 2 III 1984, 23 V 1984, 1 X 1985, and 18 XI 1986 on weekdays and 2 II 1985 and 31 VIII 1985 on Saturdays. Timemark -19 is reported only on 08 and 09 IV 1987. This is probably an adjustment for TM -18 for a couple of days. TM -17 has been recorded only on 01 I 1987, the first working day in the year, and again is not normal. TM -15 has been recorded only five times, once in 1984 on 24 VIII 1984 and four times in 1988: 28 IV, 17 X, 07 XI, and 11 XII; a Wednesday, two Fridays, and a Sunday. TM -06 is reported twice, 06 IX 1988 (a Tuesday) and 06 X 1988 (a Thursday).

The most interesting thing in a study of NAPANEE timemarks is the existence of matched pairs. So far, there are no reports of three timemarks on the same date. The following are the recorded matched pairs, with the quantity of each:

-06 and -07 - 1	-07 and -18 - 6	-15 and -16 - 1
-07 and -13 - 2	-13 and -15 - 1	-16 and -18 - 2
-07 and -16 - 3	-13 and -16 - 2	
-07 and -17 - 1	-13 and -18 - 4	

Few definitive statements can be made about the timemarks of NAPANEE. First, in 1989, only -07 and -16 have been reported. There is much more regularity now and/or there are fewer dispatches of mail. Second, in 1988, there are only two Sunday reports, one of which is a TM -15 report, and in 1989, only one Sunday report so far. It appears that mail was not normally processed on Sunday. Third, the series of matched timemarks suggests that there were generally more than two mail clearances a day and/or the time on the machine was changed more frequently than twice a day. The long periods of time over which several of the TMs are reported and the great variety of the matched pairs also suggests this. TM -12 and TM .18 are reported, but not yet confirmed.

