FEDERAL SUPREME COURT 10000 QUEBEC

A study of the control numbers, paper types, and perforation line on the first Supreme Court issues has resulted, so far, in the following table.

Please note that, for the \$1 value, there are two separate ranges for the 12 x 12 thin paper, suggesting that this issue stamps were available for printing even after the 12 x 12 thick paper was introduced. (This conclusion is, of course, based on the reasonable assumption that the printing of control numbers onto these stamps was copied consecutively.) Also, there is evidence to indicate that use of value continued to be produced after all other values ceased, in that, the large control numbered stamps that I have (above 18736) are printed on a poorer quality yellowish or off white paper.

Collectors are requested to check their copies of this issue and update the above table where possible.

BRITISH COLUMBIA REAL ESTATE STAMPS

These stamps were issued by the Province of British Columbia to collect a fee from Real Estate Agents and Salesmen. These stamps were to be affixed to the Real Estate Agent's license.

Licenses were issued for one year, 1st of July to 30th of June. License fees were payable in accordance with the provisions of schedule A and all fees paid under this act shall be accounted for as part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

As far as we can determine there are three types of these stamps.

Type - 1 - (see 1952-53 document) also (1956-57 document)

Type 2 - 1958-59 "Real Estate Council"

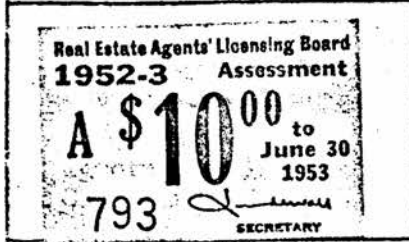
Type 3 - 1959-60 "Real Estate Council of British Columbia"
