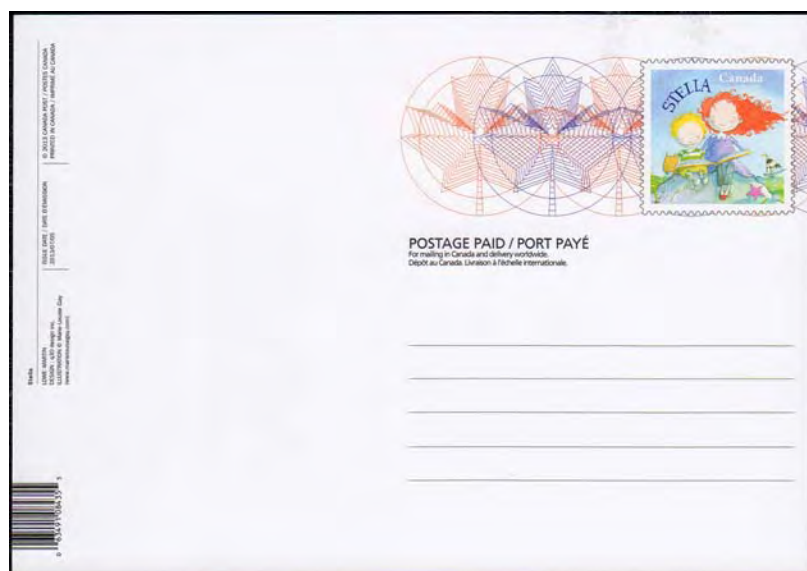
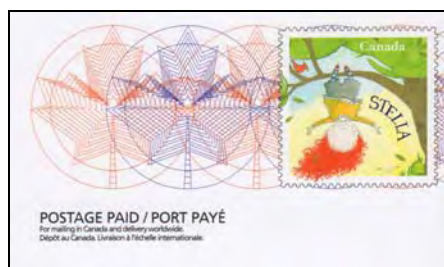
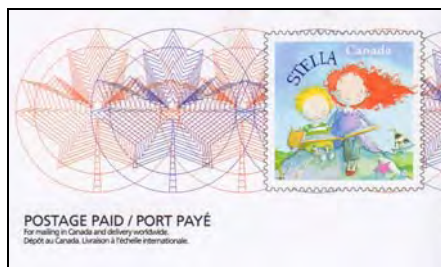

July 5, 2013 the **Stella** cards, featuring the illustrations of Marie-Louise Gay and honoring Children's Literature, were issued, with the following stamp dies: The card views replicate the stamps.