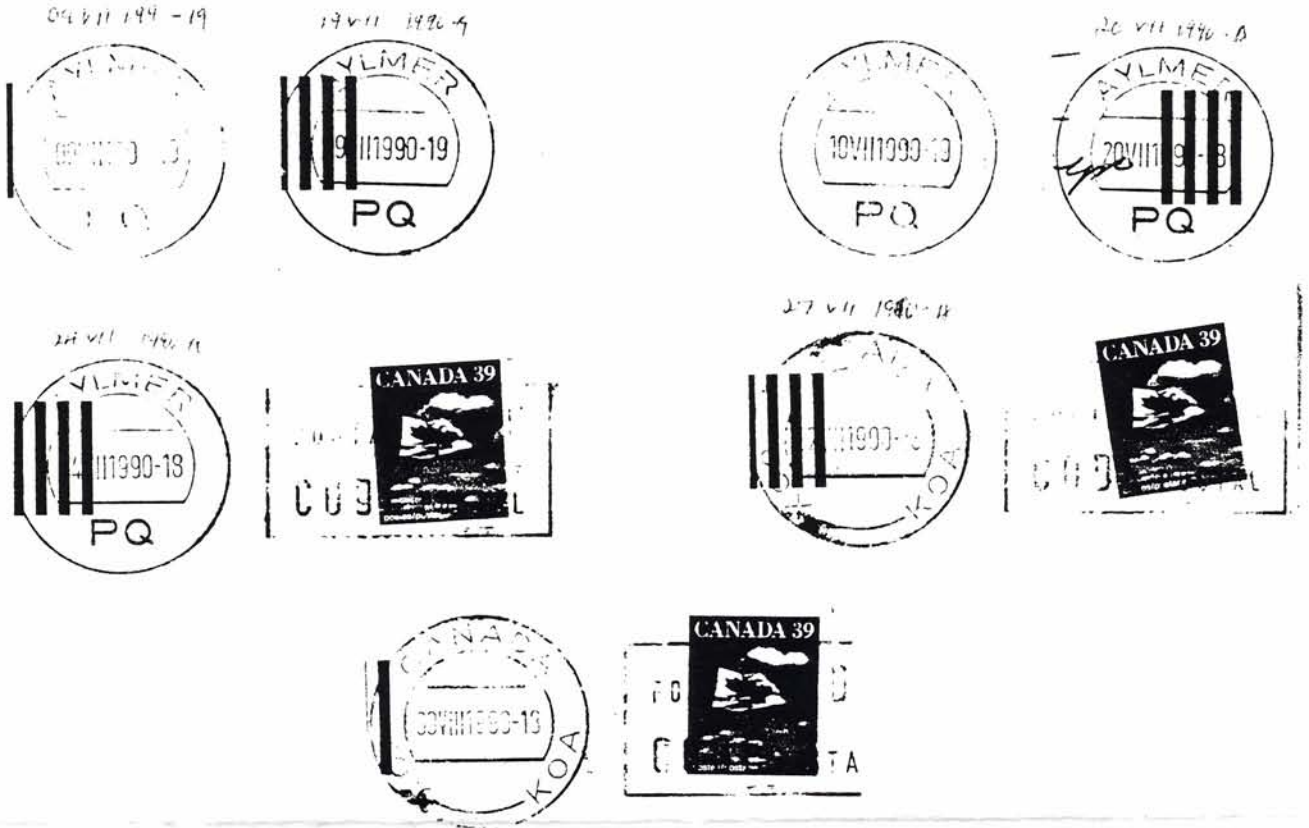

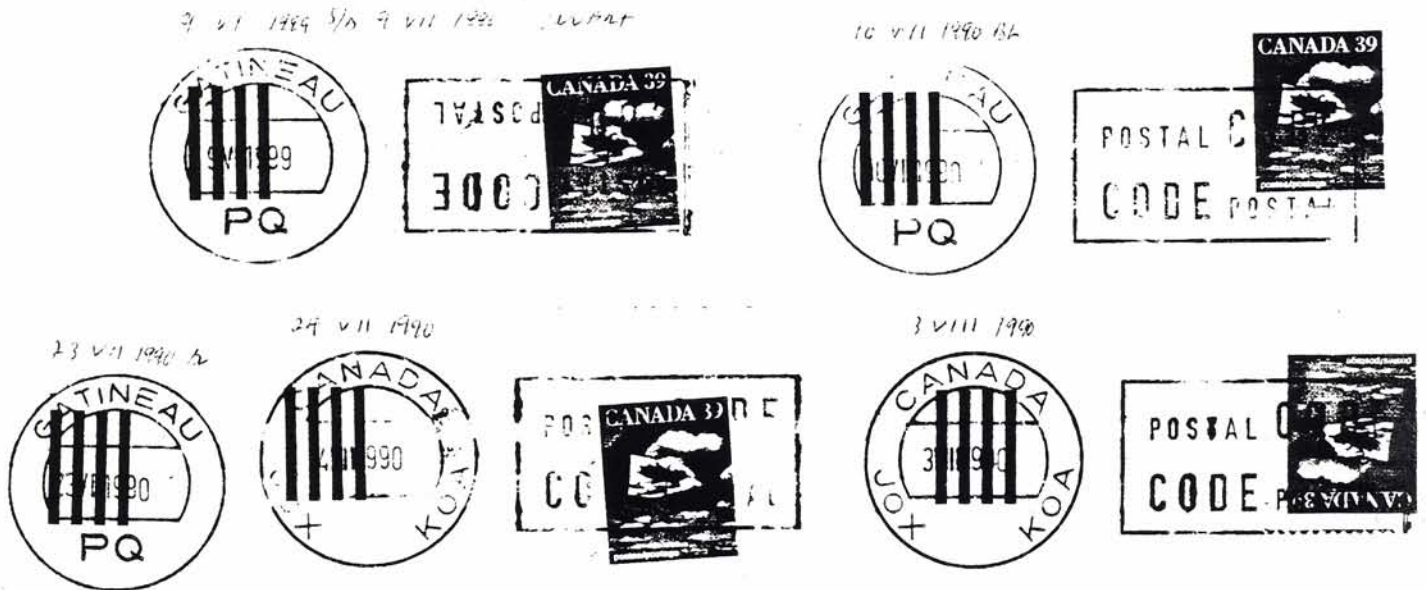

AYLMER, PQ - Goodbye. JOX KOA - Hello. Note the arc between JOX and KOA.

