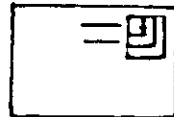

## PREFACE

During the past two years one major project of the BNAPS Postal Stationery Study Group has been to determine the earliest date of use of Canadian and Newfoundland postal stationery items. This has been done by recording the Earliest Reported Postmark (ERP) for each item, based on data provided by study group members.

The present list began as a list provided by Bill Walton, who has coordinated the entire project. Literally hundreds of dates have been pushed back with the help of other study group members. Nevertheless, what is presented here is still a preliminary list, best regarded as a working document for a project in progress. Dates given are those reported in Postal Stationery Notes through Vol. 2, No. 5.

It is hoped that members who have been putting off checking their collections will now check them. Fully 70% of the original target dates provided for pre-Elizabethan items still have not been changed! There has been a much larger number of changes in the Elizabethan ERPs, but earlier dates will undoubtedly also be found for most of the items of that era. If you have an ERP please send a photocopy of the front and the back of the item either directly to Bill Walton (R. D. #1 Box 454, Califon, NJ 07830, U.S.A.) or c/o the editor of Postal Stationery Notes (Robert Lemire, Box 549, Pinawa, Man., Canada ROE 1L0). To avoid confusion at a later date, ERPs for "mimeo" stock postal cards and other paper varieties will not be changed unless the item is examined by Bill Walton.

The stationery is arranged by Webb Catalogue number. The ERP and the Postal Stationery Notes reference are given. For convenience, Higgins and Gage catalogue numbers are also provided. The numerous ERP reporters responsible for progress in this project have been noted in Postal Stationery Notes. Special thanks goes to Steven Whitcombe who has computerized the ERP list, updated it several times, and who provided the master copy for this list.
