Details of all recorded envelopes are set out in the following lists. Information includes a full description of each envelope together with details of the users and their imprints (corner cards) and dates used when known. References are taken from:

ABBREVIATIONS are as in the handbook above, with two additional items:

Imp. - Imprint (corner card, identified by number) giving name and/or address of the user, on the front or back of the envelope.

Ad.- Advertisement, message or design (identified by letter) where than one is known from a particular user

USERS In general, the user of a precancelled envelope is identified in the imprint or address. However, a number of users of precancelled envelopes did not include the name of their company or organization in the printed address or return address. Some users included their name on some envelopes but not on others. With the help of city directories it has been possible to identify many of these "anonymous" users from their addresses and knowing the approximate dates the envelopes were printed. In such cases the actual "user" is noted in the main list. For the convenience of the reader a cross-index of such "anonymous" users and addresses is provided below.

DATED The earliest recorded date of use. This is usually from a postmark, but occasionally can be a date received "stamp", dated contents, or even a handwritten note. Additional dates are badly needed, especially for the different pennysaver flaps.

STATE The different "states" known for an envelope, i.e.,
PS-S (priced sample - "Specimen"),
PS (priced sample),
SO ("Specimen Only"),
UN (unused),
U (used).

1. Within a given size, envelopes are listed in the following order: cross flap, pennysaver (P/S) flap numbers, tab, side seams.

A NEWLY DISCOVERED PRECANCELLED REGULAR ISSUE ENVELOPE

Pierre Gauthier forwarded (December 1989) a photocopy of an extremely interesting new envelope. This is the first recorded #8 regular issue envelope used as a precancelled envelope. Furthermore, neither the user nor the precancel type have been reported previously. The envelope is shown below. Earle Covert has assigned the catalogue number EN52 to this envelope.