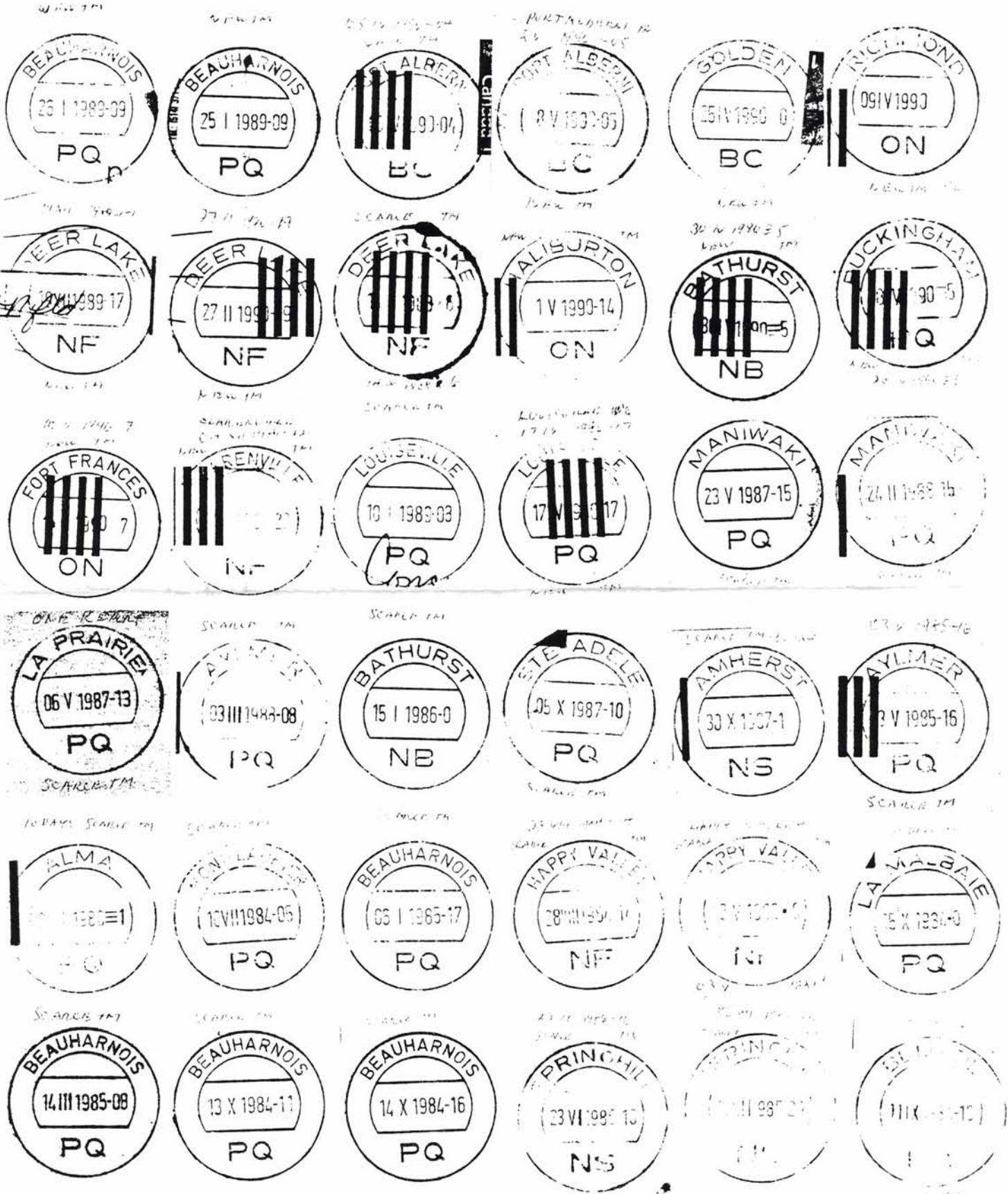


GATINEAU, PQ. An invert, and then it's gone and replaced by idiot cancel JOX KOA - without the arc. See the front page for details.



PORT ALBERNI, BC. The Salmon Festival slogan was repeated in 1988 at PORT ALBERNI. My LKU of the POSTAL CODE is 2 VIII 1988, and my EKU of the slogan is 5 VIII 1988. My LKU of the slogan is 20 IX 1988, and the EKU of the POSTAL CODE killer after the slogan is 21 IX 1988.

