1963 Royal Canadian Ordnance Corps Diamond Jubilee 1903-1963. Used in 8 cities.

1963 1903-1963 Corps Magasins Militaires Royal Canadienne. Used in Montreal and Quebec only.

1963 Royal Canadian Signals Diamond Jubilee 1903-1963. Toronto

1964 Royal 22nd Regiment 1914-1964 50ieme Anniversire. Montreal and St. Jean.

1964 PPCLI Jubilee 1914-1964. Ottawa.

44... Canadian Overseas Expeditionary Force cancel



This surely is a handsome postmark! The late Lt. Col. R.H. Webb in 1964 wrote of two hammer types, a rubber and a steel, the former having smaller printing around the rim. Examples of the former are known dated while the C.E.F. was en route to England. This refers to the First Contingent. Shortly afterward examples as shown came over from England. This cancel known over a six month period only and the date 1914 makes it an early one. See also Boggs illustration on page 645.

45... Slogan meter cancel

An interesting slogan cancel was in use at Camp Borden at least till October 1973. It appears that an error crept into the design in the double use of the word Borden in the left block of the slogan. The French inscription correctly reads, Borden, Ontario. Check your copy.

47...Earliest date report - Item 38




In closing this Newsletter we think these cancels will be of interest, one from each coast and the third from England. Maybe! Three additional pages follow.