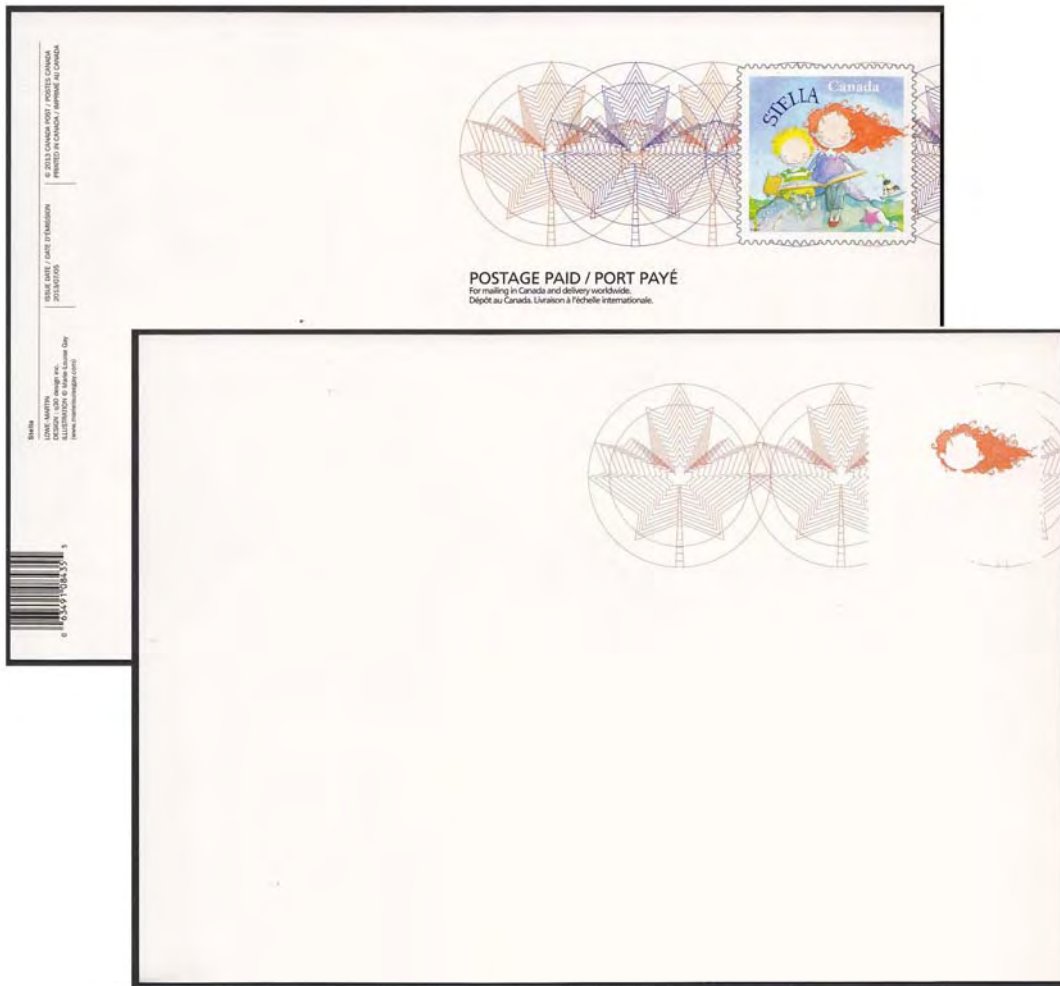

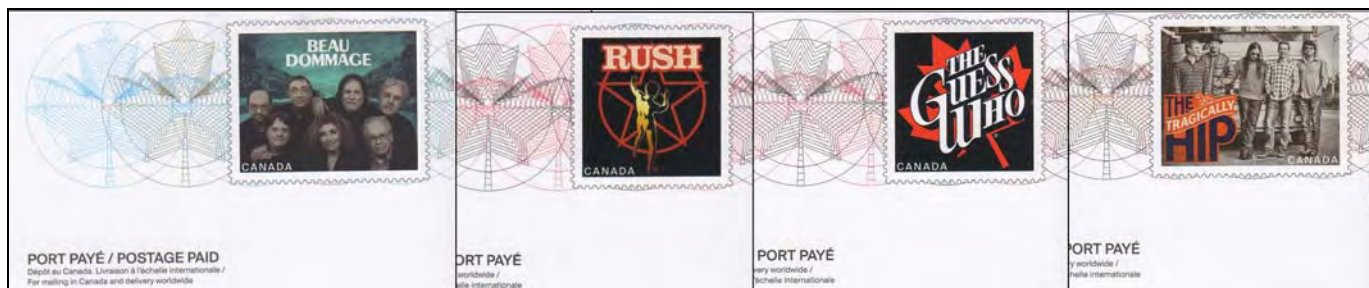

In late August, when Dudley Nash (BNAPS member but not a PSSG member) picked up copies of these at the Montreal Philatelic counter, a missing color error was discovered when the clerk attempted to scan the card. The face (illustration) side of the card was correct, but the address side showed only the red color printed. No other copies were amongst the ones on sale.

July 17, 2013 Four **Canadian Recording Artist** cards. These have been issued every other year since 2007 – these four make a total of 16 in total issued. 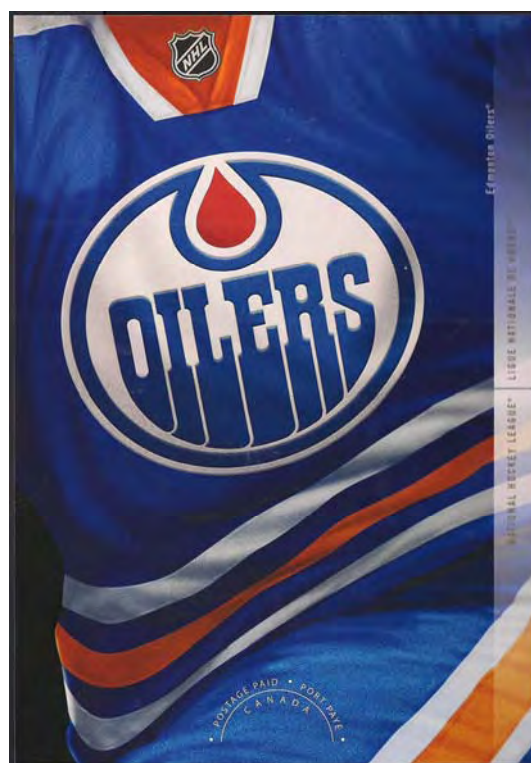

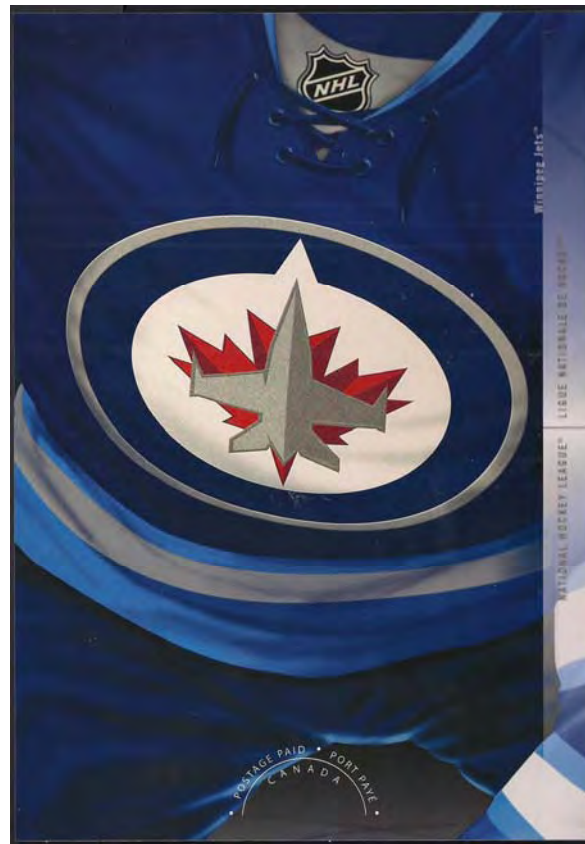

Product # (Set of 7): 262373

SUPERMAN Post Cards, 2 sets of 5 each, issued Sept 10, 2013, with imprinted international rate stamps. These cards are for sale in Canada only – that is, you cannot order them from abroad (probably because of license limitations). Collectors will have to make arrangements with Canadian friends to obtain mint sets. They may or course be mailed abroad.

BACKGROUND (from *Details*:*) Superman was co-created in 1938 by Canadian Joe Shuster and American Jerry Siegel. This celebrates 75 years of Superman.