Robert Meek has sent in these interesting reports:

- Page 173 - Confirmation of BLENHEIM, ON invert, with a date of 02 II 1990
- Page 175 - SPRINGHILL, NS error 12 II 199 -0 to 28 V 199 -0; extend the period
- Page 186 - Bob notes that he too collects the 38-cent flag self-adhesive on cover and has three different so far. He has started the same with the 39-cent self-adhesive.
- Page 187 - SMITHERS in purple - reports of 03, 04, 18 IV 1990.
- Page 187 - AMHERST, NS - extend the period to 08-29 V 1980-1 error for 1989
- Page 188 - WINDSOR, ON in list - correct to PQ. Correct WOODSTOCK, ON to NE

Bob reports some new INVERTS. He adds "I love 'em." Don't we all?

- PRINCE RUPERT (slogan) 31 XII 1989.
- L'ASSOMPTION 23 III to 24 V 1990-00
- DAWSON CREEK 26 II 1990.0
- GATINEAU 5-9 VI 1999 BL (should be 1990 VII)
- COCHRANE 11-17 VII 1990-16

The PRINCE RUPERT inverted slogan, Bob notes, is only the third inverted slogan. The previous were PICTON and WEYBURN. Bob also reports the impossible date error of 33 V 1990-18 at PARIS, ON.

Bob asks about BELOEIL, PQ - when did the outer rim of the dater get broken? He has an LKU of the unbroken ring of 31 VI 1989 8 with a large gap (no covers) until the EKU of the broken ring on 14 VIII 1989-18.

SPRUCE GROVE, AB. Kevin O'Reilly sent me a few K covers, from a regular controlled mail source. There were 5 or 6 from SPRUCE GROVE, and two of them had the dates 24 V 1990 BL and 26 VI 1990 BL. Was either of these an error (see page 199)? The answer is yes - the 24 V 1990 is an error for 24 IV 1990. I can tell this only because of the monthly sequence of the dates on these covers (telephone bills). The 26 VI date is correct - paying the phone bill for June. This shows the necessity of controlled mail sources - and probably also how trivial some of these errors really are!

And a few interesting dates. David Harding of Victoria sent me cut squares with these dates:

- PENTICTON, BC 18 IV 1986 Confirmation of LKU
- PENTICTON, BC 29 II 1996.1 TM .1 was reported only for January 30-February 5, 1985,

and the error of 29 II-1996.1 has been reported previously, probably for 29 I 1985 (p. 116). Now that's the kind of error that I like - there's no doubt about it. (kgs)

PORT ALBERNI, BC. 1989 was an interesting year for PORT ALBERNI Ks. The year started with TM = 0 as in 1988. There was an error on 10 I 1989, with 01 I 1989=0 instead. This timemark lasted until 31 I 1990. On 1 II 1989 an error of 1 II 1987.8 occurred. This was corrected on the 2nd, with 2 II 1989.8. Things went normally until the 30th of March when the error 30 IV 1989.8 (for III) occurred. The 31st of March also was in error, with 31 IV 1989.8. Again, things were fine from 01 IV 1989.8 until 17 VI 1989.8. From the 22nd of June, a year and month error was reported with a new TM: 22-30 V 1988.6 for VI 1989. This led to a second error noted as 04-05 IV 1989.7 for VII 1989 with another new timemark (.7). This was corrected by 11 VII 1989.7. Then we come across the errors of 26 IV 2016 4 (no dash) for 26 VII 1989 and 28 IV 2016 7 (no dash) for 28 VII 1989. On 2 VIII 1989.8, everything is back in order. Perhaps some of you can fill some of the holes in these listings. (unfortunately, most of the photocopies from Allan are obscured by black bars, so only the clearest are shown below).



Speaking of PORT ALBERNI, Bill Robinson has sent a photocopy (above right) of the new TM -08, dated 17 VIII 1990-08.

Experiment time again. On the next page or so, I am trying a new typeface for some lists. This type seems to be particularly clear on the dot-matrix printer for numerals. And that's the main feature of our lists. Too bad the Mac doesn't use (easily) daisy wheel printers. And on our budget, I can't afford a laser printer here at home.

