New K Towns

There have been three new towns reported since our last issue. The three new Klüssendorf cancels brought into use by Canada Post are:

ST-ELIE-D'ORFORD, PQ - early report is June 16/92 (R. Meek) Blank timemark

SAINTE-MARIE, PQ - early reports are Aug. 26 and 27/92 (A. Steinhart and R. Meek) Blank timemark

GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR, NF (a merger of two older Klüssendorfs) - early report is 12 XI 1992-17 (A.S.)

Naturally, we'd like as much pertinent information about these new cancels as we can get.

Here are some pictures of the new postmarks. Thanks to Father Walker for the Sainte-Marie xerox, dated 21 X 1992 BL. The St-Elie-D'Orford strike is dated 28 VII 1992. The Grand Falls-Windsor, NF is the early strike, 12 XI 1992-17.



And here are a few pages that I've had prepared for quite some time.




Special delivery covers with K cancels are not too common. Here's one mailed at PONOKA, AB dated 16 XI 1988 BL



Registered K covers are not common, either. Here is a pair of them, sent to me by Kevin O'Reilly in Yellowknife. One is for the last day of the Suboffice 1 in Yellowknife, December 9, 1991. Believe me, the K cancel for YELLOWKNIFE is there (10 XII 1991 =). The other cover is from the first day (opening) of a new REPO (retail postal outlet) - same dates as the other registered cover. Would you believe that I received them a week apart?




And the second QUEBEC K machine was still going strong on 17 XII 1991 BL



This cover with a KAPUSKASING corner card has the error 07 X 199 - 15 in the Klussendorf cancel.




Jeff Switt has prepared cacheted covers to commemorate the Alaska Highway anniversary. Here's an example, used at FORT NELSON, BC on 03 X 1991-0.



While I'm illustrating a few covers, here are several interesting items from PHILEX. The first is a card that was mailed at SMITHERS, BC on 31 V 1988-00, to Brockville. Somehow, it was marked with an incorrect bar code. The next mark is a machine cancel L4W 1T0 on 3 VI 1988, and the final mark is a cds at BARRY'S BAY, ON on 7 VI 1988. There's no indication when it got to Brockville. The second is a double K strike at LA PRAIRIE, PQ. The dates of the cancels are 16 VI 1989-18 and 21 VI 1989-18.



Another K item is from LA TUQUE, PQ (no town name showing) - with a nice return address. The date is 16 III 1990 =.


Bruce Murduck sent information on his accumulation of covers with the PERTH, ON Come on Home/175th Anniversary slogan.

LKU of POSTAL CODE killer 29 V 1991 BL

EKU of the slogan 3 VI 1991 BL

See dates of slogan to 22 VII 1991 BL

Bruce also sent photocopies of a BRIGHTON, ON error of 16 IX 1992 9, and the normal 23 VII 1991 08. The error envelope was presumed to have been postmarked on 16 VII 1991.



Bruce also sent a copy of the WHITEHORSE, YT Alaska Highway slogan with an incomplete date impression. It is dated 28 VI 1991 . but the year wheel has rolled.

Bruce reports that GANANOQUE local mail includes Kingston and is cancelled with the K. All other mail is processed in Ottawa. Mail from PICTON, TRENTON, COBOURG, and PORT HOPE is trucked to Toronto's L4W 1T0 postal plant and is processed there in a Toshiba machine.


MISSION, BC New timemark seen with cover dated 14 VII 1992 0 (TM 0)

PRINCETON, BC New timemark (.1) on a cover dated 20 VIII 1992.1

OSOYOOS, BC Also has a new TM of .0 as seen on cover dated 14 IX 1992 .0; meter on the cover is dated 14 VIII '92, so one of them is an error.

TERRACE, BC Timemark .1 used on 10 IX 1993 error (for 1992). On 03 IX 1992 the timemark was a dot.



[Wally, I suspect that the April date is an error. The 39¢ stamp indicates 1990. The postmaster possibly found his error and corrected it before forwarding the letter. kgs] This interesting cover is shown below.
