PRECANCELLED CANADIAN REVENUE STAMPS

Used on Playing Cards and Mouth Wash

This is a reprint of a listing of these items published by Ed Richardson in his publication, "Canadian and Revenue B.N.A. Yearbook" - 1962.

As far as we know the following listing is the first list published on these items. Much of the following listing is based on information given us by Carl Sonne of Moose Jaw, Sask., and has been checked against our own collection.

We hope that the publication of this list will open a new field of revenue possibilities to Members of the Canadian Revenue Study Group.

The A.P.C. CO. (American Playing Card Co. ?)

Type 1 - "A.P.C. / Co." in two lines - between horizontal bars.

A 1 - 20¢ carmine (3 leaf)

A 2 - 1 pack violet playing card stamp.

Type 2 - "A.P.C." in one line between vertical bars.

A 3 - 1 pack violet playing card stamp.

The C.P.C. Co. (Canadian Playing Card Co. ?)

Type 1 - "Cancelled / C.P.C.Co." in two lines, in red.

C 1 - 10¢ blue (2 leaf)

C 1a - as above, invert.

C 1b - as above, normal and invert.

C 1c - first line normal, second line "C.P." only.

C 2 - 5¢ blue (3 leaf)

C 3 - 10¢ blue (3 leaf)

C 3a - as above, invert.

Type 2 - Precancelled as above, but in red violet.

C 4 - 10¢ blue (2 leaf)

C 5 - 10¢ blue (3 leaf)

Used Canadian Revenue Stamps (continued)

C. Co. (?)

e 1 ~ "Cancelled/C.L.M.Co." in two lines.
Legs of "M" straight and parallel - in red.

L 1 ~ 15¢ orange (head)
L 1a ~ inverted "C" missing
L 2 ~ 8¢ blue (2 leaf)
L 3 ~ 10¢ blue (2 leaf)
L 3a ~ as above, invert.
L 3b ~ as above, doubled

e 2 ~ Precancelled as above, but legs of "M" are spread upward outward
in red.

L 4 ~ 15¢ orange (head)
L 5 ~ 8¢ blue (2 leaf)
L 6 ~ 10¢ blue (2 leaf)
L 6a ~ as above, invert.

C. S. Ltd. (?)

e 1 ~ "Cancelled / C.S.S. Ltd." in two lines ~ typewriter stencil.

G 1 ~ 15¢ orange (head)

e 2 ~ as above, but typeset, lower line with serifa.

G 2 ~ 15¢ orange (head)

"International" Co. (?)

e 1 ~ "Cancelled / International" in two lines, lower line small
font - in black.

I 1 ~ 10¢ blue (2 leaf)
I 2 ~ 10¢ blue (3 leaf)

Precancelled Canadian Revenue Stamps (continued)

The U.S.P.C.Co. (U. S. Playing Card Co. ?)

Type 1 - "Cancelled / U.S.P.C. CO." in two lines -
the only type with the lower line all caps - in black

- U 1 - 3¢ green (war tax)
- U 2 - 4¢ blue (war tax)
- U 3 - same as above, with red surcharge
- U 4 - 7¢ brown (head)
- U 5 - 8¢ brown (war tax)
- U 5a - as above, invert.
- U 6 - 15¢ orange (head)
- U 6a - as above, invert.
- U 7 - 25¢ carmine (war tax)
- U 8 - 50¢ brown (war tax)

Type 2 - "Cancelled / U.S.P.C.Co." in two lines
"Cancelled" tall thin type, 17 mm long.
"U.S.P.C.Co." lightly shaded type, 16 mm long.

- U 9 - 15¢ orange (head)
- U 10 - 10¢ blue (2 leaf)
- U 10a - as above, invert.

Type 3 - in two lines - "Cancelled" heavy type, 18 mm long.
"U.S.P.C.Co." shaded type, 18 mm long.

- U 11 - 15¢ orange (head)
- U 12 - 8¢ blue (2 leaf)

Type 4 - as above, in two lines - "Cancelled" shaded type, 17 mm long.
"U.S.P.C.Co." lightly shaded 19 mm long.

- U 13 - 15¢ orange (head)
- U 14 - 8¢ blue (2 leaf)

Type 5 - as above, in two lines - "Cancelled" shaded type, 17 mm long.
"U.S.P.C.Co." lightly shaded 17 mm long

- U 15 - 8¢ blue (2 leaf)
- U 16 - 10¢ blue (2 leaf)

Type 6 - as above, in two lines - the only type with the lower line
in sans-serif letters - lower line 20½ mm long.

- U 17 - 8¢ brown (war stamp)
- U 18 - 15¢ orange (head)

Precancelled Canadian Revenue Stamps (continued)

General Use (no company name)

Type 1 - "Cancelled" only in black

- X 1 - 15¢ orange (head)
- X 2 - 10¢ blue (2 leaf)
- X 3 - 15¢ blue (3 leaf)
- X 4 - "15" black on 2¢ blue
- X 5 - "15" blue on 2¢ blue
- X 6 - 20¢ blue (3 leaf)
- X 7 - 20¢ carmine (3 leaf)
- X 8 - "20" red on 15¢ blue
- X 9 - 10¢ blue (3 leaf)

Kem Plastic Playing Cards

Type 1 - KEM emblem - with "PLASTIC PLAYING CARDS" to right in three lines.

- K 1 - 20¢ carmine (3 leaf)

Pepsodent Co.

Type 1 - "Pepsodent / Co." in two lines.

- P 1 - 8¢ brown (war tax)
- P 2 - 10¢ green (war tax)

While this list covers the Precancels used on Playing Cards and Mouth Wash, there are many other types of precancels or Canadian War Tax and Excise Tax Stamps. Some of these are listed as "a" numbers in dissons, some are not. We would like Study Group members to report any precancels, by sending a Xerox copy or the stamp itself, to Ed. Richardson, P.O.