TIMEMARKS and ERRORS. I don't know where this list came from in the files, but it's got a lot of timemark change, etc from the turn of the year

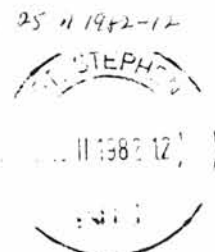

KENTVILLE, NS Carl Munden brought me a copy of the Sept. 1990 issue (Vol. 2, #3) of the Postal History Study Group of N.S. newsletter. It included the following material on the chronology of the K and IPS machines at KENTVILLE from mid-1988, prepared by Roger Greer.

1. 12 V 88 K machine in use with usual -16 timemark
2. 31 III 89 K machine switches to TM -17
3. 19 VI 89 Test of IPS machine, replaced by K machine 30 VI
4. 8 VIII 89 K machine with -17 timemark
5. 29 IX 89 Test of IPS continues
6. 20 XI 89 Test machine breaks, so K machine put back in service. Strikes of both machines on this day
7. 22 XI 89 K machine back in service; TM is -17
8. 23 XI 89 Timemark of K machine changes to -22
9. 4 XII 89 K machine with -22 TM continues until
10. 11 XII 89 IPS reappears, with a test
11. 19 XII 89 K machine returns (-22)
12. 3 II 90 K machine with TM -22 continues
13. 7 II 90 K timemark changes to -18

Some reports of early K reports. ANTIGONISH, MAGOG, MEADOW LAKE, ST. STEPHEN. Here are examples of scarce early TMs. The ANTIGONISH, NS strike shows TM -16 used on 4 IV 1984. We have a second report on 30 IV 1984. MAGOG, PQ has an early report of 29 XI 1983= .It appears that this TM was in use only in Nov. 1983. An error of 4 IV 1983-16 for 1984 has been reported for MEADOW LAKE, SK This is an early strike; the EKU for this town isn't clear. ST. STEPHEN, NB - a report of an error of 25 II 1982-12 for 25 II 1984-12 also gives us a new TM.



BELOEIL, PQ. BELOEIL shows a month error of VI for VII in 1989. Again, this type of error is virtually impossible to prove later unless there is a second cancel, the date of issue of the stamp is after the cancellation date, or the mail is from a controlled source. We have reports of this error from 04 to 31 VI (VII) 1989. The 31 VI 1989 8 report is an impossible date. It is the provable error for 31 VII.

Also, there was a change in TM on 11 VIII 1989-18 when this timemark replaced the 8 TM.

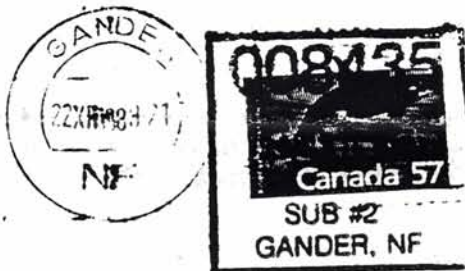

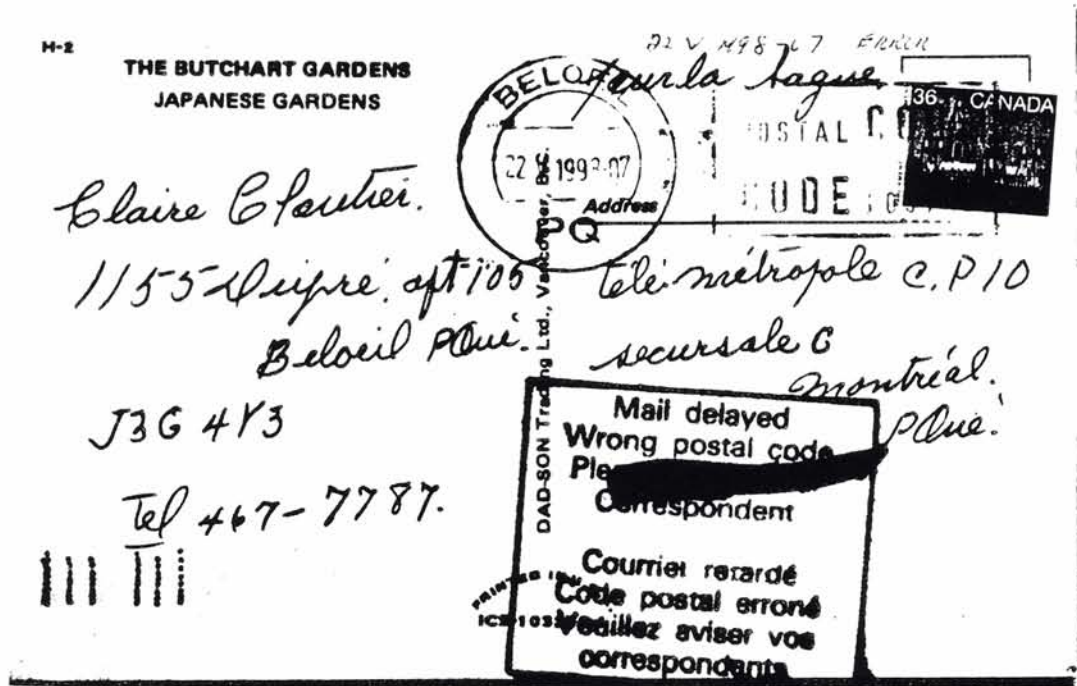

GANDER, NF. Some K towns with suboffices have the stamps cancelled by the POCONs or other handstamps of the suboffices and are then postmarked again by the main post office's Klussendorf. These two-cancel covers add some variety to a collection. Below is a cancel of GANDER, NF Sub #2 in combination with the GANDER, NF 22 XII 1988-21 K, as reported by Robert Meek.



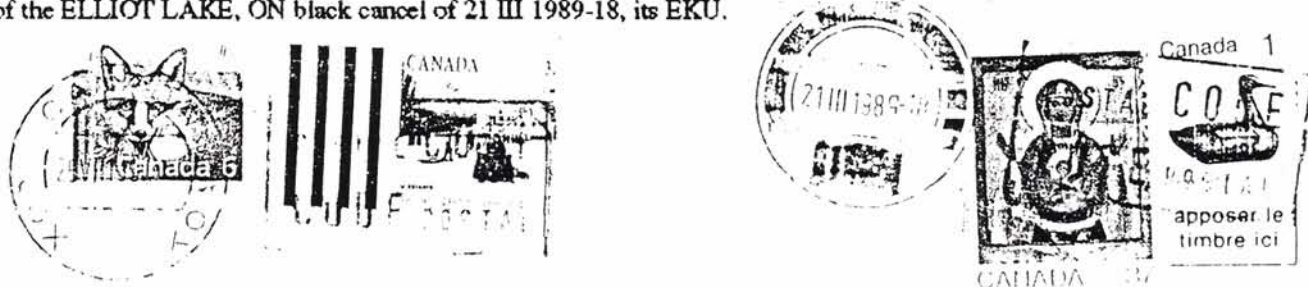
BELOEIL, PQ. Here is a date error of 22 V 1998-07 instead of 22 IV 1987-07. In addition, the "Mail delayed..." handstamp adds immeasurably to the interest of the item.

GATINEAU, PQ. Gilles Tremblay reports an EKU of the JOX KOA (no arc) GATINEAU cancel of 25 VII 1990 (below). He also reports a strike of the ELLIOT LAKE, ON black cancel of 21 III 1989-18, its EKU.



WAINWRIGHT, AB. Strikes for May through August are infrequent. I've seen one in May, one in June, and none since. Is this K machine being phased out, used for local mail only, or what? Perhaps a western member could check it out.

BOWMANVILLE, ON. Still no reports for 1990, so it appears that this K town is finished. The PM told me all mail - even local - is going to the Oshawa facility. The LKU at present is 29 XII 1989-18, used only 27-29 XII 1989 in this late period.

CAMPBELLFORD, ON. Since 1984, the normal TM has been -16, with -11 used on Saturdays. TM-11 was not scarce but -16 is much more common. There are numerous reports in 1990 but so far no TM -11 after January. We have three Saturday 1990 reports after January, all -16, so it appears that -11 has been discontinued.

INGERSOLL, ON. Has timemark =5 been discontinued? From early 1985, TM -19 and some form of 5 such as =5, the commonest, -05, and 5 has been used for 7 PM and 5 AM clearances. Both timemarks were seen commonly, with -19 the more common. The latest report of =5 is in February 1990, with many -19 seen after February 26.
